**NARRATIVE**

On May 12, 2026, at approximately 1708 hours, I arrived at the Indian River County Sheriff's Office Jail located at 4055 41st Avenue in reference to a disturbance. Upon my arrival, contact was made with jail supervision. Jail supervision provided a video in which I observed the following:

On this date, between 1540 hours and 1545 hours, inmates Frank Lagola and Richter Occeus were in a cell together. During the video, Frank is clearly seen holding a small cup of liquid and tosses the liquid on Richter's person. A few moments later, Frank throws liquid on Richter again. Richter approaches Frank and strikes him numerous times in the face with a closed fist. Frank eventually falls to the ground and Richter stops punching him. Frank and Richter are eventually separated from each other.

Frank suffered multiple injuries to his face from this incident, therefore, medical services were requested and later arrived on scene. Frank was transported to the Cleveland Clinic Hospital to be treated for his injuries.

D/S P. Newman later arrived at the hospital and spoke with Frank. Frank confirmed he threw water on Richter a couple of times and was struck in the face numerous times by Richter. D/S P. Newman informed me Frank was receiving multiple stitches for injuries sustained during the incident.

Let it be noted, Frank received multiple injuries to his face from this incident. Frank had numerous lacerations on his face, a swollen nose, and a massive knot on the left side of his forehead that was bleeding profusely. Frank was covered in blood.

I then spoke with Richter. Richter said he did not touch Frank, but that Frank was pouring water on him. Richter was informed I observed the video and saw him strike Frank multiple times with a fist, but he did not respond. While speaking with Richter, I did not observe any injuries on him.

Based on the information above, I found probable cause Richter was in violation of F.S.S 784.082.1, aggravated battery by person detained in prison or jail facility.

NARRATIVE

On May 12, 2026, at approximately 0639 hours, I arrived at Perkins Indian River Pharmacy located at 3721 10<sup>th</sup> Court, in reference to a burglary alarm. Dispatch received a complaint from the alarm company that the door and glass break detector was activated.

Prior to my arrival, as I was driving on 37<sup>th</sup> Street and was just west of 10<sup>th</sup> Court, I observed a black male with dreads in a dark hoodie and jeans carrying a pink tote bag. The black male was walking west on 37<sup>th</sup> Street.

Upon my arrival, I checked the business and observed the front doors open. The latch on one of the doors was still in the locked position and the other door's frame appeared to be damaged by forced entry. A search of the building was conducted, but no one was located inside the store. All the other doors were locked and secured.

The store's owner, Gregory Decrescenzo, later arrived on scene. Gregory confirmed the front doors were locked and secured prior to closing and leaving the store last night. Gregory did a quick search around the store, but could not find anything obvious missing. Gregory informed me there were video cameras all around the outside and inside of the store.

A search of the camera system revealed at approximately 0626 hours, the black male described above was seen approaching the front doors of the store. It was clear in the video that the doors were closed.

The male was then observed trying to pry open the doors with what appeared to be a crowbar or pipe. The male then turned around so he was facing the parking lot and he was able to pry the doors open with the burglary tool behind his back while he kept a visual of the area.

The male entered the store at approximately 0629 hours, and immediately selected the pink tote bag he was in possession of. The tote bag was valued at \$39.00. The male quickly walked around the store and selected two pocket tool kits valued at \$12.50 each, three Cascade Complete Dawn Fresh packs valued at \$8.29 each, three packs of Tide Pods valued at \$6.49 each, 4 containers of Before You Go Poo-Pourri valued at \$6.75 each, three packages of Everyday Energy valued at \$11.39 each, three packages of Duracell batteries valued at \$6.89 each, two packages of Nix Lice Control spray valued at \$9.99 each, one bottle opener set valued at approximately \$50.00, and a bottle of O'Keeffe's Working Hands hand cream valued at \$8.39. The total value of all the merchandise stolen was \$268.55. The approximate total for the door to be repaired was \$500.00.

Once the male was finished selecting the items above, he walked out the store. The male exits the store at approximately 0630 hours, and is seen walking towards 37<sup>th</sup> Street. The male never rendered payment for any of the merchandise he selected.

Gregory stated no one had permission to damage his property, force entry into the property, or take merchandise without rendering payment. Gregory desired prosecution for this incident.

After watching the video and confirmed I had seen the suspect leave on foot, additional units were requested to the

area to search for the suspect. Through investigative means, the Indian River County Sheriff's Office Real Time Crime Center (R.T.C.C) was able to locate a footage of the suspect leaving the scene and disseminated photographs of the suspect to the additional units.

Additional units were able to recognized the suspect as Johnny Davis, due to previous contact with him. Units went to the area of 4200 block of 26<sup>th</sup> Avenue in search of Johnny since he lived in the area. D/S D. Rivers observed a male matching the exact description walking in the area and recognized the male to be Johnny. D/S D. Rivers immediately detained Johnny. D/S D. Rivers informed me Johnny was in possession of the pink tote bag and multiple items listed above that were stolen.

D/S M. Baumann later met with D/S D. Rivers and took custody of Johnny to transport him to the Indian River County Jail. Once D/S M. Baumann arrived, she verbally advised him of his Miranda Rights, which he waived. D/S M. Baumann advised the following via supplement:

"When we arrived to the Indian River County Jail, the jail staff began to state he has stayed out of jail for a long time. Davis began to get emotional. I explained to Davis he did not take any of the medication from the business and asked if he wanted to explain why he did it. Davis began to cry and advised he has no resources and just wanted to clean his house. Davis then asked if the charges could be dropped down to a Misdemeanor and requested to speak to the business owner to drop the charges."

D/S M. Baumann also collected the tote bag and the items inside the tote bag. D/S M. Baumann was able to bring the items back to the store and it was discovered most of the items that were identified to be stolen were still inside the bag. The bottle opener set was not located and Johnny claimed he did not know where it was. There was also a crowbar and a pair of metal snips located inside the tote bag.

I then arrived at the jail and was able to speak with Johnny as well. Johnny advised the following verbally:

Johnny confirmed he was verbally advised his Miranda Rights and would speak with me. Johnny also confirmed he took the items he stole because he wanted to clean his room. Johnny went on to say he chose to burglarize the store out of random and he had never been inside the store before. Johnny thought he did not damage the door when he forced it open. Johnny was informed that he would be charged for burglary and being in possession of burglary tools. Johnny said the crowbar was from home and I told him he was on video using what appeared to be a crowbar in the video and he did not respond.

Based on the information above, I found probable cause Johnny was in violation of F.S.S 810.02.4A, burglary of an unoccupied structure unarmed and F.S.S 810.06, possession of burglary tools.

On May 12, 2026, Officer N. Nocera of the Vero Beach Police Department responded to \_\_\_\_\_ in reference to a domestic violence dispute.

Upon arrival, I made contact with the victim, Angela Geschwendt who stated this morning around 0500 hours, her boyfriend of three months Brant Smith entered her room severely intoxicated and tried to grab her out of bed then proceeded to put his forearm on her throat and would not allow her to get up. Ms. Geschwendt also stated she asked Mr. Smith to leave multiple times before and after the incident because she was afraid for her safety. Mr. Smith refused to leave after multiple requests. Ms. Geschwendt then expressed to me that Mr. Smith did not reside at the above address (which was also confirmed by management). I then evaluated Ms. Geschwendt for marks which were present on both arms. Ms. Geschwendt had visible bruises approximately the size of a thumb to both forearms and a fresh cut to the top of her right hand that still had visible dried blood. All injuries were photographed and uploaded to a secure file. Ms. Geschwendt stated she wanted Mr. Smith trespassed.

After my interaction with Ms. Geschwendt, she provided entry into the apartment at which time I made contact with Mr. Smith. Upon entering the apartment, I located Mr. Smith on the back porch. At this time, I asked Mr. Smith to explain to me what transpired between he and Ms. Geschwendt. Mr. Smith explained they were drinking last night and started arguing, he then stated she locked him out of the bedroom and went to sleep. Mr. Smith explained that this morning he went into the room and wrapped his arms around her and stated he just wanted to tell her he loved her. Mr. Smith advised that he laid his hands on her at any point. When asked where he lived, he stated there with Ms. Geschwendt, and they have been living together for the last three months, which was found to be a false statement.

With all the physical evidence and conflicting statements made by both parties I found to have probable cause to arrest Brant Smith for violation of F.S.S 784.031a1 (domestic Violence).

Mr. Smith was transported to the Indian River County Jail without further incident and currently being held with no bond.

These interactions and interviews were all recorded on my body-worn camera and uploaded to evidence library.

NARRATIVE

On May 12<sup>th</sup>, 2026 at approximately 1909 hours, I was dispatched to [REDACTED] in reference to a residential burglary in progress. The calling party was identified as Christina Selph. Christina stated her ex-boyfriend, identified as Brandon Boyer, had broken into her residence's garage. She stated Brandon let the air out of her vehicle's tires as well. Christina advised the male party was inside the garage, and let her dogs out the residence. Christina also advised the male was banging on windows outside the residence, and that the male is yelling.

Deputy Goodrich and I responded to the area, where I observed Brandon walking westbound on [REDACTED] from the area of the residence. Of note, a dog was running in front of him. I had my emergency lights activated, where I exited my vehicle and conducted a felony stop on Brandon. Brandon was compliant, where he walked back toward my agency vehicle. While walking backwards he was screaming at Christina who was outside, saying something to the effect of what she has done to him. Brandon was handcuffed by Deputy Goodrich where Brandon continued to lay on the ground. Brandon would ultimately scream and yell loudly, begging for help, stating we the deputies had beaten him up. He was screaming so loudly others stopped and began filming. However, we did not use any physical force with Brandon to take him into custody.

I moved up toward his vehicle, which was identified as a Ford F250 bearing Florida registration R0EBR. The vehicle was cleared for any other persons, which resulted in negative findings. I walked back to Brandon, where I issued him multiple commands to stand up and walk to Deputy Goodrich's vehicle. He did so, but went limp while walking forcing us to catch him. He ultimately entered Deputy Goodrich's vehicle while the investigation was on-going.

I spoke with Christina at the front of her residence. She explained her and Brandon had been in a romantic relationship, where they have a child in common. She explained they broke up and he had moved out of the house in October of 2025. She explained she had changed the locks to the residence, and he does not reside with her. Christina stated she pays all the bills and is the sole owner of the residence. She stated Brandon is not living there, and does not have regular access. Christina stated he resides in Lakewood Park with his grandmother. A later query of the Indian River County Property Appraiser results in Christina being listed as the sole owner [REDACTED]

Christina explained throughout the day of May 12<sup>th</sup>, 2026, she had been receiving messages from Brandon's cell phone stating his intent to come to the residence, break a window, and retrieve his stuff. She stated he placed a ring of Brandon's in the mailbox, which is on the opposite side of the road, and told him he could retrieve this item.

Christina explained prior to the [redacted] Brandon arrived at the residence in his truck. She explained he began to knock and bang on the front door, along with going to the windows on the 2 side of the residence. She explained she observed him by opening the door, and telling him to leave. However, he did not. She explained she heard the closed garage door open, and believed him to be inside the garage. She explained due to this she opened the interior door which led to the garage, where she observed Brandon in the corner of the garage. She explained as she opened the door, he walked further into the garage coming towards her, thus she shut the door and retreated.

I conducted an interview with Christina's son, who was identified as Brody Mills. It should be noted, he was separated from his mother at the time of the interview by being inside his vehicle. He stated his mother had told him that Brandon was acting erratic throughout the day. He explained he left to go visit his girlfriend at work down the road from his residence, where he received a call from his mother that Brandon was at the residence. Due to such, he rushed home and saw Deputies interacting with Brandon in the roadway. Brody stated Brandon does not live at the residence, and confirmed Christina timeline since his moving out.

Deputy Goodrich would read Brandon his Miranda Rights on scene, where he requested a lawyer. Deputy Goodrich stated Brandon would later request to speak to law enforcement post his invocation. Due to his behavior on scene, I did not deem this as reasonable.

Deputy J. Yerian conducted a video canvas where he identified residence [redacted] had a forward-facing video camera. The residents, identified as Alanna Chaples and Zylar Newland provided a long uninterrupted video of the incident. The video was uploaded to Evidence.com. I observed within the video Brandon arriving, walking to the front door, then the 2 side of the residence, and then ducking behind the driver's side of the vehicle near the front left driver's tire. Christina then opens the door, where he begins yelling at her and charges toward the front door, she slams the door. He screams to her to let him get his belongings. He then screams at her through the door calling her a "fat piece of shit" and "whore." I observed him walking to the garage where he opens it. The dogs run out; he chases them. He then returns to the property and goes inside the garage to the left portion, and then entering even further into the garage as though something draws his attention. The video captures Brandon's arrival up to the point of law enforcement's arrival.

Christina mentioned Brandon had been texting her throughout the day. She showed me a cell phone text message conversation from the number 772-643-0246. She allowed me to screen record the conversation from today. Throughout the conversation the following was learned: Brandon stated his intent multiple times to come to the residence to gather his ring. Christina clearly stated he was not

allowed in the residence. Brandon stated his intent to break the windows if he had to, where Christina stated she was going to call law enforcement. The message reads the following "call the cops right now Christina cause they'll get my ring for me. Please do that. Ill be there in 30 minutes bitch I'll bust every fucking window out of that motherfucking house..." He stated he did not care, and was coming anyways. He stated he would take a battery if need be. The screen recording was uploaded to.

Ultimately, Brandon was placed under arrest and driven to IRCSO Jail by Deputy Goodrich. I remained on scene, where Christina filled out a written statement. During this time period, I did observe the front left tire on Christina's vehicle, identified as a 2007 Lexus bearing Florida registration AV68MN, had low tire pressure. I also noted the air stem to be missing the cap which covers the valve.

While at the jail, Brandon identified his phone number as 772-643-0246. It should be noted, this is the same number messaging Christina throughout the day, which she identified as Brandon. Brandon asked me what his charges were, which I informed him. He stated without any questioning something to the effect of "all I did was open the garage." He asked me to speak with him, I advised he invoked his right to remain silent and an attorney. He stated he would like to revoke this.

I read Brandon his Miranda Rights line by line from the agency issued card, where Corrections Deputy Canales (6127) was present for this. At the end of each line, I asked if Brandon understood, which he stated yes, every time. I asked if at the end if he was willing to speak with post his previous invocation, which he stated yes. He explained he went to the residence to get some of his personal belonging out of the garage. He stated he has a key to the garage, and pays all the bills at the residence. He stated there had been no argument and or threats toward Christina when specifically asked. He stated she allowed him to come to the house.

The text messages which Christina provided proves this interview to be inaccurate, along with false. Brandon specifically stated in the messages he was willing to go to jail for battery, and stated he would break Christina's windows on the residence if she did not open the door. He consistently called his multiple profanities and was speaking in a vial/threatening manner to her within the messages.

NARRATIVE

On Tuesday, 05/12/2026, at approximately 2212, I was dispatched to 488 U.S Highway One, Vero Beach, Florida 32962 (Mullinax Ford), in reference to a theft investigation.

The complainant works for a security company that monitors the cameras of Mullinax Ford 24/7; while monitoring the cameras they observed a male wearing all black take a bright yellow object out of a work truck's bed and left southbound on a bicycle.

While checking the area I observed a male who matched the description walking a bicycle west in the middle U.S Highway One just north of 4<sup>th</sup> street. The male did not have any bicycle lights and was not utilizing the crosswalk that was south of him at the intersection, based on these observations I stopped the male with probable cause for a potential violation of F.S.S 316.130(11) – Pedestrian failed to cross in crosswalk.

The male, identified as Tyler Jaymes Robinson, was extremely nervous (Robinson was sweating profusely and shaking) and immediately asked if he was going to jail. I asked Robinson where he was coming from when crossing U.S Highway One, which he advised that he was coming from the gas station. I asked Robinson if he went into the Mullinax Ford dealership parking lot, which he stated he crossed through it to get to the gas station.

I then informed Robinson of his Miranda Rights, which he voluntarily waived and agreed to speak with me. I asked Robinson if he had taken anything from the back of a truck at the dealership, which Robinson replied that he felt bad and was in the process of returning it. I asked Robinson where the item he took was, which he advised he had stashed it at the Mobil Mart Gas Station (420 US Highway One, Vero Beach, Florida 32962). Sergeant Rodriguez was able to retrieve a yellow coil of Neptco Trace Safe wire.

After placing Robinson under arrest in the back of my vehicle I went to inventory his property before it was submitted into the Indian River County Crime Scene for safe keeping. While inventorying a drawstring bag attached to Robinson's bike, I located a white capsule with a glass shard like substance inside. Robinson advised it was crystal methamphetamine, using an agency provided test kit I conducted a field test of the suspected methamphetamine. The test kit yielded a distinct blue coloration change indicating a field presumptive positive test for the presence of methamphetamine.

Based on totality of the circumstances, I placed Tyler Jaymes Robinson under arrest for the following offenses:

- F.S.S. 810.02.4B – Auto Burglary
