**NARRATIVE**

On April 10, 2026, at approximately 0420 hours, I was stationary at approximately MM 150 on Interstate 95, facing south, when I observed a vehicle approaching me at a high rate of speed, which I visually estimated at 93 MPH. I activated my Stalker Radar DSR 2X SN: DB031280 and confirmed the black GMC Denali's speed at 94 MPH.

As the black GMC Denali passed me going north on Interstate 95, I turned out onto Interstate 95 and proceeded to catch up to the vehicle. By the time I caught up to the black GMC Denali bearing Maryland tag 9GH3064 it was traveling at 106 MPH, which was confirmed by Stalker Radar DSR 2X SN: DB031280.

I initiated a traffic stop on the aforementioned vehicle at MM 156 northbound on Interstate 95 by activating the overhead emergency lights on my marked patrol car, for violation of Florida State Statue 316.183(2)-(Speeding).

As I approached the passenger side of the vehicle, I could smell the strong odor of burnt marijuana coming out of the vehicle. I made contact with the driver and sole occupant, Steven Simon. I asked Steven for his driver's license, registration, and proof of insurance. As I spoke with Steven, I observed a bag of green leafy substance on the passenger seat, which I know to be marijuana based on my education and experience. I also observed rolling paperS in the center consul. I asked Steven if he possessed a medical marijuana card, which he advised he did not. I asked Steven for the bag of marijuana, which he handed me. Steven also provided me with his Florida driver's license and the rental agreement for the vehicle.

Steven informed me that he smokes marijuana for his pain.

I returned to my vehicle and requested K9 Deputy Le to my traffic stop. As I waited for K9 Deputy Le to arrive, I conducted my traffic stop. When K9 Deputy Le arrived, we approached the driver's side of the vehicle and requested Steven to step out, which he did. As Steven exited, I observed marijuana shake all over the front of Steven's black pants, and another bag of marijuana in the driver's door.

K9 Deputy Le secured Steven in handcuff restraints, and sat with him at the front of my vehicle, while I searched the black GMC Denali. During my search, I located another bag that contained marijuana, along with a cup in the center consul that contained several burnt marijuana cigarettes inside, floating in liquid.

I returned to my vehicle and placed the bags of marijuana in my trunk.

I approached Steven and had him face away from me, and began to search him. As I was searching Steven, I felt a bag with a lumpy consistency in his underwear between his legs. Steven informed me they were Percocet's. I removed the bag that contained the white pills, and placed Steven in the rear of my patrol car.

I secured the pills in the rear of my vehicle.

While I was securing items, and looking over the vehicle, Steven attempted to talk to me. I read Steven his Miranda rights from my agency issued Miranda card, which he advised he understood and wished to talk. Steven informed me he takes the pills and smokes the marijuana for pain.

The following items of evidence were removed from Steven's vehicle, and Steven.

- 8.5 grams field weighed with bag of field test positive (FTP) marijuana

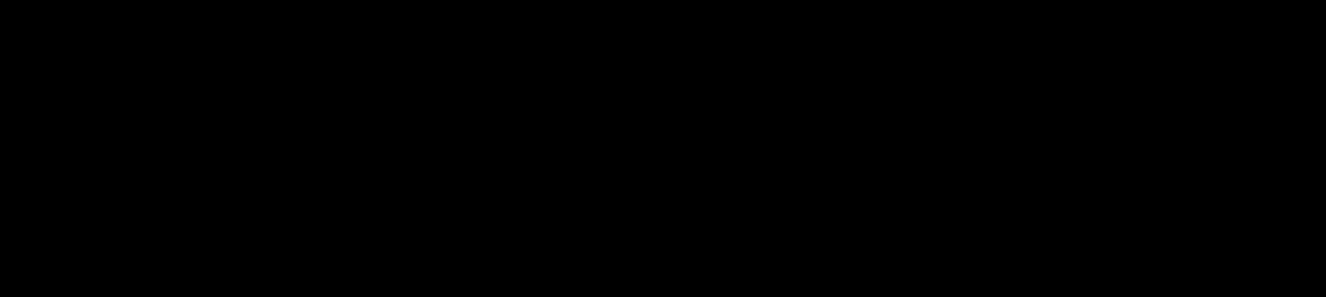

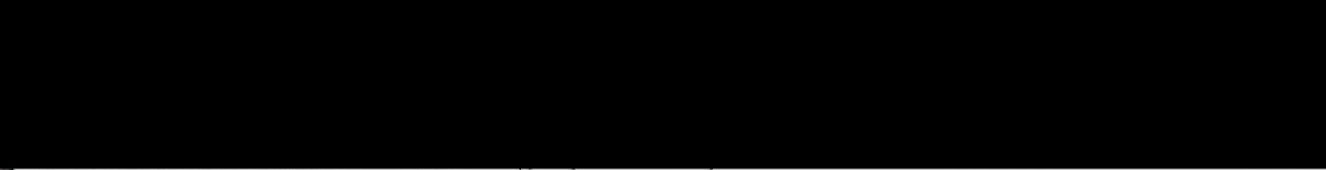

The undersigned certifies and swears that he/she has just and reasonable grounds to believe that the above named defendant committed the following violation of law: On 04/10/2026 at 14:38 (Specifically include facts constituting cause for arrest.)

VBPD Case #2026-0678

VBPD Det. Somoza's report:

On 4/10/2026, at 11:00 hours, I was requested to respond to [redacted] in reference to a child abuse complaint.

Upon arrival, I met with VBPD SRO Willis, who stated the following: On 4/10/2026, the victim [redacted] hereafter referred to as [redacted] came off the school bus in the drop off location at approximately 08:50 hours. [redacted] Gina Dipasquale noticed an injury on [redacted] face. Gina asked [redacted] how the injury occurred. At first [redacted] did not seem like [redacted] wanted to talk about it. Eventually [redacted] hereafter referred to as "W") said that [redacted] hit [redacted] this morning before getting on the school bus. At this point, Gina advised SRO Willis of the allegation as well as DCF. Shortly after, Beachland Elementary Vice Principle Dr. Jessica Keaton made contact with [redacted] Dr. Keaton observed the physical signs of injury on [redacted] face. Dr. Keaton asked [redacted] how [redacted] was injured, [redacted] said [redacted] scratched [redacted] this morning before getting on the school bus.

It should be known that [redacted] (defendant) is identified as Jenelle A. Brooks (DOB: 01/20/1995).

I first spoke to Gina Dipasquale (audio recorded statement) and she reiterated the information above that she told SRO Willis.

I then spoke to [redacted] Agnes Falvey. (audio recorder statement) and she stated the following in summary: Agnes [redacted] (the defendant Jenelle Rooks). Agnes was not present during the incident this morning because she left the house prior to the bus arriving to pick the kids up for school. Agnes did mention that the prior night, when she told [redacted] goodnight, they each did not have any visible injuries present. Agnes added that this morning prior to her departure at approximately 08:30 hours, [redacted] did not have any visible injuries.

I then spoke to Dr. Jessica Keaton (audio recorded statement) and she reiterated the information above that she told SRO Willis.

I then spoke to W (audio recorded statement) to ascertain facts about the alleged crime. W stated that this morning before the bus picked her and [redacted] up for school [redacted] scratched [redacted] in the face. W stated that the incident occurred outside while they were waiting for the bus to pick them up for school. W stated only [redacted] and [redacted] were present at the time of the incident.

On 4/10/2026, at 12:00 hours DCF investigator Samantha Hope arrived at Beachland Elementary. Samantha interviewed [redacted] in the presence of SRO Willis and myself (audio recorded statement) [redacted] disclosed the following: prior to being picked up by the school bus this morning, [redacted] was upset and struck [redacted] on the right side of [redacted] face. [redacted] said [redacted] used her hand to strike [redacted] face. Samantha asked why [redacted] was upset. [redacted] stated [redacted] was upset because V told [redacted] that [redacted] was stealing money from [redacted] [redacted] stated the incident occurred outside near their driveway.

I observed the following injuries present on [redacted] while Samantha spoke to [redacted]

- Along [redacted] right eyebrow: small red abrasions (consistent with being scratched in the face).
- Along [redacted] right cheek: small red abrasions (consistent with being scratched in the face).
- Along [redacted] right side of neck: small red abrasions (consistent with being scratched)
- Along [redacted] right eye: purple discoloration (consistent with bruising).

On 4/10/2026, at 12:41 hours, VBPD Ofc. Aguilar, DCF Investigator Samantha Hope, and I responded to [redacted] Agnes Falvey opened the door and allowed us to come inside to speak with Jenelle Rooks.

DCF Investigator Samantha Hope conducted her interview as it relates to DCF proceedings. This interview was captured on my agency-issued BWC. During this interview Jenelle disclosed the following in reference to this incident this morning: She stated that [redacted] was running around outside on the street. [redacted] made it to the opposite side of the street from their house. Jenelle tried talking to [redacted] to get [redacted] back closer to her. Jenelle then had to go toward [redacted] and physically grab [redacted] and bring [redacted] back. Samantha asked if maybe during that time Jenelle may have scratched [redacted] in the face. Janelle said she does not believe so and she does not scratch normally when she's trying to reach for her child.

Based on the above investigation, there is probable cause that Jenelle Rooks did commit child abuse against [redacted] on 4/10/2026. This is a violation of FSS 827.03.

**NARRATIVE**

On Friday, April 10, 2026, at approximately 1800, I responded to the 800 block of 43<sup>rd</sup> Avenue to assist Cpl Szott with an auto accident without injuries to which he believed the female driver was impaired.

Upon my arrival, I made contact with CPL Szott, whom stated that when he arrived, he requested the female, Irene Manasa, provide him with her vehicle registration. CPL Szott stated Irene continuously attempted to give him a large sum of cash in lieu of her registration.

CPL Szott stated as he continued to speak with Irene during his crash investigation he observed an odor of an alcoholic beverage and glassy-watery eyes, with a slurred speech. CPL Szott also stated Irene kept falling asleep behind the wheel as he was finishing his investigation. I proceeded to meet with Irene to conduct my investigation. I informed Irene that the crash investigation was completed, and I would be conducting a DUI investigation, subsequently advising her of her Miranda Rights to which she stated she understood.

As I interacted with Irene, I observed several physical signs of impairment: Glassy-watery eyes, slurred speech, and a heavy odor of an alcoholic beverage. Also, as I approached the vehicle to make contact with Irene, she was asleep behind the wheel in the driver seat of her vehicle.

I became concerned Irene was impaired beyond her normal faculties by alcoholic beverages or chemical or controlled substances.

To dispel my concerns, I asked Irene if she would participate in a series of standardized field sobriety exercises, to which she agreed. I asked Irene a series of medical questions to ensure she could participate in field sobriety exercises. Irene stated that she had no physical defects, was not sick or injured, did not have epilepsy or diabetes, did wear contacts and glasses; however, was not currently wearing them. Irene stated she had left Nino's Corner pizzeria located at 4300 20th Street, where she consumed one singular 6oz glass of wine with her friend.

All field sobriety exercises were explained and demonstrated proficiently prior to her beginning each exercise and I confirmed she understood the instructions prior to the start of each exercise.

The following exercises were performed:

- 1.) HORIZONTAL GAZE NYSTAGMUS – I instructed Irene to stand on the painted white line for the turning lane as the lane was blocked by a patrol vehicle for our safety. Irene was unable to follow instructions on numerous occasions. I instructed her to stand facing me with her feet together heel-to-heel, and toe-to-toe with her hands by her side. Irene was unable to put her feet together falling numerous times, and grabbed onto my arms to catch her fall. This continued approximately six more times before I stopped the exercise.

I discontinued the exercises out of concern for Irene's safety as she was unable to stand unassisted, almost fell backwards into traffic, and continuously grabbed my arms to maintain her balance.



NARRATIVE

On April 10<sup>th</sup>, 2026, at approximately 1850 hours, I responded to the area of 6900 US Highway 1, Vero Beach, Florida, in reference to a reckless vehicle.

While I was enroute, Indian River County Sheriff's Office (IRCSO) dispatch advised the complainant was following the vehicle northbound on US Highway 1, from 69<sup>th</sup> Street – the vehicle was a white Dodge Charger driving through the area with flashing lights in the front and red and white flashing lights in the rear. IRCSO dispatch stated the vehicle was stopped at the traffic light at 85<sup>th</sup> Street and US Highway 1. The vehicle then turned eastbound on 85<sup>th</sup> Street, eventually pulled onto Frangipani Drive, then stopped at a residence briefly. The Dodge Charger then left Frangipani Drive and began traveling westbound on 85<sup>th</sup> Street.

I was stationary in the area of 4900 85<sup>th</sup> Street (County Road 510) when I witnessed a white Dodge Charger (bearing FL/XLK552) traveling westbound on 85<sup>th</sup> Street. The Dodge Charger had flashing white headlights, as well as, flashing red and white lights on the exterior of the vehicle. The vehicle was also traveling closely behind the vehicle in front of it. I then pulled behind the Dodge Charger, and as I did so, the vehicle made an abrupt right turn onto 87<sup>th</sup> Street. I subsequently conducted a traffic stop on the Dodge Charger near 4400 87<sup>th</sup> Street.

I made contact with the driver, and sole occupant, Mr. Luke Clauss, who I identified by his Florida-issued driver's license. While speaking with Mr. Clauss, he appeared to have constricted pupils, and also appeared lethargic and confused. I asked Mr. Clauss where he was headed, and he stated home to Sebastian. When I asked why he was driving on 85<sup>th</sup> Street and Frangipani Drive, he stated he was lost; however, Mr. Clauss stated he had lived in Sebastian for approximately five years and had his GPS on.

Mr. Clauss also attempted to open his driver's door. I then instructed Mr. Clauss to close the door and he stared at me and continued to appear confused. He then attempted to turn the car off, however, it was still in gear. Mr. Clauss let his foot off the brake and the vehicle began to move, so I instructed him to put the vehicle in park. Mr. Clauss struggled putting his vehicle into park and I had to tell him how to do so. While continuing to speak with Mr. Clauss, he had difficulty concentrating and appeared uncoordinated.

Based on my observations, I requested Mr. Clauss exit the vehicle. I then requested he preform Standardized Field Sobriety Exercises (SFSE's), and he stated he would. During the medical questionnaire, Mr. Clauss stated [REDACTED]. He stated he does not have any physical disabilities.

The first exercise was the Horizontal Gaze Nystagmus (HGN) exercise. I explained the instructions and Mr. Clauss stated he understood. During the exercise, Mr. Clauss did not follow directions and would not follow my fingers with his eyes. When he did begin following my finger with his eyes, I observed lack of smooth pursuit in both eyes. Mr. Clauss then stopped performing the exercise, so I reminded him to continue completing it. I did not observe distinct and sustained nystagmus at maximum deviation or nystagmus prior to 45 degrees in his left or right eye. I did not observe vertical gaze nystagmus. However, during this exercise, Mr. Clauss struggled following directions. He was also swaying.

The next exercise, was the Walk and Turn (WAT) exercise. As I explained the instructions for the exercise, Mr. Clauss was unable to keep his balance. After finishing the instructions, and demonstrating the exercise, Mr. Clauss stated he understood the exercise and did not have any questions. During the exercise, Mr. Clauss stepped off line and missed heel-to-toe. He then stopped the exercise, and began again. During his second attempt, he stepped off line, took the wrong number of steps, missed heel-to-toe, used his arms for balance, and made an improper turn. While walking back down the line, he also stopped the exercise again before completing it.

The third exercise was the One Leg Stand (OLS) exercise. I explained the instructions and demonstrated it for Mr. Clauss. He stated he understood and did not have any questions. During the exercise, Mr. Clauss put his foot down, used his arms for balance, and swayed.

The fourth exercise was the Modified Romberg Balance exercise. I explained the instructions for Mr. Clauss and he stated he understood and did not have any questions. During the exercise, Mr. Clauss' eyelids were fluttering and he was swaying. He also lost his balance and almost fell over. He then stood with his feet apart and continued swaying. Mr. Clauss estimated 30 seconds had elapsed after approximately 66 seconds.

Based on my observations, Mr. Clauss was placed under arrest for the offense of DUI. He was placed into handcuffs that were checked for proper fit and double-locked.

During a search of Mr. Clauss' white Dodge Charger, I touched the center console in front of the cup holder. When I did so, the plastic cover appeared loose. After moving the plastic cover, I observed the corner of a plastic baggie near the rear of the compartment. I subsequently removed the plastic bag, which contained a large quantity of yellow pills. The adjacent cup holder also appeared loose. After moving the cup holder, another smaller baggie containing more yellow pills was located. Utilizing Drugs.com, the yellow pills were identified as Alprazolam. The total weight for both baggies of suspected Alprazolam was 94 grams.

A loaded pistol, as well as, two loaded magazines were also located in the center console.

During a post-Miranda interview, Mr. Clauss advised the pills arrived at his house yesterday (Thursday, April 9<sup>th</sup>) in an envelope with no return address. As I continued speaking with him, he further advised he ordered Xanax pills on the Dark Web from an unknown individual. He explained that he used to be prescribed various medications and he could not take care of his mother without the pills. When I asked why there was a small baggie that was individually packaged and appeared to be ready to be sold, he stated he knew it appeared as if he were packaging it to sell it, but that it was all personal use. He also stated he had last ingested one Alprazolam approximately 10 hours prior.

Mr. Clauss' was eventually transported to the Indian River County Jail, without incident.

Detective Miller, ID# 3059, also spoke with Mr. Clauss while at the Indian River County Jail. During another post-Miranda interview, Mr. Clauss advised he drove to Frangipani Drive to make contact with a male to purchase fentanyl; however, the

PROBABLE CAUSE STATEMENT

On April 11th, 2026, at approximately 0040 hours, I was conducting routine patrol in my marked patrol vehicle. I observed a grey Kia SUV bearing Florida registration DR41UA, traveling northbound onto Roseland Road from Sebastian Boulevard, Sebastian, Florida. I observed the vehicle fail to stop at the stop sign located north of the intersection on Roseland Road.

I conducted a traffic stop utilizing my overhead emergency lights on the vehicle which yielded to a final stop in the area of Rivera Avenue and Blossom Drive, Sebastian, Florida.

I made contact with the driver and sole occupant, Tiffany Ambrose. Ambrose provided her Florida driver license, registration, and proof of insurance. I observed Ambrose's eyes to be red and glossed over, and the faint odor of an alcoholic beverage emitting from the vehicle. I asked Ambrose if she had any alcohol tonight, which she denied and stated she just got off work.

I then approached the vehicle on the driver side and explained to Ambrose that I was issuing her a electronic written warning for the stop sign. I and once again I once again detected the odor of an alcoholic beverage emitting from Ambrose that appeared to be stronger once I was closer to Ambrose and while she was speaking.

At this time, I requested Ambrose to step out of vehicle which she complied. I instructed Ambrose to stand in front of my patrol vehicle with my emergency overhead lights still activated.

I requested for an additional unit to assist in performing field sobriety exercises. Ambrose agreed to participate in field sobriety exercises. Ambrose once again denied consuming any alcoholic beverages and was swaying as she was standing.

While waiting for additional unit in front of my patrol vehicle, Ambrose then began to walk away from me and towards her vehicle. I told Ambrose to stop and to come back, she was instructed to stay in front of my patrol vehicle. Ambrose continued to walk without an explanation and sat in the driver seat.

I asked Ambrose what she was doing and to exit the vehicle. Ambrose refused and stated she was going to call someone. I grabbed Ambrose's left arm and she immediately began tensing up and grabbing the steering wheel to defeat my efforts from attempting to escort her out of the vehicle. Ambrose continued to tense her arm to pull away from me and stated I was not allowed to. It should be noted the vehicle was still on and put myself in fear Ambrose was going to drive off.

Ambrose was escorted out of the vehicle and placed onto the ground. Ambrose was placed into mechanical hand restraints behind her back that were double locked and checked for proper fit.

I then advised Ambrose of her Miranda rights which she nodded her head that she understood.

Ambrose then stated that she heard that I was waiting for another unit, and then went back to her car to call her sister to come to pick her up. Ambrose stated she was not told she was detained and wanted to get her phone to make phone calls. Ambrose denied wanting to drive off. Ambrose stated to Corporal Keskinen that she knew we were police officers and were wearing uniforms.

Ambrose was then placed into the rear seat of my patrol vehicle.

Ambrose was then searched by Indian River County Sheriff's Office Corporal Moon, prior to being transported to Indian River County Jail.

Ambrose was then transported to Indian River County Jail for processing.

While at Indian River County Jail, Ambrose agreed to participate in Standardized Field Sobriety Exercises.

I then began by checking Ambrose's eyes, utilizing a small flashlight as the stimulus. I observed lack of smooth pursuit in both eyes, distinct and sustained nystagmus at max deviation, and onset of nystagmus prior to 45 degrees. I also observed vertical nystagmus.

I then proceeded to the Walk and Turn portion of the exercises, which Ambrose stated she had a sprained right ankle. Ambrose agreed to continue with the exercise. I explained and demonstrated the starting position to Ambrose, but then shortly after failed to stay in the starting position and had to be corrected. Ambrose stated she understood my instructions and was told to begin.

During the walk and turn, I observed 2 times where Ambrose's feet did not touch heel to toe and utilized her arms for balance by raising them above her sides.

I then began the One Leg stand exercise, after I demonstrated and instructed Ambrose on the starting position. Ambrose stated she still had a sprained right ankle and would struggle to balance on it. I explained to Ambrose she could use either

leg for the exercise. It should be noted I utilized my left leg for balance during my demonstration to mimic Ambrose's issue with her right ankle. Ambrose stated she understood my instructions and was told to begin.

At 0222 hours, Ambrose provided two lawful samples of her breath to determine its alcohol content, which yielded to 0.185 and the other at 0.178.

Based on the totality of circumstances I determined Ambrose was in violation of F.S.S 843.02, resist officer without violence and F.S.S 316.193(4) DUI 0.15+ BAL.

NARRATIVE

On Saturday, April 11, 2026, at approximately 0800 hours, I responded to Wawa, located at 1180 US Highway 1, in reference to shoplifting. Upon arrival, contact was made with the suspect Bobbi Fatz, who was already in Deputy I. McKay's custody.

The store manager, Fran Jennings, stated he observed Fatz remove (6) cans of Buzzballs and 2 bags of Sour Patch from the store's shelves and conceal the merchandise inside her bag. Deputies were able to apprehend Fatz while she was still inside the store. While deputies were collecting the stolen merchandise from inside Fatz bag, Fatz claimed to have purchased the items. Fatz was then issued a Trespass After Warning (TAW) and instructed not to return to the property, which she stated she understood.

After being issued the TAW and instructed to leave the property, Fatz was located a few minutes later sitting in the back parking lot of the store. When I approached her, I observed Fatz remove another Buzzball from her bag and throw it in the grass next to her. Fatz was then placed under arrest and secured inside the rear of my patrol vehicle. During a search incident of arrest, a bag of unused syringes and a \$20 bill were discovered inside Fatz's bag.

In total Fatz stole \$30.42 worth of merchandise from Wawa. Only the (2) bags of Sour Patch and (3) of the 6 Buzzballs were recovered. Fatz was originally in the company of an unknown black male, and could've possibly passed the other 3 cans to him.

Jennings stated the incident was not captured on the store's surveillance video due to where Fatz was standing and the shelves being out of camera view. Jennings provided a sworn statement on my body worn camera in regards to witnessing Fatz concealing the merchandise in her bag.

A criminal history query revealed Fatz's last conviction for felony petit theft was on 07/12/2023.

The items were returned to Wawa and Fatz was transported to the Indian River County Jail without incident.

 On **04/11/2026**, at **12:56** (Specifically include facts constituting cause for arrest.)

On Saturday, April 11, 2026, I was on routine patrol facing northbound on US 1 near Sebastian Blvd at a red light. While stationary, I entered the tag information for the vehicle in front of me into ELVIS. Upon querying Florida tag DK55WK, I received an alert indicating the registration was expired, which was confirmed via Sebastian Police Communications. I also observed that the registration decal did not match the information associated with the tag attached to the vehicle.

I then conducted a traffic stop on the vehicle, which came to a final stop in the parking lot of Speedway located at 700 US 1, Sebastian, FL. I made contact with the driver, who was later identified as Mark Brandes via his Florida identification card. I advised Mark of the reason for the stop. He appeared confused and stated his ex-girlfriend must have made an error with the registration. Mark stated the vehicle belonged to him, despite registration records indicating it was registered to a female. When asked for the required documentation, Mark was unable to provide a driver license. When asked if he had his driver license on him, he replied, "no." I then asked if he had anything with his name on it to verify his identity. Mark stated he had a Florida ID card and produced it. Mark further stated that his Florida driver license is suspended and that he is currently on a payment plan to have it reinstated. I asked Mark why the registration decal did not match the tag, and he stated he did not know.




Upon the arrival of additional officers, Mark was asked to step out of the vehicle. He was then placed in mechanical restraints, which were double-locked and checked for proper fit.

Post-Miranda, Mark again stated he knew his driving privileges were suspended and that he had started a payment plan a few weeks prior. I then questioned Mark regarding ownership of the vehicle. Mark stated he purchased the vehicle, but due to not having a valid driver license, it was registered to his girlfriend, Kimberly Klok, who is now his ex-girlfriend. Several attempts were made to contact Kimberly, but she did not answer her phone. Upon further questioning, Mark stated Kimberly was aware he had the vehicle and allowed him to keep it. When asked again about the registration decal, Mark admitted he placed a valid decal from a different vehicle onto the tag in an attempt to make law enforcement believe the registration was valid. The decal was confirmed to belong to a different vehicle owned by Mark's father. While still on scene, Kimberly contacted the Sebastian Police Department and confirmed Mark's statements. She stated the vehicle did not belong to her and that Mark had full access to it.

Based on the above, Mark was placed under arrest for driving with a suspended license with knowledge and for attaching a registration decal to a tag to which it was not assigned.

Mark was transported to the Indian River County Jail without incident.

NARRATIVE

On April 11<sup>th</sup>, 2026, at approximately 1836 hours, I responded to Donald McDonald Park, located at 12305 Roseland Road, Sebastian, Florida, in reference to a trespassing.

Upon arrival, I made contact with Ms. Kerri Lewia, who is the camp host. Ms. Lewia stated she received complaints about a barking dog at campsite #2. When she arrived at that campsite, she discovered someone was staying there; however, there was no one registered to stay at that campsite.

Ms. Lewia subsequently made contact with a male, later identified as Mr. Derek Smith, who was extremely intoxicated. Ms. Lewia stated she explained to Mr. Smith that he needed to create an online account, make a reservation, and pay to stay there. Ms. Lewia advised that Mr. Smith refused to make an online account and was refusing to leave.

I then made contact with Mr. Smith, who I identified by is Arizona-issued ID card. Mr. Smith appeared extremely intoxicated. As I was speaking with Mr. Smith, he was talking incoherently about not being a Florida citizen so he did not need to make an online account.

I also made contact with Mr. Steven Barako, who is the Park Superintendent for Donald McDonald Park. He stated he wanted Mr. Smith to leave, and if he refused, he wanted Mr. Smith trespassed.

I subsequently made contact with Mr. Smith again and advised him he was being trespassed from the Donald McDonald Park. Mr. Smith repeatedly stated that he would pay and it was unfair that he was being trespassed. I advised Mr. Smith numerous times that he was being trespassed and needed to leave the property; however, Mr. Smith refused to leave and continued arguing with me.

I subsequently placed Mr. Smith under arrest for the offense of trespass after warning. He was placed into handcuffs that were checked for proper fit and double-locked. He was transported to the Indian River County Jail, without incident.

It should also be noted, Mr. Smith was standing on a campsite at the front of the park when I arrived. There were multiple families and individuals in the area during this incident. Mr. Smith had also parked his vehicle at campsite #2 and had his dog on a leash that was tied to a tree – he later moved his dog to the interior of his vehicle. Additionally, Donald McDonald Park is a county park.

On April 11th, 2026, at approximately 2007 hours, I was dispatched to [redacted] reference to a physical disturbance in progress. While en-route, Sebastian Communications advised the complainant stated her brother was hitting her dad and was out of control.

Upon arrival, I made contact with the victim, identified as Emerito Hernandez. Emerito stated his son, later identified as Emerito Hernandez Jr, "snapped." According to Emerito, food was picked up for Hernandez Jr and brought to the residence. Hernandez Jr was informed of this by his mother, identified as Isabel Perez Garcia, over the phone. Upon being informed of this, Emerito stated Hernandez Jr stated to Isabel "you better tell that motherfucker not to be here," referring to Emerito. According to Emerito, Hernandez Jr was outside the front door, standing in front of where Emerito was seated on the staircase. Emerito stated upon Hernandez Jr's arrival back to the residence and approaching him, he was in an agitated state, telling Emerito "I'm going to fuck you up." Emerito attempted to calm Hernandez Jr by speaking with him, however this was unsuccessful. It was at this time that Emerito got up from the stairs and Hernandez Jr proceeded to strike Emerito on the left side of his face with a cellphone. No marks were observed on Emerito's face while I was speaking with him. Immediately after this occurred, Emerito instructed his daughter to call law enforcement.

Contact was also made with Isabel while on scene, who witnessed this occur. According to Isabel, as Emerito stood up from the stairs while her son Hernandez Jr approached him, Hernandez Jr was saying "I'm going to kill you." Immediately upon this occurring in an attempt to de-escalate the situation, Isabel stated she inserted herself in between Emerito and Hernandez Jr. While doing so, she was pleading with Hernandez Jr to calm down. Isabel further stated Hernandez Jr made a statement along the lines of "this has been a long time coming." After Hernandez Jr made this statement, Isabel stated she witnessed Hernandez Jr proceed to strike Emerito on the left side of his face with a cell phone while she was in between the two of them. Immediately after this occurred law enforcement was contacted by Isabel's daughter after being instructed to call. Isabel also showed me text messages of a conversation between her and Hernandez Jr. In this conversation, Hernandez Jr sent a message to Isabel that included the following statement: "I'm going to beat the fuck out of him when I see him," referring to Emerito.

Hernandez Jr's sister and Emerito's daughter, identified as Denise Hernandez, was also on scene. I made contact with her as well to which she stated she only heard the commotion going on downstairs. To be specific, Denise stated she heard Emerito say "he hit me." Denise was the one who called law enforcement.

Contact was made with Hernandez Jr on scene as well. According to Hernandez Jr, him and Emerito have been having ongoing issues involving verbal disputes with one another. Specifically, during this incident, Hernandez Jr stated his sister Denise brought a friend over to the residence which he was trying to engage with. Hernandez Jr stated his father Emerito became upset over this and threatened to call law enforcement. According to Hernandez Jr, he proceeded to pack a bag and go outside to avoid further conflict. Hernandez Jr repeatedly stated he was drinking alcohol and was under the influence. Initially, Hernandez Jr denied striking Emerito at all. However, Hernandez Jr then changed the statement by informing me he did "swing" at Emerito after Emerito swung at him. According to Hernandez Jr, Emerito swung toward his left shoulder and was struck there as well. No marks and bruises were observed on Hernandez Jr according to Corporal Keskinen. Hernandez Jr stated this occurred by the front door near the stairs Emerito was seated at.

Emerito, Denise and Isabel all expressed concern over Hernandez Jr's behavior and appeared fearful of what could happen in the future due this.

Based on the totality of circumstances and statements gathered on scene from all parties, I determined Hernandez Jr was the primary aggressor during this incident and probable cause existed to place Hernandez Jr under arrest for violation of FSS 784.03(1A1) BATTERY DOMESTIC VIOLENCE.

Hernandez Jr was transported to the Indian River County Jail without incident.

NARRATIVE

On 4/11/2026 at approximately 2300 hours, the Affiant responded to [redacted] which is a location within Indian River County, in reference to a Disturbance. As the Affiant responded to said address, Sean Mahaffey, hereafter referred to as the Defendant, notified Indian River County Dispatch that he was responding to the Sheriff's Office to turn in three firearms.

Upon arrival, I met the Victim, Jake Murracas, who stated the Defendant punched him in the face. Murracas stated the argument began in the backyard of the residence where he was attempting to start a fire in the fire pit. While trying to start the fire, Murracas stated the Defendant disagreed with having a fire in the backyard so he put the fire out. After an argument ensued, Murracas stated he attempted to start a fire again, which was put out a second time by the Defendant. Murracas stated he then went inside (residence) and punched the Defendant's laptop that was sitting adjacent to the couch and went into his bedroom and locked the door. As the Defendant came inside the residence, Murracas stated he heard the Defendant screaming about his laptop. He stated he then checked his bank account and noticed that money from his bank account was missing. Murracas, who was still in his room, stated he told the Defendant to give him his money back and he refused. Murracas stated he turned his speaker up really loud in his room and the Defendant came to the door and attempted to open it. He stated the Defendant then busted his door down close to his face while screaming at him. Murracas then stated to the Defendant, if you hit me you're going to jail to which the Defendant replied, "wanna bet?" He stated that the Defendant then punched him in his face with a closed fist.

I observed damage to the door jamb to Murracas's bedroom as the casement had separated from the door, which is consistent with forced entry. I also observed swelling to the right side of Murracas face and his shirt was torn from the neck. These observations were consistent with Murracas's account of events.

I then relocated to 4225 43rd Ave where D/S Moon and Estrella were standing by with the Defendant. The Defendant was then mirandized and waived.

The Defendant stated Murracas was in the backyard and starting a fire with a chair that he had destroyed in his room. Thinking this was inappropriate, the Defendant stated that he told him no, and there was back and forth yelling. The Defendant stated Maraccas said he would love for him to swing on him so he could go to the cops. After Maraccas disagreed with the Defendant, the Defendant stated Murracas does not handle "no" well. He stated he didn't like his "no" and insisted that it (starting fire) was okay as he had communicated with his mom who was working in Jupiter Beach who told him it was okay. After the disagreement, the Defendant stated that Murracas then attempted to start the fire, which he put out. He stated he attempted to start the fire again, and then he put it out a second time. From that point, the Defendant stated Murracas went inside of the residence and destroyed his laptop. The Defendant, who has access to Murracas bank account, stated that he contacted his wife (Murraca's Mother) and they both agreed that the money in Murracas account would be used to pay for the damage to the laptop. After speaking with his wife, the Defendant stated he heard Murracas start playing a high pitch noise with his phone so he went to his bedroom to check on him. He stated he tried speaking with him through the door and there was no response. He stated that he continued to try and engage with him through the door and told Murracas that he needed to come check on him. He stated that he then felt Murracas lean up against the door so he knew that he was okay.

The Defendant then denied damaging the door to Murracas room and denied punching him in the face. I then inspected the Defendant's hands and did not observe any offense wounds or swelling to his hands.

**NARRATIVE**

On April 12, 2026, at approximately 1935 hours I responded to [REDACTED] in reference to a Disturbance. While enroute, Public Safety Dispatch stated the caller witnessed a male and a female arguing, the male was hitting the female and left on a bicycle wearing a blue shirt.

Upon my arrival, Deputy Sibole locate the male, later identified as David Wheelus. I asked Wheelus who was the other party involved was; he stated Tabitha and she should be outside the next house. I made contact with Tabitha Jo Oakley Wheelus, who informed me, they all had returned from a fishing and were arguing over money owed to her daughter by Wheelus. Oakley stated that it turned ugly with insults back and forth between her and Wheelus over infidelity with a female named Danielle Cortes, who lives nearby. Wheelus made vulgar remarks which Oakley returned with a vulgar remark regarding Wheelus's infidelity with Daniella Cortes.

Wheelus then grabbed a bag of flour and threw it at Oakley, striking her in the back. Oakley stated, "why don't you roll the fat bitch in flour to get her wet". This made Wheelus angry. Wheelus then gabbed Oakley by her throat and said "ill fucking kill you cunt, ill slit your throat with this bottle". Oakley stated that she replied "all you can do is kill me". Oakley stated, at the time, she was not in fear for her life. After observing Oakley's back, it was covered with flour. Oakley stated that she has [REDACTED]

It should be noted that Wheelus had a beer bottle in hand upon making contact.

I then made contact with Wheelus and read him his Miranda rights, which he waived, and agreed to speak with me. When asked what occurred, Wheelus gave a very vague but similar story with several inconsistencies. First, he stated that he did not touch Oakley, then stated that he "Flung" the flour in the air and it got on both on them. I did not observe any flour on his person. He then stated that Oakley threatened him with a broom stick but didn't strike him, and later claimed she struck him on his left arm with the broom stick. I did not observe any visible marks consistent with a broom stick on his left arm. When I asked why he stated that there was nothing physical and was now claiming there was, he stated that he "was never physical with her".

I then made contact with Oakley again, read her Miranda rights, which she waived, and agreed to speak with me. When asked if she ever picked up a broom to strike Wheelus, she stated no. Oakley then went over the incident once again and demonstrated where she was standing when she was struck with flour and when she was grabbed by the throat and threatened.

Based on the statements provided, Wheelus actually and intentionally touched or struck Oakley against her will, therefore I find probable cause to charge David Wheelus with:

1. F.S.S. 784.03.1a1 Battery touch or strike, domestic violence, no bond.

NARRATIVE

On April 12<sup>th</sup>, 2026, at approximately 2046 hours, I was traveling northbound near the 13000 block of US Highway 1, Sebastian, Florida.

At that time, I was traveling in the left lane when a red Hyundai SUV (bearing FL/CH24EE) passed me in the right lane, at a high rate of speed. The red Hyundai was also unable to maintain a single lane - the passenger side wheels crossed over the solid white line multiple times. I also conducted an NCIC/FCIC query of the license plate, which revealed the female register owner had an expired driver's license, and the male registered owner had an ID card only.

I subsequently conducted a traffic stop on the red Hyundai near the 13700 block of US Highway 1. I then made contact with the driver, and sole occupant, Ms. Carrie Prevorse, who I identified by her Florida-issued driver's license. Ms. Prevorse was not wearing her seatbelt and appeared to have glassy, watery eyes, as well as, droopy eyelids. While speaking with Ms. Prevorse, she confirmed she was not wearing her seatbelt and stated she was speeding because she wanted to beat the traffic light and get around traffic.

Additionally, while speaking with Ms. Prevorse, I observed an open Bud Ice beer can on the passenger seat. Ms. Prevorse then stated, "And yes, I know you see it..." and held up the Bud Ice beer can. Ms. Prevorse subsequently stated she had "Just the one" drink tonight.

Based on my observations, I requested Ms. Prevorse exit the vehicle and complete Standardized Field Sobriety Exercises (SFE's) and Ms. Prevorse agreed. During the medical questionnaire, Ms. Prevorse stated [REDACTED] She also stated she does not take insulin, nor any other medications for it. Ms. Prevorse also stated she does not have any physical disabilities.

The first exercise was the Horizontal Gaze Nystagmus (HGN) exercise. I explained the instructions and Ms. Prevorse stated she understood. During the exercise, Ms. Prevorse was moving her head and swaying. I also observed a lack of smooth pursuit and distinct and sustained nystagmus at maximum deviation, in both her left and right eyes.

The next exercise, was the Walk and Turn (WAT) exercise. As I explained the instructions for the exercise, Ms. Prevorse was unable to keep her balance. After finishing the instructions, and demonstrating the exercise, Ms. Prevorse stated she understood the exercise and did not have any questions. During the exercise, Ms. Prevorse stepped off line and missed heel-to-toe. She then stopped the exercise, walked back to where she started, and began again. During his second attempt, Ms. Prevorse stepped off line, took the wrong number of steps, missed heel-to-toe, and made an improper turn.

The third exercise was the One Leg Stand (OLS) exercise. I explained the instructions and demonstrated it for Ms. Prevorse. She stated she understood and did not have any questions. During the exercise, Ms. Prevorse put her foot down and was swaying.

The fourth exercise was the Modified Romberg Balance exercise. I explained the instructions for Ms. Prevorse and she stated he understood and did not have any questions. During the exercise, Ms. Prevorse was swaying and estimated 30 seconds had

elapsed after approximately 41 seconds.

Based on my observations, I placed Ms. Prevorse under arrest for the offense of DUI. She was placed into handcuffs that were checked for proper fit and double-locked.

During a search of Ms. Prevorse's vehicle, I located the open Bud Ice beer can, which was still cold and had condensation. Three more closed cans of cold Bud Ice were also located in the passenger seat. The open can of Bud Ice was almost empty. Additionally, a clear pouch with a yellow-ish substance was located in the center console – the substance appeared to be urine.

During a post-Miranda interview, Ms. Prevorse stated the yellow-ish substance was fake urine that she and her son use to pass drug tests at work because they smoke marijuana.

Ms. Prevorse was transported to the Indian River County Jail, without incident.

Booking staff then requested Ms. Prevorse provide breath samples, and she agreed. Ms. Prevorse provided samples of 0.024 and 0.026. I subsequently requested Ms. Prevorse provide a urine sample, and she agreed to provide one. Additionally, Ms. Prevorse did not agree to a Drug Recognition Expert (DRE) evaluation.

Ms. Prevorse was issued three citations and one warning. The citations are as follows: DUI (citation #: AMOOCJE), open container (citation #: AMOOCIE), no seatbelt (citation #: AMOOCKE), and expired driver's license (warning).
