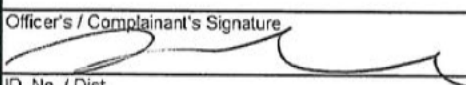
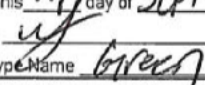
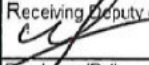

NARRATIVE

On September 14th, 2026, at 1144 hours, I responded to Dollar General located at 950 Old Dixie Hwy SW, Vero Beach, FL 32967 in reference to a disturbance. Dispatch advised that a male, Irving Harris, was beating on a woman. [REDACTED] Irving fled the scene after taking [REDACTED] cards from her purse.

Upon arrival, I made contact with [REDACTED] at Dollar General who advised that [REDACTED]

[REDACTED] originally advised that Irving and her were at a friend's house prior to attending the Dollar General. While at the friend's house [REDACTED] advised that Irving asked to retrieve a lighter from her purse to which she allowed him to. A short while after [REDACTED] opened her purse and observed her Moto G Cell Phone with a pink case, Chase Bank card, Florida ID, Uber debit card, and door dash card to be missing. [REDACTED] confronted Irving about her missing belongings to which Irving advised that he had accidentally left them at McDonalds located at 754 S US-1. While travelling to McDonald's to retrieve [REDACTED] cards, they stopped at Dollar General and an altercation took place.

At the Dollar General [REDACTED] observed her missing cards in Irving's pocket. [REDACTED] advised that she then went to reach for the cards and Irving grabbed her arm and twisted it [REDACTED] did not have any injuries to her arm that I observed. [REDACTED] advised that Irving did not hit her the day of and that all she wanted was her belongings back.

I made contact with a witness, Thomas Solomon, who advised that [REDACTED] and Irving got into an argument outside of Dollar General and observed Irving push [REDACTED] in the chest with one hand on two separate occasions. Thomas advised that [REDACTED] did not fall to the ground; however, in the moment of getting shoved, she was on a bike that almost fell over.

Thomas advised [REDACTED] walked away from the store to separate herself from the situation. When doing so, Irving threw [REDACTED] purse on the ground at Dollar General and Irving fled the scene on his bike. [REDACTED] then walked back to Dollar General to retrieve her purse. Thomas did not know [REDACTED] or Irving, identifying him to be an independent witness.

Dollar General did not have any camera footage that captured the incident.

After attempting to get the camera footage, I remade contact with [REDACTED] who confirmed that Irving did shove her.

Deputy Dyess made contact with Irving who was located at the 800 block of S US1. Irving was detained and put into mechanical hand restraints. Deputy Dyess advised that Irving invoked his rights and did not wish to speak to

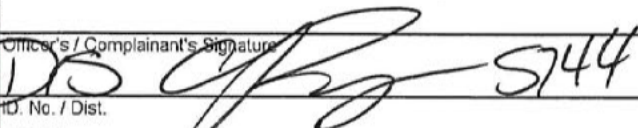
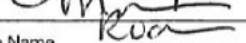
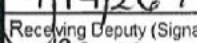

NARRATIVE

On Monday, September 14, 2026, at approximately 1700 hours, I received an alert from my agency issued ALPR.

The alert indicated a subject with a revoked license was associated with a blue Hyundai bearing Florida tag FNBA61. I then confirmed on D.A.V.I.D, the registered owner of the vehicle identified as Bernard Dejuan Ingram had a suspended driver's license since November 24, 2025. I was also able to view an alert on D.A.V.I.D to seize tag if driver is the registered owner and how there was no vehicle insurance on the vehicle.

I then drove along side the vehicle and was able to confirmed the subject listed as the registered owner of the vehicle was the driver and sole occupant of the vehicle.

I then proceeded to conduct a traffic stop at 8th Street and US Highway 1. The driver was asked for his license, vehicle registration, and insurance. The driver was confirmed to be Bernard Ingram by his driver's license. Bernard then proceeded to give me the vehicle registration that indicated his name, driver's license number, and his address (same address on his driver's license). I asked Bernard again for the insurance and he began looking through paperwork in his glove compartment. Bernard while looking for his insurance took out a paperwork issued by the Department of motor vehicles giving Bernard notice of his driver's license suspension to take place on November 24, 2025 at 12:01AM (paperwork had already been opened), due to lack of insurance coverage on the vehicle. Bernard was unable to provide me with insurance.

Bernard was asked to step out of his vehicle and asked to make a phone call for someone to assist him. While on the phone, the subject made a comment about the situation and Bernard replied by stating he was going to take care of it next week when he got paid.

Based on the fact Bernard had documentation in his vehicle from the Department of Motor Vehicle notifying him of his suspension (the fact the paperwork was opened) and the spontaneous utterance to the subject on his phone of meaning to fix the issue next week (also went to prove he was aware), I have reason to believe Bernard Ingram had knowledge his license was suspended.

Due to these facts of the case, Bernard Ingram was placed under arrest and transported to Indian River County Jail. Ingram was issued citation number ANUPOPE for violation of FSS 322.34 (2)(a) for Knowingly DWLSR.

NARRATIVE

On September 14th, 2026, at approximately 1852 hours, I was patrolling eastbound near the intersection of 74th Avenue and State Road 60 in Vero Beach, Florida, when I observed a black Chevrolet SUV bearing Florida temporary tag ECC2921. The temporary registration displayed an expiration date of August 29th, 2026.

I conducted a query through D.A.V.I.D., which indicated that there was no insurance information on file for the vehicle. The return also displayed a "NO DLS" alert, which, based on my training and experience, indicated that no driver's-license record was associated with the query.

I conducted a traffic stop on the vehicle and made contact with the driver, identified as Manuel Roman Garcia Lancero. I informed Garcia of the reason for the stop and requested his driver's license, registration, and proof of insurance.

Garcia stated that the vehicle had recently been purchased and that he was waiting for the dealership to provide the appropriate license plate. Garcia provided the vehicle's registration, which confirmed the expiration date listed above. He also provided proof that the vehicle was currently insured.

When asked for his driver's license, Garcia stated that he did not have one. To clarify his statement, I asked whether he did not have his license in his possession or whether he had never been issued a United States driver's license. Garcia stated that he did not have a driver's license at all.

Garcia subsequently provided several inconsistent statements regarding his driving status. He initially stated that he had a Florida driver's license. He then changed his statement and claimed that he had a Florida identification card. Garcia later changed his statement again and claimed that he had a Tennessee driver's license, but that it was inside another wallet at his residence.

An FCIC/NCIC query conducted through the Indian River County Sheriff's Office Public Safety Dispatch revealed no record of Garcia having been issued a driver's license or identification card in either Florida or Tennessee.

Based on this information, I instructed Garcia to exit the vehicle, at which point, I initiated an immigration investigation. It should be noted that during my initial contact with Garcia, he made statements indicating that he did not possess lawful United States documents. I identified myself as a Designated Immigration Officer assigned to the 287(g) Task Force Unit. Garcia indicated that he understood and continued speaking with me.

Garcia stated that he entered the United States approximately three years earlier by illegally crossing the Arizona desert. Garcia further stated that he later contacted immigration authorities, applied for asylum, and was awaiting a decision from United States Citizenship and Immigration Services (USCIS).

Based on the aforementioned information, I contacted Immigration and Customs Enforcement agency (ICE), and advised them of the circumstances surrounding this investigation. ICE advised that an immigration detainer would be placed on Garcia.

Garcia was subsequently placed in handcuffs, double-locked and checked for proper fit, and transported to the

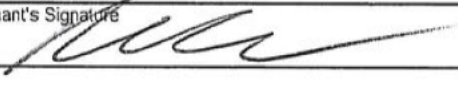
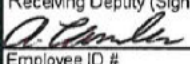

NARRATIVE

On September 14th, 2026, at approximately 1845 hours, I was traveling eastbound on 8th St., where I observed a black Jeep Grand Cherokee bearing Florida registration DL73JC. I drove parallel to the driver's side of the Jeep at the intersection with 8th St. and Old Dixie Highway. I observed the window tint to be dark on the front driver's side window, and making it difficult to see into the interior of the vehicle. As such, I continued to follow the vehicle until I could conduct a traffic stop. I activated my lights in the 700 block of Indian River Boulevard.

The vehicle came to stop at the entrance gate to Villas at Indian River located at 9 7th Pl. Vero Beach. I approached the vehicle on the passenger side of the vehicle. I noted the passenger side windows were incredibly dark and very difficult to see through. I conducted a window tint meter test two times on the front passenger window, which resulted in 17 percent. This is a violation of the window tint law.

I asked the driver, who was identified as Keith Fecke, for his license, registration, and insurance. It should be noted, Keith is the registered owner of the Jeep. Keith provided me his driver's license. While Keith was looking for his documents, I noted a black cup-holder style ash tray, which appeared to have a marijuana cigarette pre-roll on it. I also noted what appeared to be burnt marijuana cigarettes, referred to as roaches, on the ash-tray. I asked if Keith had a medical marijuana card, which he stated yes. He provided me physical medical marijuana card, which was expired as of July 8th, 2025. I told Keith his medical card was expired, where he stated he had an active one. K9 Deputy B. McKay arrived to assist.

I began to speak to Keith in reference to the pre-rolled marijuana cigarette on the ash-tray. He stated it was HEMP, and not a violation of Florida law. I explained from my training and experience I thought otherwise. While Keith and I were having this conversation he was looking for his insurance on his cell phone. I requested Keith to step out of the vehicle. Keith questioned why he had to step out and made no active movements to comply with our commands. I advised Keith a total of 3 times to get out of his vehicle, which he complied with on the 3rd request.

Keith was escorted to the front of my agency vehicle, where he continued to look for his insurance on his cell phone. He stated he had to download the app, which he was allowed to do. I radioed IRCSO Channel 2 Keith's driver's license, and requested a check on his medical marijuana card status. While doing this, Deputy McKay's K9 partner conducted a free air sniff of the vehicle, which resulted in a positive alert. Channel 2 advised Keith's medical marijuana card was expired.

A probable cause search of Keith's vehicle ensued. During the search the following items were located:

- In the front passenger seat, a black string bag containing \$31,200.00 USD, all in \$100 bill denominations; therefore, 312 \$100 bills.
- In the front cup holder, a marijuana pre-rolled cigarette which later field tested positive for marijuana-THC.
- In the center console, a zip lock baggie containing 8.9 grams of green leafy substance consistent with marijuana. This later resulted in a positive field test from heroin.
- In the rear passenger side of the vehicle a brown paper shopping bag which contained 2 vacuum sealed bags of green leafy substance consistent with marijuana
 - One vacuum bag was labeled "Galactic WN." This bag was opened and then field tested, which resulted in presumptive positives for heroin and marijuana-THC. This bag weighed 458.2 grams
 - A second vacuum sealed bag labeled "Oakland ..." with green leafy substance consistent with marijuana. This bag was weighed which resulted in 484.5 grams
- Of note a large box containing multiple business cards stating the following "High costal Exotics, Keith Fecke, Sales Manager" of a store located at 27 S. Dixie Highway, Lake Worth Beach, FL 33460. A google search of High Costal Exotics resulted in this being a marijuana/THC company. These cards were not seized, only photographed.

All aforementioned items were seized, photographed, and uploaded to Evidence.com.

Deputy Williams and I counted \$31,100.00 USD. The money was counted by K9 Deputy R.T. Williams and I, which was then secured in a brown evidence bag, and secure container. However, upon arrival to IRC SO Crime Scene a recount was conducted by Sgt. Farinacci and Deputy McKay. This resulted in \$31,200.00 USD.

It should be noted, the \$31,200 were separated from Keith's money in his wallet. The money was secured by rubber bands in stacks. They were not in official bank wrappings with dollar amounts as one would get from a FDIC Bank. This method of possession displayed by Keith is common in narcotic transactions, which I know from prior training and experience.

Keith was detained in handcuffs. He explained there was paperwork in his vehicle stating he was

allowed to possess the vacuum sealed bags of marijuana. We did not locate any such paperwork during the search. Of note, we located 4 pieces of what appeared to be lab testing of marijuana pre-rolled cigarettes, but nothing relating to the vacuum sealed bags. Additionally, there were no proper prescription containers in the vehicle with Keith's name labeled on the containers.

Keith was secured in the rear of my agency vehicle. I read Keith his Miranda rights, where he declined to speak. Keith was transported to IRCSO Jail.

It should be noted from prior training and experience as a narcotics investigator, it is highly unusual for an individual to possess 921.6 grams of marijuana for user possession. Couple with the possession of \$31,200.00 USD, this signals to me the large quantity of marijuana and the large amount of money, the marijuana is possessed with the intent to distribute. Additionally, marijuana packaged in vacuum sealed bags is know to me as the source packaging. Meaning, the marijuana is purchased at this weight, then distributed into smaller bags, such a sandwich baggies/corner bags for smaller user weights.

All evidence was transported by Deputy McKay and submitted to IRCSO Crime Scene. Additionally, IRCSO Wrecker/Crime Scene responded to transport the Jeep to the IRCSO Crime Scene compound. Deputy McKay followed the tow truck to IRCSO Crime Scene compound, where Crime Scene took possession of the vehicle. Sgt. Farinacci was present for evidence submission to Crime Scene with Deputy McKay.

Keith was read two notices, of seizure and adversarial preliminary hearing forms regarding the Jeep and the \$31,200.00 USD. A copy of each was placed into his property at IRCSO Jail. Keith ultimately signed both copies at IRCSO Jail. Keith was also issued ANHBD8E in reference to the possession of a controlled substance charge, ANHBDEE for possession of a schedule I narcotic with intent to distribute, and citation ANHBD9E for window tint violation. All aforementioned paperwork was secured in Keith's property at the jail.

NARRATIVE

On Monday, September 14, 2026 at approximately 1922 hours I was dispatched to 9050 Americana way, Vero Beach (Comfort Inn and Suites) in reference to a disturbance in progress.

Upon my arrival, I made contact with the suspect, Erin Cassidy outside of the business standing on the sidewalk. Erin advised the following statement in summary:

She had been staying at the hotel location for approximately a month and had a verbal disagreement over a civil issue. The civil issue in question was in regards to receiving back her security deposit for the room she was staying in. The room was not damaged and she wanted her money back. Erin advised the conversation was not overwhelming and did not feel like the cops should have been called. When the staff member told Erin she was calling the police, Erin continued to go outside and wait.

I made contact with the front desk staff, Melinda Boykin who was working during the time the incident occurred inside, she advised the following in summary:

She told me the same story as Erin in regards to the civil issue, however she said she was frightened by Erin due to the way she was being spoken to. Melinda advised Erin was not civil and was being completely irate and disorderly. One customer, Danny Woodard was inside of the hotel lobby during the time of the altercation and his peace and quiet was disrupted by Erin's manner of talking to Melinda. Erin was inside of the lobby of the business "irate" and screaming at her to give her the security deposit back. Erin did not make any specific physical threats towards her, however she felt threatened for her safety during the incident and wanted her prosecuted for making her feel that way.

I made contact with the witness, Danny Woodard who was still currently inside the hotel lobby, he stated the following in summary:

He was sitting in the corner of the hotel lobby when he began to hear Erin screaming at Melinda about the security deposit in a threatening manner. He is a military veteran, and has stayed in countless hotels in his lifetime, however he has never heard a customer such as Erin conducting themselves in such a manner at a public business. He came over to the counter to offer assistance to Melinda due to the manner Erin was talking to her. Erin was not making any specific threats towards Melinda; however, he was concerned for Melinda's safety as he thought something physical would happen at any moment.

No manager was on scene, or was able to access video and audio for the incident, and a follow-up investigation will be conducted to gather that footage and audio. Video footage of the incident was able to be shown to me on scene, and Erin can be seen yelling at Melinda. However, the audio is not able to be accessed without the owner on scene to observed how loud Erin was being. Based on my investigation and the statements from Melinda and Danny.

Erin was placed under arrest for F.S.S. 877.03 Disturbing the Peace (Disorderly Conduct).

In a search incident to arrest, two different items were discovered inside of the backpack Erin had in her possession. A pink

container, containing pre-cut strips of aluminum foil and a purple metal container with a white powdery residue on the inside of it. In a post-Miranda interview, Erin advised the following in reference to the two items in question:

The residue inside of the purple metal container was remains of Xanax and the container was used to store the Xanax. When asked how she attained the Xanax, she advised her boyfriend Chris has a prescription for Xanax and gives her some of his pills from time-to-time. The powdery substance was field tested and did not result in a positive indicator. It should be noted that my agency issued field test kit does not test for Xanax. When questioned about the pre-cut strips of aluminum foil, Erin advised she sells the strips of aluminum foil to pedestrians and people passing by her while she sits under the underpass of I-95 and State Road 60. In the past, Erin was continuously being asked by people for pieces of tin foil to consume illicit drugs with and had the idea to start selling them to people who asked. She started to offer the strips of aluminum foil for \$1 a strip to people who asked her for them. When asked if she knew they were being used to consume illicit substance, Erin stated she knew they were being used for drugs or whatever they wanted to use it for. It should be noted that inside of her wallet and on her person, Erin was found with 23 \$1 bills in her possession which corroborates her story of retail sale of drug paraphernalia.

Based upon my investigation into the two items discovered inside of Erin's bag suspected of being drug paraphernalia, Erin is being charged with:

F.S.S. 893.147.6 – Retail Sale of Drug Paraphernalia

F.S.S. 893.147.1 – Possession of Drug Paraphernalia / And or Use

Erin was transported to Indian River County Jail without incident.

NARRATIVE

On Monday, September 14th 2026 at approximately 2257hrs, I Deputy Finkle responded to [REDACTED] for a disturbance.

Prior to my arrival, the caller, [REDACTED] advised a Willie Tomlin [REDACTED] slammed [REDACTED] head into the wall and had a knife on him. Upon my arrival, K9 Deputy McKay #5941 had made contact with the suspect, Willie Otis Tomlin (FL-S437583950000) at the front door. The suspect, known as Mr. Tomlin for the remainder of this report was instructed outside where he stood by with other Deputies.

I entered the residence and made contact with three individuals. The first individual I made contact with was [REDACTED]. I asked him to step outside, away from the other subjects to speak alone. Once outside the rear of the home, I identified [REDACTED] and asked what happened. He advised that he was in the shower when he heard banging on the bathroom door. His [REDACTED] called him on the phone a short time later and told him that Mr. Tomlin was hitting [REDACTED].

[REDACTED] advised he got out of the shower and when he opened the door, he told Mr. Tomlin to keep his hands off [REDACTED] at which time he advised Mr. Tomlin held the knife up and pointed it at him. [REDACTED] advised that he did fear that Mr. Tomlin was going to stab him. He then [REDACTED].

I then made contact with [REDACTED]. He advised [REDACTED] Mr. Tomlin got upset because he opened the garage door for [REDACTED] after Mr. Tomlin had shut it. He advised Mr. Tomlin threatened to punch him in the face if he did it again. He then advised Mr. Tomlin went into his bedroom where he began to hearing yelling and screaming, as well as what he described as a folding knife flick open. He informed me that he cracked open the door and observed Mr. Tomlin chasing [REDACTED] around the room while holding out a knife.

He stated he called [REDACTED] and told him what was going on at which time [REDACTED] came out of the room and he heard what sounded like her head hitting the wall. He then advised he armed himself with a knife and stood by incase things escalated further.

I provided [REDACTED] with witness statement forms to complete. I then began speaking with [REDACTED]. She informed me that Mr. Tomlin gets drunk every night and when doing so, becomes aggressive, loud and physical. She informed me that this evening, she had gone to bed due to having to get up early for work. She was asleep when Mr. Tomlin came into the room yelling for her to "get the fuck up". She advised he continued yelling at her at which time he pulled out knife and pointed it at her, telling her that he would kill her.

He then began chasing her around the bedroom continuing to make threats and scream at her. As she

went to run out of the bedroom, she stated Mr. Tomlin used his hand and pushed the right side of her face, causing her head to slam into the door frame. Mr. Tomlin then heard that Law Enforcement was called and sat on the couch in the living room. Deputies observed a dark in color folding knife toward the bottom of a laundry basket inside the room, that you could visually see from looking into it with no manipulation of the few pieces of clothing in it. I was informed that the knife was shown to [REDACTED] o which she confirmed it to be the knife he had.

I responded outside and informed Mr. Tomlin of his constitutionally protected rights under Miranda. Mr. Tomlin appeared highly intoxicated. He was very unsteady on his feet, had a strong odor of an alcoholic beverage emitting from his person and slurred speech. He stated numerous times throughout the encounter, transport to jail and once at jail that he was drunk. Mr. Tomlin denied any of the accusations and only affirmed that he got mad over the garage door being open after he shut it. Due to his intoxication level, he was hard to understand as he spoke and at times did not make coherent statements. Due to this I was not able to obtain a verifiable statement from Mr. Tomlin.

I placed Mr. Tomlin into custody for two counts of aggravated assault and domestic battery. Once he was secured in my patrol vehicle, I responded back inside to collect the witness statement forms. Due to [REDACTED] still working on his, I began speaking to [REDACTED] about the domestic violence packets and victim pamphlets I provided to her. She informed me that she is in constant fear of Mr. Tomlin and when he becomes intoxicated, which is every night, he is aggressive and physical with her. She also advised that he had threatened her by stating that if she ever had him arrested, he get her.

[REDACTED] appeared very distraught as she spoke with me. She appeared genuinely fearful of Mr. Tomlin and advised she would [REDACTED] I informed her that she would be contacted prior to Mr. Tomlin getting released and informed her that I believed a no contact injunction would be issued to which she appeared very relieved. Deputy R. Thomas collected the knife and submitted it to Crime Scene for touch DNA on my behalf. He also completed two Domestic violence packets and threat assessments which indicated a high threat level.

I transported Mr. Tomlin to the Indian River County Jail where he was turned over to Jail staff. During the transport and upon entering the Jail, Mr. Tomlin was very belligerent, using profanity and making vague statements to Jail staff that if they kept putting their hands on him, they would see when the cuffs come off. He was shackled using a waste belt and chain as well as ankle shackles due to his behavior.

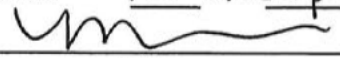

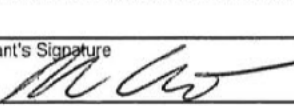

NARRATIVE

On September 15th, 2026, at approximately 0013 hours, I was in the area of the 1100 block of Old Dixie Highway, Vero Beach monitoring traffic. I observed a black Nissan Altima bearing Florida RLQL88 with a front-right headlight which was not illuminated/working. As the vehicle drove by me, I noted the rear license plate lights were not illuminating the registration plate. Therefore, I could not see the registration plate from the required 50 feet. I did not have my headlights activated, at this time, and I noted it was completely dark. I then pulled behind the vehicle, where it was passed the stop bar at the northbound intersection with 12th St. It should be noted, the light was red at the time where the Nissan's tires fully passed the stop bar. I activated my lights and conducted a traffic stop in the parking lot of 7/11 located at 1201 Old Dixie Highway, Vero Beach.

I approached the operator, who was identified as Austin Guitard. I informed him the reason for the stop, which he stated he already received a court date for the headlight violation. Austin stated he did not have his license, nor his insurance on him. He never produced his license or insurance paperwork. While speaking with Austin I noted he was constantly patting his pockets/moving around, despite already stating he did not have his license. I noticed he appeared to be extremely nervous. I asked if he had any guns or drugs in the car, which he stated no. I asked for consent, which he declined.

Deputy Gadacz and Deputy B. McKay arrived to assist. I returned to my vehicle to conduct a query of Austin's information. During this time, I noted through NCIC/FCIC, along with DAVID, the Nissan did not have a listed insurance provider.

Austin and his passenger, who was identified as Sophie Wells (16-year-old juvenile), were asked to exit the vehicle for a K9 free air sniff. While the dog was approaching the vehicle, Austin gave Deputy McKay consent to search. I was still inside my agency vehicle overhearing this conversation, where I heard Austin explained to Deputy McKay, he was nervous due to not believing he had insurance. Deputy Gadacz also advised Austin disclosed he did not have insurance on the Nissan. It should be noted, Austin had his phone on him for the entire interaction, where he stated he did not have the insurance on his cell phone due to getting a new phone.

A consent search of Austin's vehicle commenced, which resulted in no findings. Of note, I observed a condom on the driver's side floor. Austin explained he drove to Vero from West Palm to hangout with Sophie who he believed was 17-years-old. His story was complicated and when questioned did not make sense as he said he was leaving Vero but also just arrived to Vero. Of note, Austin said he had only spoken with Sophie for 2 days, while Sophie said the two had been Snapchatting for 2 months.

Austin was ultimately placed under arrest for failing to maintain motor vehicle limited liability insurance.
