NARRATIVE

On May 12, 2026, at approximately 1708 hours, I arrived at the Indian River County Sheriff's Office Jail located at 4055 41st Avenue in reference to a disturbance. Upon my arrival, contact was made with jail supervision. Jail supervision provided a video in which I observed the following:

On this date, between 1540 hours and 1545 hours, inmates Frank Lagola and Richter Occeus were in a cell together. During the video, Frank is clearly seen holding a small cup of liquid and tosses the liquid on Richter's person. A few moments later, Frank throws liquid on Richter again. Richter approaches Frank and strikes him numerous times in the face with a closed fist. Frank eventually falls to the ground and Richter stops punching him. Frank and Richter are eventually separated from each other.

Frank suffered multiple injuries to his face from this incident, therefore, medical services were requested and later arrived on scene. Frank was transported to the Cleveland Clinic Hospital to be treated for his injuries.

D/S P. Newman later arrived at the hospital and spoke with Frank. Frank confirmed he threw water on Richter a couple of times and was struck in the face numerous times by Richter. D/S P. Newman informed me Frank was receiving multiple stitches for injuries sustained during the incident.

Let it be noted, Frank received multiple injuries to his face from this incident. Frank had numerous lacerations on his face, a swollen nose, and a massive knot on the left side of his forehead that was bleeding profusely. Frank was covered in blood.

I then spoke with Richter. Richter said he did not touch Frank, but that Frank was pouring water on him. Richter was informed I observed the video and saw him strike Frank multiple times with a fist, but he did not respond. While speaking with Richter, I did not observe any injuries on him.

Based on the information above, I found probable cause Frank was in violation of F.S.S 784.082.3, battery by person detained in prison or jail facility.

NARRATIVE

On Wednesday, May 13, 2026 at approximately 1604 hours, I responded to [REDACTED] reference to phone harassment. Upon my arrival, contact was made with the victim Danielle Wynn.

Wynn stated the following: "I received an email over we care website requesting medical assistance. I called the person back and left a message to contact me for assistance. We made contact on Monday and I explained the services and requirements for the program. There was some misunderstanding about his insurance and the call dropped. I returned the call and left a message to call back. He called today and started the conversation with I was talking to some bitch the other day and she didn't know what she was talking about. I told him that was me but I would love to see how WeCare can help. As the conversation went on, he became more aggressive to the point I felt we would not be able to work with him. He kept calling me a bitch, cunt and cursing at me. I ended the call by saying I am sorry we are not able to help and have a good day. He said fuck you, you fucking cunt.

At 3:58pm I received an email threatening my life. You are fucking dead bitch, I promise you are fucking dead, I will kill you cunt, I SWEAR TO GOD YOU ARE FUCKING DEAD BITCH." Wynn stated she was scared for her and her staff's life and requested everyone stay out of work until the issue was resolved. Wynn was unsure what Pena was capable off and for the safety of her staff and herself she closed the business down.

Observed on Wynn's phone were several messages that came from an email addressed from Marco Pena. The messages were as follows: "You are fucking dead bitch, I promise you are fucking dead, I will kill you cunt, and I SWEAR TO GOD YOU ARE FUCKING DEAD BITCH."

I attempted to make contact with the suspect Marco Pena at his residence located at 811 4th Lane. On the approach to the residence contact was made with an unknown elderly female at the front door who stated Pena was inside and she would go get him. After several minutes Pena came to the door and I was able to identify him. I advised Pena that I needed him to step outside and he immediately slammed the door and locked the deadbolt and would not come outside. No interview was conducted.

Contact was made with Wynn at her residence. Wynn was asked if she would be willing to conducted a controlled phone call with the suspect and agreed. Wynn made contact with the phone number provided. Pena was identified and acknowledged himself on the phone speaking with Wynn which was all recorded on my agency issued Axon Body-Worn camera. Pena admitted to sending the threatening emails because he was enraged due to being in pain for several years and no one was willing to help him.

At the conclusion of the conversation Wynn agreed to offer Pena services and he was to report on 5-14-2026 at 0645 hours at the office located at [REDACTED] and never showed. Myself and Sergeant Scranton went back to 811 4th Lane and contact was made inside the residence with Pena. Pena was placed into custody and read his Miranda warnings and stated he understood and would speak to your affiant. Pena admitted to sending nasty emails to Daniella. With Permission from Pena he allowed me to access his cellphone and directed me to the email he sent and observed the following:

You are fucking dead bitch, I promise you are fucking dead, I will kill you cunt, I SWEAR TO GOD YOU ARE FUCKING DEAD

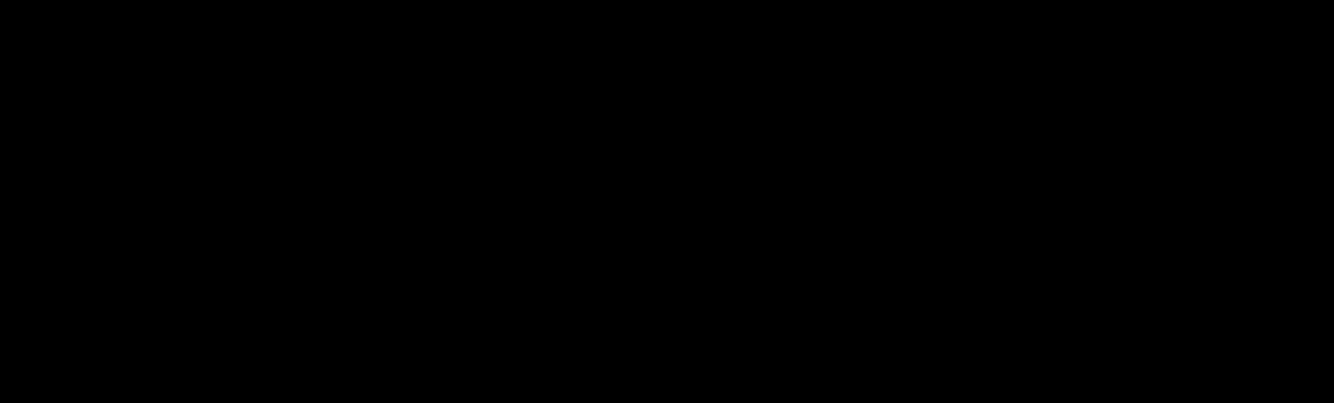

The undersigned certifies and swears that he/she has just and reasonable grounds to believe that the above named defendant committed the following violation of law:

On 05/14/2026 at 06:58 (Specifically include facts constituting cause for arrest.)

On 05/14/2026 at approximately 0658 hours, I, Ofc. Herrera, responded to the area of [redacted] in reference to a physical disturbance. Vero Beach Communications informed that there were two males having a verbal dispute that then turned into a physical altercation possibly involving a knife.

Upon arrival, I spoke with one of the involved males Victor Pires (DOB 12/22/1994 who will now be referred to as (D1). D1 did not have a shirt on when I first arrived on scene. I asked D1 if he had any weapons on him and if he would consent to a search of his person and vehicle. D1 consented to a search, and we walked towards his vehicle, a black Nissan bearing Florida tag (DX32HT) that was parked in front of [redacted]. Upon conducting a search of his person, I located a black pen in his front right shorts pocket. The pen was later determined to be involved in the incident and was submitted into evidence.

I asked D1 what happened and he stated that earlier this morning he was with a female (later identified as Chelsea A. Beal (DOB 01/02/1995) who will now be referred to as W1). D1 stated that they were involved in an accident earlier this morning around 0300 hours out west of town within the IRCISO jurisdiction. Due to the accident W1 had her boyfriend, later identified as Joshua P. Lopez (DOB 09/26/1991 and who will now be referred to as V1) come to the scene of the accident. It should be noted, according to statements from involved parties, W1 is dating both males involved and V1 was just made aware of this upon arriving at the accident. This caused a verbal disturbance between parties and that they were separated by law enforcement who responded to the crash.

D1 stated after the accident, V1 left the scene and W1 requested that he follow her home. D1 stated that when he was approaching W1's residence [redacted] V1 was outside yelling at him. D1 did not hear what was said since his windows were up and ended up parking his vehicle at [redacted].

D1 stated that he got out of his vehicle and approached V1. D1 stated that as he approached, V1 knocked the hat off of his head. D1 stated that V1 then put him in "choke hold". I observed bruising on both sides of D1's neck and scrapes to his right elbow and right knee. D1 stated that he could not breath during the choke hold and that he was in fear for his life. D1 stated that he never hit V1 and that W1 stopped the fight.

As I was speaking to D1, Cpl. J. Brumley #415 was speaking to V1. #415 informed me that D1 possibly had a knife during this incident and a black pen. D1 then stated that he had a white in color wine bottle opener (multi tool, integrated with a knife and a bottle opener) in his possession during the incident. D1 explained that he had the multi tool with "cork screw" part open in his hand when he exited his vehicle.

Cpl. Brumley once again asked about the incident and what happened after they were their initial confrontation. D1 stated that he went back to his vehicle and grabbed a black pen. D1 then became very illusive and talking around questions that were being asked. D1 was then placed into handcuffs and secured in the back of my patrol vehicle. Ofc. A. Muniz #493 stood by with D1 as I walked over to speak with Ofc. R. Aguilar #437.

I spoke with #437 who provided me the following statement, "On scene, I spoke with one of the involved males later identified as Joshua Lopez (who will now be referred to as V1). Another party involved was V1's girlfriend, [redacted] and shares a child with, later identified as Chelsea Beal (will now be referred to as W1)

V1 stated that prior to the incident, he responded out west of town in reference to W1 being involved in a traffic accident. V1 stated upon arrival, he noticed that W1 was with another male identified as Victor Pires (will now be referred to as D1). V1 then found out that W1 was involved in some sort of relationship with D1.

V1 stated this caused a verbal disturbance and that law enforcement (Indian River County Sheriff's Office Jurisdiction) responded to the scene. V1 stated he then left the accident and went back to his address at [redacted]. V1 stated that he remained outside his residence smoking a cigarette and that W1 arrived at the address at approximately 0650 hours. V1 stated while arguing with W1 in the parking lot of their apartment, he observed D1 driving southbound on [redacted] in a black Nissan Altima (Florida tag# DX32HT).

V1 stated that D1 stopped his vehicle on 40th Ave directly in front of their driveway and that they began arguing. V1 stated he then heard D1 state, "I've got something for you" while digging in his center console. D1 stated that W1 began to yell at D1 to leave and that he drove south on 40th Ave towards the next apartment (D) driveway and parked.

V1 stated he then walked towards where D1 was parked because he, "Wanted him out of here". V1 stated that D1 got out of his vehicle with a knife in his hand. He described it as knife with white handle. V1 stated as D1 approached the blade of the knife was pointing towards the ground

V1 stated that they were now within arm's reach of each other and that D1 made statement's, "I'm from Brazil, we don't fight in Brazil we kill" and that he was going to prison and was going to kill him. V1 stated this was going on, he was being circled by D1 who was still holding the knife in his hand. V1 stated that W1 tried separating them and that he responded by

moving her away from the incident.

V1 stated that D1 swiped at him using the knife in a downward motion but that he missed. V1 stated that D1 swiped at him again with the knife but that he was able to block it using his forearm overhead. V1 showed a fresh laceration on the underneath portion of his forearm, which is consistent with the statements provided. V1 stated he hit D1 in the face with his forearm which brought him to the ground. V1 stated he then held D1 to the ground and eventually D1 is able to get back up to his feet. V1 stated that D1 swiped at him again with the knife 3-4 more times and that he ended up dropping the knife. V1 stated that W1 was able to retrieve and walk away with the knife. V1 stated he then began walking back to his apartment alongside W1.

V1 stated that D1 then walked back to his vehicle and retrieved what he later identified as a black pen. V1 stated he was now located on the driveway of his apartment and that D1 approached him with the pen and began slashing at him. V1 stated that D1 was able to cut him using the pen a single time. I observed a small laceration; above his left forearm he claimed was from the pen.

V1 stated that he did not know where the pen went but that the disturbance continued and that he was punched in the face a single time by D1. V1 stated law enforcement then arrived on scene and separated the incident.

V1 stated that he did feel threatened but was not in fear for his life as he has been trained to defend against knife attacks. During the investigation, Ofc. Wells #452, handed me the above-mentioned knife/multi tool. Ofc. Wells stated he obtained the knife from W1 upon law enforcement arrival".

I received a witness statement from W1 which stated the following, "I arrived home to [redacted] Joshua was waiting for me outside, Victor followed me home. The two then began arguing when Victor stopped his car. Then he parked after Josh told him to so they could "throw hands" the two began walking down the street in each others faces. I'm not entirely sure who initiated the physical fight, they ended up on the ground. Victor had a corkscrew type of thing that he only swung after Josh continued to tell him to not be a "pussy" Josh had Victor in a chokehold. I begged him to let him go. They then stopped and got up. I told them there's people watching. Then cops pulled up."

W1 also provided a verbal statement where she informed officers that upon returning to her residence, she observed that V1 was outside waiting. W1 stated that D1 arrived shortly after and that he began arguing with V1 from the street. W1 stated she then observed that D1 pull into a driveway to the south and that V1 walked over to his vehicle. W1 stated that prior to V1 approaching the vehicle, D1 was already outside the vehicle with a knife in his hand. W1 stated she observed that D1 was holding the knife/multi tool to his side and was heard telling V1 that where he is from they do not fight, they kill. W1 stated she then observed D1 slash at V1 with the knife/tool but that he missed. W1 stated that V1 then fights at D1 with his elbow and that they go to the ground. W1 stated this is when she believed that D1 was able to hurt V1 with the knife. W1 stated that somewhere in the struggle, D1 dropped the knife and that V1 kicked it away. W1 stated she then grabbed the knife and that they separated.

W1 stated she then began walking with V1 back towards their apartment. W1 stated she then heard D1 approach from behind and that he was swinging an unknown object at V1. W1 stated she then noticed D1 scratch V1 with a pen and shortly after the incident was separated by law enforcement presence.

Ofc. D. Wells #452 handed me a witness statement from Randy Wyand (DOB 10/18/1957) who stated the following: "I saw a lot of pushing, no swinging. Couple tried to leave but guy with no shirt was aggressive each time."

One of the neighbors Fiora A. Piaseki (DOB 05/11/1995) informed me that she was walking her dog when she saw two males arguing, then wrestling she didn't see any swings. They got up and started arguing then wrestling again. She saw one of the males pull out a small "dingy" knife out of his right front pocket and started swinging it at the other male horizontally.

Based on the information gathered, there is probable cause to charge D1 with two counts of F.S.S 784.045(1a2) - PERSON USES A DEADLY WEAPON

NARRATIVE

On May 14th, 2026, at 1344 hours, I, Deputy J. Crawford #6196, was working an extra duty detail at the Indian River County Court House located at 2000 16th Ave, Vero Beach, Florida 32960 in the capacity of the Special Weapon and Tactics Team. Intel was provided prior to the detail that there was a juvenile hearing for [REDACTED] Vassili Ferrainolo, was said to be vocal about not being afraid to protect him [REDACTED] Vassili stated that he was not afraid to use firearms at this court appearance if "things don't go right." Vassilli identified himself as a sovereign citizen.

While the court room was declared in session and set for Tavion's hearing, Tavion was non-compliant with Judge White's instructions with claiming Tavion's right to counsel.

Vassili was seated in the spectator section and spoke out in the court room after Judge White stated Vassili could not represent Tavion. Judge White advised that Vassili could not represent Tavion due to not being legally licensed to do so. Sgt J. Plasse ordered Vassili to not speak out to Judge White in the court room. Vassili stated to the court room that he knows his rights and that its his right to speak out. Vassili was escorted out of the court room to prevent the furtherance of disruption of the court room process after failing to obey Sgt J. Plasse's orders to not speak out. The physical act of guiding Vassili out of the courtroom additionally interrupted the court hearing process and public peace.

Vassili was placed into mechanical hand restraints and escorted to my patrol vehicle.

Vassili was arrested for violation of FSS 843.02 Resisting Arrest without Violence and FSS 877.03 Disorderly Conduct due to interrupting the courtroom procedure after being ordered not to do so by Sgt J. Plasse.

Vassili met the following criteria to violate the aforementioned statues:

1. Vassili obstructed the court room of Judge White.
2. At the time, Sgt Plasse was engaged in the execution of legal process in the court room of Judge White.
3. At the time, Sgt Plasse was a sworn Sergeant with the Indian River County Sheriff's Office who was authorized to execute legal process.
4. At the time, Vassili knew Sgt Plasse was a sworn deputy as Sgt Plasse was dressed in class B Uniform including multiple pieces of insignia indicating to be a Sergeant with the Indian River County Sheriff's Office.
5. Vassili's actions committed additionally corrupted the public morals of a civil court room.



Vassili was transported to the Indian River County Sheriff's Office without further incident.

On 05/14/2026 , at 14:56 (Specifically include facts constituting cause for arrest.)

On 05/14/2026, at approximately 1456 hours, I, Ofc. Herrera, responded to [REDACTED] in reference to a past disturbance. Vero Beach Communications informed that the complainant was a female wanting to report an abuse but that she did not want to press charges. The complainant stated that she would meet us outside her apartment building.

Upon arrival, we did not observe the complainant outside of the apartment building. I went inside and as I walked up the stairs trying to find the caller, she came out of her apartment and told us not to go in front of her door because there was a camera. She asked us to go downstairs and meet outside. We then spoke with the caller outside who was identified as Ashley B. Barrett (DOB 11/17/1991) who will now be referred to as V1.

V1 stated that she just wanted documentation of an incident that involved her fiance, Jeremy V. Rodrigues (DOB 11/14/1986) who will be referred to as D1. V1 was hesitant on providing information as she was afraid of D1's response.

I then noticed that V1 had swelling and discoloration around the left side of her eye. V1 briefly stated that she was punched in the face by D1 but would not elaborate. V1 was very indecisive on whether to press charges, she was tearing up as she was making multiple phone calls to different people asking what she should do. V1 requested that we give her until 1700 hours that day for her to make a decision on whether to make a report about the incident. For approximately 30 minutes, V1 would go back on forth about reporting the incident. V1 believed that once she made the report, she would feel unsafe about living in her apartment with D1 and that if she moved out it would take time for her to retrieve her belongings. V1 was also overwhelmed as D1 would return from work at 1700 hours. V1 then informed that they have each other's location and wanted to remain on scene to not alarm D1 that she was reporting the incident. V1 then walked back inside and stated she no longer wanted law enforcement involvement. I remained on scene for a couple minutes; she then returned and informed that she wanted to proceed with the investigation. During this time V1 was urged to report the incident as it would be the best for her safety.

V1 stated earlier in the morning, she messaged D1's mother in regards to him not keeping up with the car payment. V1 stated that D1 was made aware of this conversation and that it angered him. V1 stated around noon, D1 arrived from work and confronted her about the conversation that was had with his mother. V1 stated while arguing in the living room D1 rushed towards her. V1 stated that D1 then pushed her onto the couch and that grabbed her by the neck and then spit on her face. While speaking with V1, I observed a small red mark on the center of her neck.

V1 stated that D1 then began "tossing the room" and while doing so, knocked over a bin that held a candle heater with melted wax. V1 stated the wax spilled onto her and stated the wax burned her skin. V1 stated that she then got up from the couch, walked towards the bathroom and picked up her hair brush.

V1 stated that D1 began screaming at her again and that he rushed at her and headbutted her. V1 stated that she was standing in between her bathtub and a small dresser and that D1 then struck her in the face with his right hand a single time. V1 described the impact as "haymaker" and then explained it as a right hook using her arm. V1 stated after the impact she "flew" across the bathroom over the dresser and onto her left side then fell on the floor. V1 stated that D1 left the apartment after hitting her and informed the injury from her face was a result of the impact.

V1 stated that she did not lose consciousness but laid on the floor for approximately 7 minutes. V1 stated D1 came back in the apartment while she was still on the floor and began to apologize for his actions. V1 stated that after D1 apologized, he then started to blame her for his actions. V1 said that while he was arguing with her, he fell to the floor and became unconscious. V1 stated she had no explanation for him becoming unresponsive but that she shook him until he woke up. V1 stated she helped D1 get back up and he then went back to work. Law enforcement and EMS were not involved in this initial incident.

After providing Vero Beach Communications D1's information, they informed me that he had an active warrant out of Palm Beach County.

I contacted D1 over the phone and asked him to meet at his residence. D1 arrived on scene and was placed in handcuffs pending the warrant confirmation. I then read D1 his Miranda Warnings verbatim, which he understood his rights and agreed to answer my questions.

I asked D1 about this morning's incident involving V1. D1 stated that he has been with her since November of 2025 and that they have been living together for a few months. D1 stated that earlier in the morning he left for work and during the day V1 was messaging him about her car payment and why he hasn't paid it.
