**NARRATIVE**

On April 23<sup>rd</sup>, 2024, at approximately 1545 hours, I responded to 160 9<sup>th</sup> Street SE, Vero Beach, FL, in reference to an indecent act.

Upon arrival, I spoke with the complainant, Tanner Quackenbush, who advised while heading towards the walk trail, Jack Jenkins and another gentlemen that was not identified, was staring at him. He stated while on the walk trail, Jack engaged in a brief conversation with him. Tanner advised Jack stated, "it's a beautiful day to be naked isn't it". After walking away in fear, Tanner turned around and observed Jack, with his pants off, exposing his sexual organ (penis) and masturbating, while looking directly at him. He advised he walked towards the observation deck to get out of the sight of Jack. Tanner stated Jack followed him to the observation deck and he ran back to his vehicle when he had the chance.

Before speaking with Jack, I read him Miranda Rights and he acknowledged he understood. Jack advised that he walked the trail and seen Tanner while walking. He stated he had a brief conversation with Tanner saying, "it's a beautiful day isn't it." Jack gave consent for a search through his phone to make sure no pictures were taken of the victim; no photos were found.

Public Safety dispatch advised that Jack has been arrested previously for the same act.

Due to the information above, I subsequently placed Jack in custody and transported him to the Indian River County jail for booking.

**NARRATIVE**

On April 23<sup>rd</sup>, 2024, at approximately 1000 hours, I observed a red in color sedan bearing a FL tag RCRC45, fail to come to a complete stop at a posted stop sign and the back windshield of the vehicle was not transparent, on the 4200 block of 27<sup>th</sup> Avenue, Vero Beach, FL.

I initiated the emergency lights on my patrol vehicle to conduct a traffic stop. The driver of the vehicle then parked in a driveway located at 2686 42<sup>nd</sup> Street. I attempted to make contact with the vehicle but the driver, later identified as Clarence Young, stepped out the vehicle without being told to do and was commanded to get back into the vehicle which he ignored. Clarence stated he will not listen to commands and his movements were aggressive. Clarence informed me that there were two other occupants in the vehicle identified as, Christina Rivas-Zeledon (rear right passenger) and Shanarra Sanders (front right passenger). I notified Public Safety Dispatch to request additional units and a K9 deputy. Both occupants were taken out of the vehicle for safety purposes, while doing so I detected the odor of burnt marijuana emitting from the vehicle.

Sergeant Curby arrived on scene and I informed him that the driver did not consent to search the vehicle. Sergeant Curby proceeded to deploy his narcotic certified K9 partner Bane. Sergeant Curby informed me Bane alerted on the driver side door area. Clarence spontaneously uttered that there was marijuana inside of the vehicle.

Sergeant Curby and I conducted a search of the vehicle. Inside, I located a cigarillo pack rolled up, under the driver side seat cover, tucked in a crevasse of the seat. Upon opening the packaging, I observed a white in color, powder like substance inside of the packaging. Based on my training, it appeared to be narcotic. I also observed a torch lighter in the front passenger seat, loose "Chore Boy", and a bent piece of metal commonly referred to as a "push rod" that is used in conjunction with smoking crack cocaine.

I then used an agency-issued drug-test kit, field-testing the white powder like substance. The substance, when fused with the liquid, turned into pink in color with blue dots which shows a positive reaction to cocaine.

I read Clarence Miranda warning to which he confirmed he understood. Clarence denied knowing the power like substance was under the seat cover of the driver seat. He informed me that no one else drove the vehicle.

Using my agency issued tint reader, I recorded that the tint of the front driver side window was 10% and the tint of the back rear passenger window was 3%.

Due to the above, I found probable cause that Clarence was in possession of a controlled substance (cocaine).

Clarence was transported to the Indian River County Jail without incident.

NARRATIVE

On April 23, 2024, at approximately 0735 hours, I responded to [REDACTED] regarding a disturbance.

Upon arrival, I made contact with the caller, Jackie D. Porter, who told me the following, paraphrased: Prior to Law Enforcement's arrival, she and her niece, Raven S. Williams, got into a verbal altercation upon her arrival at the residence in her mother's bedroom, belonging to Magnolia V. Figgers, who was present and witnessed. Porter stated that the argument was regarding an exchange of disrespectful text messages between the pair.

Porter then stated that the argument escalated and became physical when Williams went into her bedroom and retrieved a machete, approximately 24 inches long, with a black handle. Porter advised that Williams returned to Figger's room, punched her in the stomach, and in self-defense, Porter pulled Williams's hair. Porter then advised Williams swung the machete and hit her in the right shin. Underneath Porter's long dress, I observed a scratch mark on her right shin. However, she declined EMS.

I then spoke with Porter's mother and witness, Figgers, who corroborated Porter's statement. Figgers advised she yelled at the pair to stop fighting but, due to physical disability, could not physically intervene. With cooperation from Williams as to the location of the weapon, assisting deputy Deighan located the machete, which was positively confirmed as the weapon used by Williams.

I made contact with Williams, who told me the following, paraphrased: Prior to Law Enforcement's arrival, she was awoken by her aunt, Porter, who was banging on her window to open up the front door to let her in the residence. Due to Williams being asleep and not hearing her bang, Porter sent Williams several text messages. Porter said she got up, opened the door, and followed Porter into Figger's room, where the verbal altercation ensued. Williams said she became upset and went into her bedroom to retrieve a white pole and machete. Due to having a vision impairment and not wearing her glasses at that time, she stated that she swung what she thought was the white pole and not the machete to hit her aunt on the leg because Porter grabbed her by the hair.

I read Williams her Miranda Rights from my agency-issued card. Williams advised that she understood her rights and agreed to speak with me. Post-Miranda, Williams recanted the above-mentioned statement and advised that she did not hit Porter with the machete regardless of Porter and Figgers' consistent statements.

Based on the statements provided, Williams was arrested and transported to the Indian River County Jail without incident for the following charge:

-F.S.S 784.03 Battery (Domestic Violence)
