The undersigned certifies and swears that he/she has just and reasonable grounds to believe that the above named defendant committed the following violation of law: On 04/21/2026, at 02:30 (Specifically include facts constituting cause for arrest.)

I, Detective Ayala #674, responded to the Indian River Cleveland Clinic Hospital in reference to a robbery.

I made contact with the initial reporting officer, Officer Dominguez #490, who stated the following in his report:

" On April 21st, 2026, at approximately 0226 hours, I, Ofc. Z. Dominguez, responded to [redacted] in reference to a disturbance.

Upon arrival, I met with two individuals in the doorway of [redacted], identified as Zachary Palmer and Susan Woodgates. I observed Palmer with a towel over his head, large blood stain on his shirt, and blood dripping down his neck and face. I then instructed both parties to exit the room and spoke with Woodgates first. Woodgates advised she was sleeping in [redacted] when she was awoken by two unidentified individuals rushing in and Palmer being struck twice by an aluminum baseball bat in the head. Woodgates advised she was then confronted by the unidentified female at knifepoint. The female subject told her to "stay back" while thrusting the knife towards Woodgates. Woodgates then claims the two individuals grabbed her purse and ran out of the room. Woodgates claimed she did not get a good look at the male suspect but that he was a W/M wearing a black hoodie and blue jeans. However, Woodgates described the female suspect as a W/F with a gray hoodie on covering part of her face, both fleeing in a white Chevy Utility vehicle.

I then spoke with Palmer who advised he heard a knock at the door and saw nothing through the peephole. Palmer then opened the door and observed an unidentified female holding a knife, but was struck in the back of the head/neck area by an unidentified male with a silver aluminum bat. Palmer then fell back into the bed, waking up Woodgates. Palmer claims the subjects rushed into the room while he tried to crawl away from them, pleading for help. Palmer claims the male subject was searching through the room while the female was holding Woodgates at knifepoint. The female subject then grabbed Woodgates purse and fled the room with the male subject following shortly behind. Palmer described the male suspect as a W/M bald wearing a black hoodie with white design and blue jeans. Palmer described the female suspect as a W/F with a gray hoodie on covering part of her face, both fleeing in a white Chevy Utility vehicle.

At this time, due to the suspects descriptions being consistent with two subjects I had stepped out with 30 minutes prior (Reference CFS #042126-4), I BOLO'd the description of the two suspects and their vehicle to other units. The vehicle was then located by K9 Ofc. Doty who conducted a high-risk traffic stop with other units. Two individuals matching the suspect description were taken into custody and identified as Michael Jackson Jr and Leigh Kennedy.

It should be noted that after my initial interaction with the two suspects (Reference CFS #042126-4), I observed the vehicle parked in the Sunshine Pharmacy parking lot (1995 US-1) in the minutes prior to this incident.

EMS responded to the scene and transported Palmer to Cleveland Clinic Indian River Hospital where he was treated for his injuries (EMS Run #2026-11130). Crime Scene Unit and Detectives were notified and responded to the scene. After obtaining sworn witness statements from the two victims at the ER, I returned to the Crime Scene [redacted]

This incident was captured by my department issued Body Worn Camera (BWC) and uploaded to VBPD Evidence Library."

I then spoke with K9 Officer Doty #434, who stated the following in his report:

"On 04/21/26 at 0237 hours, I observed a white Chevy SUV matching the description of the suspect vehicle traveling westbound in the 1800 block of 20th st.

I further observed a white male driver wearing a black shirt and black hat and a white female in the front passenger seat.

I got behind the vehicle and confirmed it to be the suspect vehicle. I conducted a high risk traffic stop on the vehicle in the 2300 block of 20th st.

While pulling over, I observed the front seat passenger female throw a purse to the back seat.

Commands were given to both the driver and passenger auto which they cooperated and were taken into custody without further incident.

I had no further involvement in this case."

Detective Somoza #626 conducted an interview at the hospital with V2 and stated the following in his report:

"On 4/21/2026, at 02:53 hours, I was requested to respond to Cleveland Clinic Indian River Hospital ER in reference to a robbery that occurred at [redacted]

Upon my arrival to the Hospital, I went to ER Room #7. I met with the victim in this case, Zachary Palmer, and his girlfriend (second victim, Susan Woodgates). I conducted an audio and video recorded (BWC) interview with Zachary, and he stated the following in summary:

On 4/21/2026, at some time in the early morning hours, he heard a knock at his room door. Zachary got up and checked the

peep hole in the room door. Zachary did not see anyone, he did not think this was odd. Zachary mentioned he has a friend that frequently visits him (Jordan) who would normally knock on the door and walk away to put away his electric bike. After a few moments, Zach checked the peep hole again and still could not see anyone at the door. Zachary then opened the door. As soon as Zachary opened the door and stepped outside of his room, to his left, he saw a female holding a knife toward him. He was then struck in the back of the head with a blunt object, twice. Zachary then noticed a male subject to the right of the door holding a baseball bat. The male and the female subject then entered the hotel room and began demanding money and jewelry from Zachary, and his girlfriend (Susan).

Zachary stated that the female subject brandishing a knife was near Susan within their hotel room. The male subject was searching through the room for money or valuables. At some point, Zachary saw an opening by the door and left the hotel room, with the two subjects and Susan still inside the room. Zachary went to another room (#26) and asked the female there, Monica, for help with his injuries.

While talking to Zachary, I observed him in a neck brace with blood stained hands and pillow which his head was resting on. During my time in the hospital with Zachary, I heard medical personnel advising that he would require staples on his head for his injuries.

On 4/21/2026, at 06:12 hours, I responded to the [redacted] (Room #22). Once on scene, I made contact with Monica Barton, who stated the following: Monica was staying at the hotel in room #26 for approximately 2-3 months. Monica is acquaintances with Zachary and Susan and is familiar with where they have been staying in the hotel. Monica stated that she did not hear any disturbance throughout the night. But at some point, in the early morning hours, she heard a knock at her door. When Monica opened the door, she observed Zachary holding his head with his hands and bleeding profusely from his head. Monica provided Zachary with a towel to help soak up the blood. She stayed with Zachary until law enforcement and EMS arrived.

On 4/21/2026, at 06:29 am, I made contact with Susan Woodgates. She consented to a search of her cellular device, which was cordoned off by crime scene tape inside [redacted]. I escorted Susan into the room and observed her locate her cellphone. She and I then left the room and I observed her search through her cellphone. This was in an attempt to see any evidence of text communications between Susan and the female suspect in this case. After reviewing the text messages alongside Susan, it was determined that she either deleted the messages from her "trash" inbox, or Zachary's cellphone contained any communications between them and the female suspect."

While on scene, I made contact with V1, who advised the following:
V1 and V2 advised they have been staying in [redacted] for the past several weeks due to family-related issues at their primary residence. V1 stated that she and V2 have been in a romantic relationship for approximately six years and currently reside together. V1 reported that during the nighttime hours, she was awakened by the sound of banging on the bed. Upon waking, V1 observed an unknown white male subject standing over V2, holding what appeared to be a baseball bat. V1 also observed a second subject, described as a white female, holding a knife in her hand. V1 stated that both suspects repeatedly demanded money, making statements such as, "Give us all your money" and "Money or jewelry." V1 advised that V2 attempted to defend himself while yelling at the suspects to stop. In response, V1 positioned herself over V2 in an attempt to protect him, at which point V2 was able to move away. V1 further stated that the female suspect approached her with the knife in an apparent attempt to prevent her from interfering. During this time, V2 observed that the door to the room was open and was able to flee the room. V1 advised that she then located V2's cellular phone, unlocked it using her fingerprint, and began dialing law enforcement. V1 stated that the female suspect attempted to stop her. However, upon realizing that law enforcement was being contacted, the female suspect immediately fled the room. V1 reported that the male suspect remained inside the room and began searching through personal belongings as if looking for items of value. After locating nothing of significance, the male suspect took V1's purse, described as a brown Michael Kors purse valued at approximately \$200, which contained miscellaneous makeup items and pens, before leaving the scene. V1 described the female suspect as a tall, thin white female with dark-colored eyes. V1 stated the female was wearing two hooded sweatshirts, one of which was multicolored and used to partially cover her face. V1 advised the knife in the female suspect's possession appeared to be a few inches in length, however, she was unable to determine the color of the handle due to the suspect's grip. V1 described the male suspect as a white male wearing jeans and a black hooded sweatshirt bearing a white logo on the right chest area. V1 advised she was unable to obtain a clear view of the male suspect's face.

V1 later advised that she and V2 have a history of drug use and had previously attempted to purchase narcotics from an individual known to her as "Leigh," later identified as Leigh H. Kennedy. V1 stated she initially met Kennedy at the same motel a few weeks prior and had communicated with her on several occasions. V1 further advised that communication between them ceased following an altercation, which occurred when Kennedy attempted to purchase drugs from V1 despite V1 stating she did not have any. V1 explained that after this incident, she has had no further contact with Kennedy.

While at the hospital, I was advised that Leigh H. Kennedy was located in Room #22 for an unrelated medical issue. I made contact with Kennedy and advised her of her Miranda rights. Kennedy acknowledged she understood her rights and agreed to speak with me.

During the interview, Kennedy provided multiple inconsistent statements and changed her version of events several times before ultimately claiming the following account to be accurate.

Kennedy stated she was with her long-term boyfriend, Michael A. Jackson, who had recently relocated with her to Florida from Ohio with the expectation of employment, which did not work out. Kennedy advised that all of her belongings had previously been stolen in Ohio. Kennedy stated that the vehicle they were traveling in had overheated and required water. Due to not knowing anyone in the area, they decided to go to the motel room where V1 and V2 were staying to request assistance. Kennedy acknowledged that she and V1 had a prior conflict, alleging that a few days earlier V1 had taken money from her via a mobile application identified as "Cash App." Kennedy was unable to provide additional details regarding this allegation and stated she did not possess her own cellular phone, occasionally using Jackson's device. Kennedy further stated that, due to her past experiences with violence, Jackson advised her to protect herself. As a result, she approached the room carrying a knife, while Jackson was carrying a bat-like object. Kennedy stated she knocked on the door, at which point V2 exited the room and began yelling at her while placing his hands near her face. Kennedy stated Jackson then struck V2 in the head with the bat, causing her to go into shock. Kennedy advised that, during the incident, both she and Jackson ultimately entered the room. Kennedy stated she heard V2 make a comment about being struck in the head. She further advised that she felt as though V1 was going to harm her, although she was unable to articulate a specific reason for this belief, and stated she held the knife in a defensive manner. Kennedy then admitted she realized her actions were wrong, became scared, and fled the room. Kennedy described the knife as an open knife with a silver blade and a white handle, which she stated she had purchased from a gas station at an earlier time. Kennedy stated she returned to the vehicle, where Jackson arrived shortly thereafter and handed her V1's purse, which she claimed she did not want. Kennedy advised that shortly after entering the vehicle, officers with the Vero Beach Police Department conducted a traffic stop. During this time, she placed the purse in the rear of the vehicle. Kennedy stated she was worried and did not want to get into trouble.

Michael A. Jackson was transported to the Vero Beach Police Department Detective Division, where he was placed in an interview room and recorded for further questioning. I advised Jackson of his Miranda rights, which he stated he understood and waived, agreeing to speak with me. During the interview, Jackson provided the following statement: Jackson stated that he and Leigh H. Kennedy are in a romantic relationship and had recently relocated to Florida from Ohio for employment opportunities. Jackson advised that he became acquainted with V1 and V2 during their time staying at the [redacted] as well as through encounters within the City of Vero Beach. Jackson stated that both he and Kennedy have a history of drug use and had previously sought to purchase narcotics from V1 and V2 on multiple occasions. Jackson alleged that, on several of those occasions, money was sent via the mobile application "Cash App," but the narcotics were never provided and no refunds were issued. Jackson stated that, knowing V1 and V2 were staying in the motel room, he and Kennedy went to the location without prior notice in an attempt to recover their money. Jackson advised that he brought a bat with him in case the situation escalated and he needed to defend himself, and that Kennedy was also armed with a knife. Jackson stated that Kennedy knocked on the door and was met by V2, who he described as aggressive and irate. Jackson advised that V2 began yelling at Kennedy regarding the money, although he could not recall the exact statements made, and then grabbed her by the arm. Jackson stated that he then struck V2 with the bat one time in order to prevent V2 from further harming Kennedy. Jackson advised that both he and Kennedy subsequently entered the motel room, where a discussion regarding money took place, however, he was unable to provide specific details regarding that conversation. Jackson stated that at some point, V2 exited the room. Jackson then began searching the room for money and ultimately took V1's purse, believing it contained cash. Jackson further advised that during the incident, he was not paying attention to Kennedy's actions and could not provide details regarding her involvement. Jackson admitted that he was not invited into the room and entered while armed, acknowledging that he had considered the possibility of using the bat. Jackson described the bat as silver in color and stated that he later discarded it in a dumpster located at the Burger King. Jackson described the knife as having a steel blade with a white handle but stated he did not know what ultimately happened to it.

It should be noted that the bat was collected by VBPD officers at Burger King located at 1928 US HWY 1 in the dumpster on the south east corner of the lot matching the statement given by Jackson.

I was able to obtain surveillance video from the [redacted] and observed the following: At approximately 0222 hours, Michael A. Jackson and Leigh H. Kennedy were observed walking through the parking lot in the direction of [redacted]. Kennedy was visibly armed with a knife in her left hand. Jackson was wearing a dark-colored hooded jacket with the hood pulled over his head and appeared to be wearing gloves. Kennedy was also wearing a dark-colored hooded jacket with the hood up upon approaching the room. Both individuals positioned themselves on either side of the doorway, with Jackson placing his back against the wall in an apparent attempt to conceal himself from the occupants' view.

At approximately 0223 hours, Kennedy knocked on the door. When the door was opened by V2, Kennedy raised her arm and pointed the knife toward him. V2 was observed attempting to lower Kennedy's hand when Jackson struck V2 in the head multiple times with a bat and then entered the motel room.

At approximately 0225 hours, V2 exited the room holding his head and covered in blood. V2 then re-entered the room. V1 subsequently exited the room and was observed on the phone with law enforcement while simultaneously engaged in a verbal altercation with Kennedy and Jackson. Kennedy was then observed exiting the room.

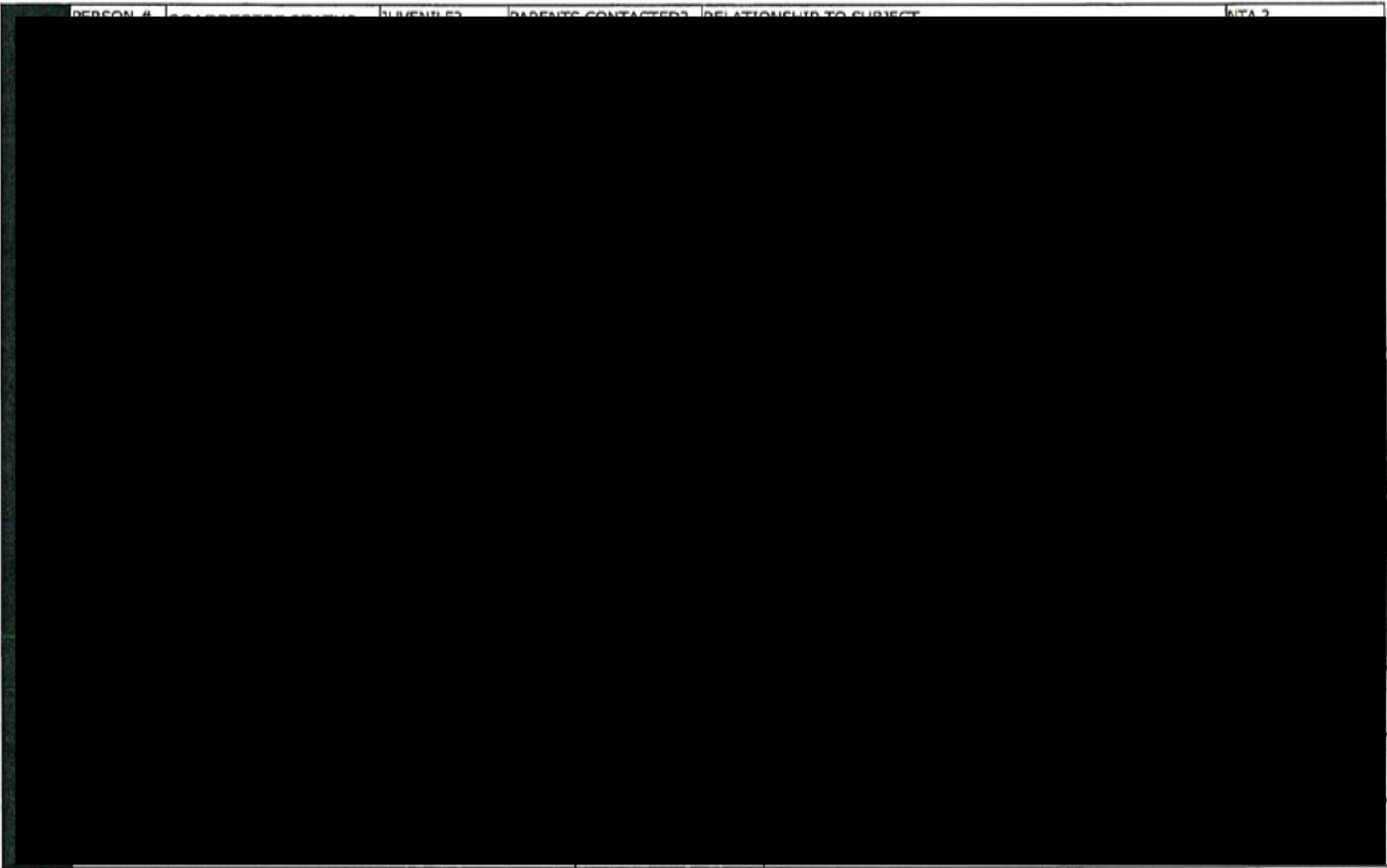

The undersigned certifies and swears that he/she has just and reasonable grounds to believe that the above named defendant committed the following violation of law:

On 04/21/2026, at 14:02 (Specifically include facts constituting cause for arrest.)

On 04/21/26 at approximately 1402 hours, I, Ofc Herrera observed a black female, later identified as Arlicia Ryan (D.O.B. 03/15/02 and now identified as V1) pushing a stroller containing [REDACTED] V1 was traveling westbound on the crosswalk located at 17th St. and 10th Ave.

I observed that V1 was being followed by a black male, later identified as Jacolby Dunbar (D.O.B. 05/19/87). Dunbar appeared to increase his walking speed and was now closing distance on V1. I then conducted a U-turn on 17th St and now observed that Dunbar ran up to up to V1. They were now standing face to face at the intersection of 17th St. and Commerce Ave. yelling at each other.

As we approached, Dunbar looked in our direction and began to walk away crossing over 17th St and headed westbound. V1 continued westbound on 17th St. Ofc. Aguilar got out of the vehicle and walked westbound to meet with V1. I began driving westbound on 17th St. and conducted another U-turn and parked next to V1 and Ofc Aguilar.

Ofc Aguilar was then able to speak with V1, across the street from 1225 16th St. V1 then informed that there was an active protection order issued by a local judge and that she was the protected person. Ofc Aguilar informed Officer Amburgey who was arriving on scene. He asked Ofc. Amburgey to detain Dunbar pending the investigation.

I observed in the distance that Ofc. Amburgey was speaking with Dunbar who continued walking westbound on 17th St. I observed that Ofc. Amburgey was walking alongside Dunbar and now approaching the intersection of 17th St. and Old Dixie Hwy. I observed that Dunbar was flailing his arms at Ofc. Amburgey in frustration. I then observed Dunbar making quick, intentional movements towards Ofc. Amburgey as if to make him flinch. Ofc. Amburgey and Dunbar continued walking southbound on Old Dixie Hwy out of view. Ofc. Aguillar headed towards Ofc Amburgey and Dunbar.

Ofc Aguilar informed me that he approached their location and grabbed Dunbar from behind and informed that he was not free to leave. Dunbar continued to scream profanities at officers and refused to identify himself. I confirmed with V1 and Vero Beach Communications that she was the protected person in Indian River County Court Case (#25000830DV11, Domestic Violence).

Condition #1 for the above-mentioned in which V1 is the protected person and Dunbar the respondent, (The subject is restrained from assaulting, threatening, abducting, harassing, following, interfering with, or stalking the protected person and or the child of the protected person).

Condition #5 (The subject is restrained from communicating with the protected person including but not limited to, personal, written, or telephone contact, or anyone with whom the communication would be likely to cause annoyance or alarm the victim).

Dunbar was then placed under arrest for 3-counts [REDACTED] violation of F.S.S. 741.31. (4a) Violation of a Domestic violence protection order and F.S.S. 843.02 Resisting without Violence then transported to the Indian River County Jail. While enroute to the jail and upon arriving inside the sally port, Dunbar was located in the prisoner compartment and began kicking the rear passenger prisoner window multiple times. This delayed his removal from the vehicle, as the Indian River County Jail was required to gather more man power due to his disruptive behavior. Dunbar also stated that, "If I had a gun right now Id shoot you bitch ass nigga" and "I hope you die a terrible death". Dunbar made multiple similar comments and eventually had to be strapped to a restraint chair by Booking staff at the Indian River County Jail.

PROBABLE CAUSE STATEMENT

I, Detective Ayala #674, responded to the Indian River Cleveland Clinic Hospital in reference to a robbery.

I made contact with the initial reporting officer, Officer Dominguez #490, who stated the following in his report:

"On April 21st, 2026, at approximately 0226 hours, I, Ofc. Z. Dominguez, responded to [redacted] in reference to a disturbance.

Upon arrival, I met with two individuals in the doorway of [redacted], identified as Zachary Palmer and Susan Woodgates. I observed Palmer with a towel over his head, large blood stain on his shirt, and blood dripping down his neck and face. I then instructed both parties to exit the room and spoke with Woodgates first. Woodgates advised she was sleeping in [redacted] when she was awoken by two unidentified individuals rushing in and Palmer being struck twice by an aluminum baseball bat in the head. Woodgates advised she was then confronted by the unidentified female at knifepoint. The female subject told her to "stay back" while thrusting the knife towards Woodgates. Woodgates then claims the two individuals grabbed her purse and ran out of the room. Woodgates claimed she did not get a good look at the male suspect but that he was a W/M wearing a black hoodie and blue jeans. However, Woodgates described the female suspect as a W/F with a gray hoodie on covering part of her face, both fleeing in a white Chevy Utility vehicle.

I then spoke with Palmer who advised he heard a knock at the door and saw nothing through the peephole. Palmer then opened the door and observed an unidentified female holding a knife, but was struck in the back of the head/neck area by an unidentified male with a silver aluminum bat. Palmer then fell back into the bed, waking up Woodgates. Palmer claims the subjects rushed into the room while he tried to crawl away from them, pleading for help. Palmer claims the male subject was searching through the room while the female was holding Woodgates at knifepoint. The female subject then grabbed Woodgates purse and fled the room with the male subject following shortly behind. Palmer described the male suspect as a W/M bald wearing a black hoodie with white design and blue jeans. Palmer described the female suspect as a W/F with a gray hoodie on covering part of her face, both fleeing in a white Chevy Utility vehicle.

At this time, due to the suspects descriptions being consistent with two subjects I had stepped out with 30 minutes prior (Reference CFS #042126-4), I BOLO'd the description of the two suspects and their vehicle to other units. The vehicle was then located by K9 Ofc. Doty who conducted a high-risk traffic stop with other units. Two individuals matching the suspect description were taken into custody and identified as Michael Jackson Jr and Leigh Kennedy.

It should be noted that after my initial interaction with the two suspects (Reference CFS #042126-4), I observed the vehicle parked in the Sunshine Pharmacy parking lot (1995 US-1) in the minutes prior to this incident.

EMS responded to the scene and transported Palmer to Cleveland Clinic Indian River Hospital where he was treated for his injuries (EMS Run #2026-11130). Crime Scene Unit and Detectives were notified and responded to the scene. After obtaining sworn witness statements from the two victims at the ER, I returned to the Crime Scene [redacted]

This incident was captured by my department issued Body Worn Camera (BWC) and uploaded to VBPD Evidence Library."

I then spoke with K9 Officer Doty #434, who stated the following in his report:

"On 04/21/26 at 0237 hours, I observed a white Chevy SUV matching the description of the suspect vehicle traveling westbound in the 1800 block of 20th st.

I further observed a white male driver wearing a black shirt and black hat and a white female in the front passenger seat.

I got behind the vehicle and confirmed it to be the suspect vehicle. I conducted a high risk traffic stop on the vehicle in the 2300 block of 20th st.

While pulling over, I observed the front seat passenger female throw a purse to the back seat.

Commands were given to both the driver and passenger auto which they cooperated and were taken into custody without further incident.

I had no further involvement in this case."

Detective Somoza #626 conducted an interview at the hospital with V2 and stated the following in his report:

"On 4/21/2026, at 02:53 hours, I was requested to respond to Cleveland Clinic Indian River Hospital ER in reference to a robbery that occurred at [redacted]

Upon my arrival to the Hospital, I went to ER Room #7. I met with the victim in this case, Zachary Palmer, and his girlfriend (second victim, Susan Woodgates). I conducted an audio and video recorded (BWC) interview with Zachary, and he stated the following in summary:

On 4/21/2026, at some time in the early morning hours, he heard a knock at his room door. Zachary got up and checked the

peep hole in the room door. Zachary did not see anyone, he did not think this was odd. Zachary mentioned he has a friend that frequently visits him (Jordan) who would normally knock on the door and walk away to put away his electric bike. After a few moments, Zach checked the peep hole again and still could not see anyone at the door. Zachary then opened the door. As soon as Zachary opened the door and stepped outside of his room, to his left, he saw a female holding a knife toward him. He was then struck in the back of the head with a blunt object, twice. Zachary then noticed a male subject to the right of the door holding a baseball bat. The male and the female subject then entered the hotel room and began demanding money and jewelry from Zachary, and his girlfriend (Susan).

Zachary stated that the female subject brandishing a knife was near Susan within their hotel room. The male subject was searching through the room for money or valuables. At some point, Zachary saw an opening by the door and left the hotel room, with the two subjects and Susan still inside the room. Zachary went to another room (#26) and asked the female there, Monica, for help with his injuries.

While talking to Zachary, I observed him in a neck brace with blood stained hands and pillow which his head was resting on. During my time in the hospital with Zachary, I heard medical personnel advising that he would require staples on his head for his injuries.

On 4/21/2026, at 06:12 hours, I responded to the [redacted] Room #22). Once on scene, I made contact with Monica Barton, who stated the following: Monica was staying at the hotel in room #26 for approximately 2-3 months. Monica is acquaintances with Zachary and Susan and is familiar with where they have been staying in the hotel. Monica stated that she did not hear any disturbance throughout the night. But at some point, in the early morning hours, she heard a knock at her door. When Monica opened the door, she observed Zachary holding his head with his hands and bleeding profusely from his head. Monica provided Zachary with a towel to help soak up the blood. She stayed with Zachary until law enforcement and EMS arrived.

On 4/21/2026, at 06:29 am, I made contact with Susan Woodgates. She consented to a search of her cellular device, which was cordoned off by crime scene tape inside [redacted]. I escorted Susan into the room and observed her locate her cellphone. She and I then left the room and I observed her search through her cellphone. This was in an attempt to see any evidence of text communications between Susan and the female suspect in this case. After reviewing the text messages alongside Susan, it was determined that she either deleted the messages from her "trash" inbox, or Zachary's cellphone contained any communications between them and the female suspect."

While on scene, I made contact with V1, who advised the following:
V1 and V2 advised they have been staying in [redacted] at the [redacted]), for the past several weeks due to family-related issues at their primary residence. V1 stated that she and V2 have been in a romantic relationship for approximately six years and currently reside together. V1 reported that during the nighttime hours, she was awakened by the sound of banging on the bed. Upon waking, V1 observed an unknown white male subject standing over V2, holding what appeared to be a baseball bat. V1 also observed a second subject, described as a white female, holding a knife in her hand. V1 stated that both suspects repeatedly demanded money, making statements such as, "Give us all your money" and "Money or jewelry." V1 advised that V2 attempted to defend himself while yelling at the suspects to stop. In response, V1 positioned herself over V2 in an attempt to protect him, at which point V2 was able to move away. V1 further stated that the female suspect approached her with the knife in an apparent attempt to prevent her from interfering. During this time, V2 observed that the door to the room was open and was able to flee the room. V1 advised that she then located V2's cellular phone, unlocked it using her fingerprint, and began dialing law enforcement. V1 stated that the female suspect attempted to stop her. However, upon realizing that law enforcement was being contacted, the female suspect immediately fled the room. V1 reported that the male suspect remained inside the room and began searching through personal belongings as if looking for items of value. After locating nothing of significance, the male suspect took V1's purse, described as a brown Michael Kors purse valued at approximately \$200, which contained miscellaneous makeup items and pens, before leaving the scene. V1 described the female suspect as a tall, thin white female with dark-colored eyes. V1 stated the female was wearing two hooded sweatshirts, one of which was multicolored and used to partially cover her face. V1 advised the knife in the female suspect's possession appeared to be a few inches in length, however, she was unable to determine the color of the handle due to the suspect's grip. V1 described the male suspect as a white male wearing jeans and a black hooded sweatshirt bearing a white logo on the right chest area. V1 advised she was unable to obtain a clear view of the male suspect's face.

V1 later advised that she and V2 have a history of drug use and had previously attempted to purchase narcotics from an individual known to her as "Leigh," later identified as Leigh H. Kennedy. V1 stated she initially met Kennedy at the same motel a few weeks prior and had communicated with her on several occasions. V1 further advised that communication between them ceased following an altercation, which occurred when Kennedy attempted to purchase drugs from V1 despite V1 stating she did not have any. V1 explained that after this incident, she has had no further contact with Kennedy.

While at the hospital, I was advised that Leigh H. Kennedy was located in Room #22 for an unrelated medical issue. I made contact with Kennedy and advised her of her Miranda rights. Kennedy acknowledged she understood her rights and agreed to speak with me.

PROBABLE CAUSE STATEMENT

During the interview, Kennedy provided multiple inconsistent statements and changed her version of events several times before ultimately claiming the following account to be accurate.

Kennedy stated she was with her long-term boyfriend, Michael A. Jackson, who had recently relocated with her to Florida from Ohio with the expectation of employment, which did not work out. Kennedy advised that all of her belongings had previously been stolen in Ohio. Kennedy stated that the vehicle they were traveling in had overheated and required water. Due to not knowing anyone in the area, they decided to go to the motel room where V1 and V2 were staying to request assistance. Kennedy acknowledged that she and V1 had a prior conflict, alleging that a few days earlier V1 had taken money from her via a mobile application identified as "Cash App." Kennedy was unable to provide additional details regarding this allegation and stated she did not possess her own cellular phone, occasionally using Jackson's device. Kennedy further stated that, due to her past experiences with violence, Jackson advised her to protect herself. As a result, she approached the room carrying a knife, while Jackson was carrying a bat-like object. Kennedy stated she knocked on the door, at which point V2 exited the room and began yelling at her while placing his hands near her face. Kennedy stated Jackson then struck V2 in the head with the bat, causing her to go into shock. Kennedy advised that, during the incident, both she and Jackson ultimately entered the room. Kennedy stated she heard V2 make a comment about being struck in the head. She further advised that she felt as though V1 was going to harm her, although she was unable to articulate a specific reason for this belief, and stated she held the knife in a defensive manner. Kennedy then admitted she realized her actions were wrong, became scared, and fled the room. Kennedy described the knife as an open knife with a silver blade and a white handle, which she stated she had purchased from a gas station at an earlier time. Kennedy stated she returned to the vehicle, where Jackson arrived shortly thereafter and handed her V1's purse, which she claimed she did not want. Kennedy advised that shortly after entering the vehicle, officers with the Vero Beach Police Department conducted a traffic stop. During this time, she placed the purse in the rear of the vehicle. Kennedy stated she was worried and did not want to get into trouble.

Michael A. Jackson was transported to the Vero Beach Police Department Detective Division, where he was placed in an interview room and recorded for further questioning. I advised Jackson of his Miranda rights, which he stated he understood and waived, agreeing to speak with me. During the interview, Jackson provided the following statement: Jackson stated that he and Leigh H. Kennedy are in a romantic relationship and had recently relocated to Florida from Ohio for employment opportunities. Jackson advised that he became acquainted with V1 and V2 during their time staying at [REDACTED] as well as through encounters within the City of Vero Beach. Jackson stated that both he and Kennedy have a history of drug use and had previously sought to purchase narcotics from V1 and V2 on multiple occasions. Jackson alleged that, on several of those occasions, money was sent via the mobile application "Cash App," but the narcotics were never provided and no refunds were issued. Jackson stated that, knowing V1 and V2 were staying in the motel room, he and Kennedy went to the location without prior notice in an attempt to recover their money. Jackson advised that he brought a bat with him in case the situation escalated and he needed to defend himself, and that Kennedy was also armed with a knife. Jackson stated that Kennedy knocked on the door and was met by V2, who he described as aggressive and irate. Jackson advised that V2 began yelling at Kennedy regarding the money, although he could not recall the exact statements made, and then grabbed her by the arm. Jackson stated that he then struck V2 with the bat one time in order to prevent V2 from further harming Kennedy. Jackson advised that both he and Kennedy subsequently entered the motel room, where a discussion regarding money took place, however, he was unable to provide specific details regarding that conversation. Jackson stated that at some point, V2 exited the room. Jackson then began searching the room for money and ultimately took V1's purse, believing it contained cash. Jackson further advised that during the incident, he was not paying attention to Kennedy's actions and could not provide details regarding her involvement. Jackson admitted that he was not invited into the room and entered while armed, acknowledging that he had considered the possibility of using the bat. Jackson described the bat as silver in color and stated that he later discarded it in a dumpster located at the Burger King. Jackson described the knife as having a steel blade with a white handle but stated he did not know what ultimately happened to it.

It should be noted that the bat was collected by VBPD officers at Burger King located at 1928 US HWY 1 in the dumpster on the south east corner of the lot matching the statement given by Jackson.

I was able to obtain surveillance video from the Palm Inn and observed the following: At approximately 0222 hours, Michael A. Jackson and Leigh H. Kennedy were observed walking through the parking lot in the direction of Room #16. Kennedy was visibly armed with a knife in her left hand. Jackson was wearing a dark-colored hooded jacket with the hood pulled over his head and appeared to be wearing gloves. Kennedy was also wearing a dark-colored hooded jacket with the hood up upon approaching the room. Both individuals positioned themselves on either side of the doorway, with Jackson placing his back against the wall in an apparent attempt to conceal himself from the occupants' view.

At approximately 0223 hours, Kennedy knocked on the door. When the door was opened by V2, Kennedy raised her arm and pointed the knife toward him. V2 was observed attempting to lower Kennedy's hand when Jackson struck V2 in the head multiple times with a bat and then entered the motel room.

At approximately 0225 hours, V2 exited the room holding his head and covered in blood. V2 then re-entered the room. V1 subsequently exited the room and was observed on the phone with law enforcement while simultaneously engaged in a verbal altercation with Kennedy and Jackson. Kennedy was then observed exiting the room.

NARRATIVE

On Tuesday, April 21, 2026, at approximately 2038 hours, I was traveling South on 27th Avenue near the 700 block, when I was flagged down by two pedestrians in front of the Speedy Beverage Mart, 737 27th Avenue SW, Vero Beach, Florida. The pedestrians stated, a male had just stolen items from their store, while wearing a mask.

While trying to locate the suspect a male, who was later identified as, Dominic Angel, emerged from the wood line, holding a vape in his hand, and stated, "I will give it back". I instructed Angel to have a seat on the side of the roadway. After Angel had taken a seat on the ground, I requested his identification, advising him he was not free to leave. Angel stated, "No, why" and continued to not provide me with his identification. I subsequently instructed Angel to stand up and began to detain him, at which time, he attempted to pull his left arm away from my grasp.

It should be noted, I was in my agency issued patrol uniform, in a marked patrol car with my emergency lights activated, and was carrying out my duties as a sworn Deputy for the Indian River County Sheriff's Office.

After Angel was detained, I made contact with the store owner, Mehedi Hasan, who had witnessed the incident via his surveillance footage. Hasan stated, Angel approached the store from the East entrance, while wearing a red bandana, covering his face. Hasan then stated, Angel approached the vapes and grabbed two "elite ultra" vapes, before running from the front of the store, as the employees chased him. Hasan stated, he and his fellow employee only allow vehicles to drive through, as foot traffic is prohibited. Hasan also stated, there is signage stating "Stay in your vehicle's, allow us to serve you", which is posted on the entrance of the store. Hasan explained, he and his fellow employees do not allow any customers to enter their store by foot and only allow customers to enter by vehicle and never allow customers to exit their vehicles.

Hasan further stated, by Angel walking into the store, through the exit, reaching past the entrance to the register, where he obtained the vapes, is an area designated for employees only and marked with a red line. Hasan again reiterated, he and his employees do not allow pedestrian traffic to enter the store, and has been common practice since the store was established, with him as the owner. This is also common knowledge to the public since the stores opening, as it is a drive through beverage mart.

I met with Angel advising him of his Miranda Right's, to which he stated he understood. Angel stated, "I tried to leave money on the ground and take the vapes and run since they changed the legal age to buy vapes to 21 years old. I am only 18 years old so am unable to purchase them". When I asked about the bandana Angel used to conceal his face, which was still around his neck at the time of his detention.
