NARRATIVE

On June 8th, 2026, at approximately 0029 hours, I responded to Rack 'M Billiards, located at 13527 US Highway 1, Sebastian, Florida, in reference to assisting Sebastian Police Department (Sebastian Police Department case #: 26-1033).

While enroute, Indian River County Sheriff's Office (IRCSO) dispatch advised Sebastian Police Department made contact with a male in a vehicle that was stolen from Rack 'M Billiards.

Upon arrival, I made contact Ms. Jerica Cromer, who stated she and her friend, Ben (later identified as Mr. Benjamin Queen) traveled from Rosie's Bottoms Up in Brevard County to Rack 'M Billiards. After arriving at Rack 'M Billiards, Ms. Cromer left her purse and keys in her black Mazda CX5 (bearing FL tag RCQZ90) and went inside the bar. Several minutes later, an employee at Rack 'M Billiards advised Ms. Cromer that Mr. Queen was leaving in her vehicle. Ms. Cromer stated that she then began calling Mr. Queen, who answered and stated "I'm going to jail."

While speaking with Ms. Cromer, she stated Mr. Queen did not have permission to use her vehicle, and has never had permission to use it. She further advised she wished to pursue charges against Mr. Queen for stealing her black Mazda SUV.

I also made contact with Sebastian Police Department, Officer Venegas, ID# 420. Officer Venegas stated he was driving on US Highway 1 near Davis Street, Sebastian, when he witnessed a black SUV southbound on US Highway 1 at a high rate of speed. As he attempted to catch up to the vehicle, it turned eastbound on Martin Avenue, then southbound on Indian River Drive. The black SUV continued southbound on Indian River Drive to Coolidge Street, where the vehicle parked between two parking spots.

Officer Venegas explained that he witnessed a male, identified as Mr. Benjamin Queen, exit the driver's seat while speaking on the phone. At that time, Officer Venegas overheard Mr. Queen on the phone with a female that was screaming that Mr. Queen stole her vehicle from Rack 'M Billiards. Officer Venegas made contact with Mr. Queen and began a DUI and stolen vehicle investigation (see Officer Venegas' report for further). During his investigation, it was determined Ms. Cromer's vehicle was stolen from Rack 'M Billiards.

Officer Venegas subsequently placed Mr. Queen under arrest.

After arriving at the Indian River County jail, I read Mr. Queen his Miranda Rights and he stated he wanted a lawyer.

Based on my investigation, Mr. Queen committed the offense of grand theft auto.

The undersigned certifies and swears that he/she has just and reasonable grounds to believe that the above named defendant committed the following violation of law:
On 06/08/2026 , at 00:27 (Specifically include facts constituting cause for arrest.)

On June 8th, 2026, at approximately 0013 hours, I was traveling north in the 1700 block of US Highway 1, when I observed a 2024 black Mazda CX-5 bearing Florida tag RCQZ90 traveling south. As the vehicle passed me, I visually estimated it to be traveling at approximately 65 miles per hour in a 35 mile per hour zone. As a result, I immediately conducted a U-Turn in an attempt to catch up. It should be noted, this vehicle was the only vehicle on the roadway at the time.

Upon conducting a U-turn, I observed the vehicle to continue traveling south at a high rate of speed. I observed the vehicle abruptly make a left onto Martin Avenue. I also made a left on Martin Avenue and upon reaching Martin Avenue and Indian River Drive, I observed the vehicle traveling south on Indian River Drive. As previously mentioned, this vehicle is still the only other vehicle on the roadway. I observed the vehicle make a right onto Coolidge Street which I proceeded to follow. While turning onto Coolidge Street, I observed the vehicle attempt to park at a parking spot in the 700 block of Coolidge Street. The vehicle parked in between two parking spaces and the front two tires were completely on the sidewalk in front. Based on this driving pattern I stopped my patrol car and activated my right-side scene light.

Almost immediately after, I observed a black male exit the vehicle from the driver seat. The male appeared to be unsteady on his feet and needed to use the vehicle to stand up straight. The male pulled a phone out of his pocket and began to make a phone call. I exited my patrol vehicle at this time and made contact with the male.

Upon making contact with the male, I detected the strong odor of an alcoholic beverage emanating from his person and breath. The male's speech was slurred and he had glossy, watery eyes, all consistent with being under the influence of alcohol. The male was later identified as Benjamin Queen. I explained to Benjamin why I was making contact with him and what I observed. Benjamin spontaneously uttered that he did not have a license and that he was going to jail. Benjamin was placed in mechanical restraints at this time for the remainder of the investigation.

After Benjamin was placed in mechanical restraints, it was confirmed by Sebastian Communications after querying his Florida Identification Card that he does not have a valid license. Law enforcement database ELVIS and DAVID also confirmed Benjamin has No Florida License. Benjamin has had numerous suspensions for the following:



Once secured in my patrol vehicle, I spoke to the female Benjamin was on the phone with briefly, identified as Jerica Cromer. Jerica advised me Benjamin was drunk and did not have a license and took her vehicle from 13527 US Highway 1 (Rack'M Bar and Billiards). This information was relayed to the Indian River County Sheriff's Office to which Corporal Kramer responded to accordingly (IRCSO case#2026-60287).

While in the back of my vehicle, Benjamin became unresponsive and as a result, 4, 4mg Narcan's were deployed after numerous sternum rub attempts. Benjamin became responsive again shortly after and informed officers he "shot up" fentanyl and thought he was going to die. Indian River County Fire Rescue responded and placed Benjamin in the back of the ambulance. Sergeant Melius was in the back with Benjamin, and requested assistance due to Benjamin beginning to flail his arms and kick his feet, as well as making threats to him and EMS personnel. Benjamin was transported to Orlando Health Medical (Sebastian ER). Sergeant Melius stated the following occurred during the transport: "Queen also refused any type of medical intervention from EMS. I rode in the back of the ambulance with EMS due to the threats and physical resistance Queen was displaying. Queen was stating that he was trained for combat and continued to remove the straps on the gurney, threaten harm to EMS and myself, and at one point, got his legs loose and attempted kicking me."

Once in the hospital and in the room, Benjamin continued to be uncooperative and refused to be cared for. Corporal Revis and I advised Benjamin we were going to place his handcuffs behind his back again, which was followed by Benjamin threatening to fight us once the handcuffs were off. Benjamin attempted to kick at me and move his body forward, forcing me to hold his legs down and Corporal Revis to hold his head down. Upon the arrival of more officers, Benjamin's handcuffs were safely readjusted.

Myself and Corporal Revis began to escort Benjamin to my patrol car. While doing so, Benjamin began to tense his arms up and attempted to defeat our efforts of placing him in the vehicle. Benjamin was given multiple commands to stop however he failed to comply. Benjamin forced us to bring him to his knees and back up to his feet, which was when he finally was placed inside of my patrol vehicle.

Based on the facts mentioned above, I found probable cause to place Benjamin under arrest for violation of FSS 316.193(2B2) DUI, 322.34(2B) DRIVING WHILE LICENSE SUSPENDED, and 843.02 RESIST OFFICER WO VIOLENCE.

At the jail, I requested Benjamin to submit to field sobriety exercises which he refused.

It was later learned via DAVID that Benjamin was charged with DUI on 03/13/2023 in St. Lucie County (case #AGC7VIE) and refused to submit as well. Benjamin was adjudicated guilty. Benjamin was also charged with driving while license suspended on 03/13/2023 in St. Lucie County (case#AGC7V0E) and adjudicated guilty.

Benjamin was also subsequently charged with FSS 316.1939(1) REFUSAL TO SUBMIT DUI TESTING as a result.

NARRATIVE

On June 8, 2026, at approximately 0907 hours, I arrived at the Publix located at 810 South U.S Highway 1, in reference to a trespass. Upon my arrival, contact was made with Publix employee Jesse Richard, who advised the following verbally:

Jesse is a manager of the Publix. Jesse stated there is a blanket trespass for the Publix and all other businesses surrounding the South Vero Square Shopping Mall. Jesse went on to say this morning, there were numerous transients on the property. Jesse specifically informed me there was a white male sitting underneath a blue umbrella on the north side of the property that they had told to leave the property, but he did not. Jesse stated if anyone refused to leave the property, he desired prosecution for trespassing.

While on scene, a check of the blanket trespass was done via Teletype. Dispatch confirmed a blanket trespass had been completed for the South Vero Square Shopping Center, which included Publix. See case #2014-159006, which was requested by Timothy Vanderberghe.

I then went outside and made contact with the person Jesse mentioned above. I introduced myself as an Indian River County Sheriff's Office Deputy and informed the person, later identified as Donnie Goss, that he was being trespassed.

When I originally asked Donnie for his name, he provided a name of Mike Goss and for a date of birth, he provided October 26, 1968. I asked Donnie if his legal name was Mike or Michael and he responded with Michael. Donnie was asked if he had a license or anything and he said he did not have any form of identity that would have his name on it. Donnie was asked for his social security number and said it was [REDACTED]

I attempted to utilize the Driver Information and Vehicle Information Database (D.A.V.I.D) to check Donnie's information he originally provided, but I could not locate anything. I checked my agency database and found no information regarding a Michael Goss.

I asked Donnie multiple times to confirm his name and he provided the same information as he originally stated. I asked Donnie if he ever had an identification card of driver's license issued to him and he said he had a Georgia identification card that had been previously issued to him.

Teletype was provided the information Donnie originally provided me and everything came back with no records found. Due to the fact Donnie was previously warned by Jesse to leave the property and he refused to do so, therefore trespassing after warning, and the fact I could not successfully identify Donnie, I requested for any units with Rapid I.D to be in route to my location.

During this time, Donnie was informed that he was being investigated for a trespass after warning and still provided the same information to me when I asked for his name. At this time, Donnie was told he was not free to leave and I told him to sit on a curb in the parking lot. Let it be noted, when Donnie sat down on the curb, there were no glass items near him, there was only his backpack and blue umbrella that he placed on the ground next to

I went back to my computer to continue my investigation and D/S K. Montgomery had arrived on scene and assisted me with watching Donnie. As I was walking back to my vehicle, I heard a loud smashing sound of what sounded like glass being broken. I turned around and saw Donnie stomping on a glass cylinder object that was laying on the ground right next to him. Based on my training and experience, I immediately recognized the object to be a common tool for people to use to inhale or ingest illegal narcotics such as crack cocaine or methamphetamines. Roughly half the crack pipe was smashed by Donnie and I was unable to test it for any illegal narcotics due to the damage.

I immediately told Donnie to stop stomping on the pipe. Donnie stepped away from the pipe and immediately stated the pipe was not his and he just found it there. I told Donnie that was not true since I did not see it there when he sat down, but he denied it. D/S K. Montgomery reviewed his body worn camera footage and confirmed he could see Donnie take the pipe out of his backpack, attempt to conceal it, tossing it on the ground where the item was located when I found it, and smashing it with his foot.

D/S A. Munni later arrived on scene and utilized his agency issued Rapid I.D. The hit revealed Donnie's correct information, which was Donnie Goss, date of birth October 26, 1968, and he had a social security number of [REDACTED]. I approached Donnie about this and he confirmed Michael was his brother's name.

It was later revealed by Teletype that Donnie had been trespassed from the South Vero Square Shopping Center on July 16, 2025, by D/S A. Ballester. I asked Donnie if he was trespassed and he confirmed it.

Based on the information above, I found probable cause Donnie was in violation of F.S.S 918.13, tampering with or destroying evidence, 810.08(2)(A) trespass of a structure after warning, and F.S.S 901.36.1, false name or information to a law enforcement officer during an investigation.

Donnie was subsequently arrested and was later transported to the Indian River County Jail without incident.

NARRATIVE

On Monday, June 8, 2026 at approximately 1811 hours I was dispatched to 810 S US Highway 1 (Publix) in reference to a shoplifting in progress.

Upon arrival, I made contact with the deli manager of the store, Lorenzo Altamura who advised the following in summary:

An unknown subject, later identified as Annette Nichols has been coming into the store for the past few weeks and stealing the same one piece of merchandise off their shelves. The item in question is a \$6.49 bag of Banana chips. Lorenzo accuses Annette of coming into the store on 05/13/2026, 05/19/2026, 05/26/2026, 06/02/2026, 06/05/2026 and today 06/08/2026 and stealing a total of approximately \$300 worth of the Banana chips during the course of these aforementioned dates. Lorenzo was not able to access camera footage for downloading the evidence for all dates he accuses Annette of stealing the chips, however advised he would be able to gather the footage for us tomorrow. It should be important to note that due to this ongoing theft of banana chips, Lorenzo has limited the amount of banana chip stock he puts on the shelf to 6 bags. Normally, there is upwards of 15-16 bags he stocks on the shelf; however, Annette continues to take all of the bags she can of banana chips that he puts out on the shelf. He was able to show us footage for the incident that occurred today, and on camera footage I was able to observe and record via Axon mobile app the following:

A heavy-set white female wearing, a long sleeve green shirt, and blue jeans walking up to the banana chip shelf and taking all 6 bags of the banana chips off of the shelf and placing them in her cart. Anette can later be seen at the self-checkout lane scanning 4 bags of banana chips. Annette failed to scan 2 bags of banana chips, and continued to walk out of the store past all points of sale, totaling the amount of \$12.98 of stolen merchandise seen on video.

I made contact with Annette in the parking lot using the description provided by Lorenzo via Indian River County Dispatch, and she advised the following in summary during a post-Miranda interview:

Annette admitted to stealing the two bags of banana chips, and admitted it was a stupid thing to go to jail over. Annette consented for us to go through her vehicle to gather the banana chips, and it was discovered that Annette had previously gone to another Publix location at 1851 North US Highway 1, today on 06/08/2026 at approximately 1146 hours and purchased another 4 bags of the same chips. Inside of the vehicle, 13 bags of the banana chips were found inside two different plastic Publix grocery bags. Two receipts for the separate Publix locations were obtained for todays date, 06/08/2026 and it can be seen that each time only 4 bags were purchased, totaling 8 bags of banana chips Annette should be in possession of. Inside of the vehicle 13 bags total can be observed. Though one Publix location theft occurred outside of our jurisdiction, it should be important to note that this pattern of behavior of banana chip theft from Annette is a common occurrence. Annette admitted to her wrong-doings and stated she does not know why she is stealing something so stupid, its not worth going to jail over and losing her job. A follow-up investigation will be conducted for the aforementioned dates of past theft occurrences Lorenzo accuses Annette of committing at his store.

Annette was transported to Indian River County Jail without incident.

NARRATIVE

On Monday, June 8, 2026 at approximately 2200 hours I was conducting routine patrol when I observed a blue sedan fail to stop at the stop sign at the intersection of 10th Court SW and 9th Street SW. I was able to maintain visual of vehicle during the entire incident and initiated a traffic stop in approximately the 900 block of 9th Street SW. When I initiated my emergency lights, I was in the left lane travelling east, the blue sedan bearing FL tag# 45AHGC continued to stop in the middle of the lane we were travelling east on. I stepped out of my vehicle and advised the driver of the vehicle to pull into the median, due to us blocking traffic on the roadway. I continued my traffic stop and spoke with the sole occupant and driver of the vehicle, later identified as Sarah Ragan. While speaking with Sarah I could smell a strong odor of an alcoholic beverage was emitting from her breath. It was observed that Sarah had bloodshot eyes and watery eyes, and she spoke with a slurred speech. When asked, Sarah stated she did not have anything to drink, and said she does not drink much at all. Based on my observations, and her speech pattern I asked Sarah to step out of her vehicle to perform standard field sobriety exercises. Sarah refused to get out of her vehicle multiple times, and when I grabbed her arm to take her out of the vehicle, she snatched her arm away from me, stating "get the fuck off of me". Sarah was placed under arrest for resisting without violence and transported to Indian River County Jail to perform standard field sobriety exercises.

Before beginning the exercise, Sarah advised she had no physical or mental condition that impairs her ability to function as a normal adult.

HORIZONTAL GAZE NYSTAGMUS EXERCISE

Prior to attempting this exercise, Sarah indicated she did not have any medical problems that would have prevented her from performing the exercise. Her eyes were checked and they displayed equal tracking and her pupils were equal sizes. Sarah was instructed to follow the stimulus with her eyes only, keeping her head still. After stating that she understood the instructions, Sarah attempted this exercise. No resting nystagmus was observed.

The results of this exercise displayed 0 of the 6 possible clues.

WALK AND TURN EXERCISE

Prior to attempting this exercise, Sarah indicated she did not have any medical problems that would have prevented her from performing the exercise. Sarah was instructed to put her left foot on the line and her right foot in front of it with her right heel touching the toe of her left foot. She was instructed to stand in this manner with her hands to her sides until the exercise instructions were completed and the exercise demonstrated. Sarah was instructed not to begin the exercise until told to start. She was instructed to take nine steps along the line in a heel-to-toe manner. After the ninth step she was to stop and turn around keeping her lead foot on the ground, taking several small steps with the other foot to turn around. After turning around, she was to take nine steps in a heel-to-toe manner back along the line, in the direction she had come

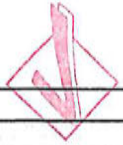



