The undersigned certifies and swears that he/she has just and reasonable grounds to believe that the above named defendant committed the following violation of law: On 05/04/2026, at 23:35 (Specifically include facts constituting cause for arrest.)

PROBABLE CAUSE STATEMENT

On May 4, 2026, at approximately 2111 hours, I was driving westbound on the alleyway behind 621 Sebastian Boulevard, Sebastian, Florida 32958, when I observed a female walking eastbound on the alleyway. I observed the female to be Pamela Diz, whom I identified from other incidents I responded to involving her. I knew Pamela Diz had an active warrant out of Indian River County for Burglary of a dwelling, petty theft, and criminal mischief (Indian River County warrant number 312026CF000482A). I knew the warrant was active in FCIC/NCIC due to attempting to complete a warrant service at Pamela's residence at approximately 2041 hours, and already having the Sebastian Police Department's Dispatch Center confirm the warrant was still active.

As Pamela began to walk past my patrol vehicle, I rolled the driver's side window of my patrol vehicle down and asked her if she was Pamela. Pamela stated yes and began to walk away from me. To stop her, I lied to her and advised her I had to do a welfare check on her (Due to my having done several welfare checks on her prior). Pamela stopped momentarily as I exited my patrol vehicle, but then began to walk away again. I advised Pamela to stop again, and she did so. As I approached her, she attempted to walk away again. I took hold of her right arm and told her to stop walking away. Pamela asked why. I told her she had a warrant out of Indian River County, as I placed her into mechanical hand restraints.

Once I placed Pamela into mechanical hand restraints, she began to yell, tense her arms, and attempt to pull away from me. Pamela began screaming and yelling that she had no criminal record and wanted to know what the warrant was for. I advised Pamela that the warrant was for burglary. Once told what the warrant was for, she became more irate and continually attempted to pull away from me.

At this time, K9 handler Corporal Revis #K941 arrived at the scene. Corporal Revis assisted me in gaining control over Pamela. Once Pamela began to calm herself, I attempted to fix her hand restraints. Pamela then began to become irate again. Pamela again began to pull away from us and tense her arms. As I was attempting to fix her hand restraints, my key to the hand restraints became stuck. While attempting to remove the stuck key, Pamela repeatedly and spontaneously moved her arms around, making it difficult to remove the stuck key. Pamela then lifted her left leg and stomped it down on top of my boot. Pamela then began to kick her legs around wildly backward, toward Corporal Revis and me. This caused me to hold Pamela against my car with my arm extended to avoid being stuck again. Pamela showed no sign of calming herself, so I took hold of both her arms while she was still kicking her feet around. I removed Pamela from leaning against my patrol vehicle and performed a leg sweep on her. Corporal Revis and I then guided Pamela to the ground in a controlled manner to insure to did not strike her head on the paved roadway.

Corporal Revis and I then held Pamela on the ground and continued to attempt to remove the stuck key while she thrashed around and screamed. At this time, Corporal Keskinen #410 arrived on scene and was able to remove the stuck key. As soon as the handcuff came off of Pamela's left hand, she pulled her arm away and attempted to place it under herself, but I defeated her attempt and replaced her hand behind her back. As Corporal Keskinen and Corporal Revis held Pamela's hands behind her back, I placed a new pair of mechanical hand restraints on her. I checked the hand restraints for proper fit and ensured they were double locked. At this time, Officer Harris #450 arrived on scene and placed Pamela, who was still irate and attempting to defeat law enforcement from keeping her restrained, into leg restraints.

Deputy Kramer arrived at the scene and conducted a female search of Pamela, which ended with negative results. Pamela was then placed into the rear seat of my patrol vehicle, where she continued to be irate and scream and thrash herself around.

The Sebastian Police Department's Dispatch Center advised me that Pamela's warrant was confirmed.

I then transported Pamela to the Indian River County Jail. The entire way to the Indian River County Jail, Pamela continued to scream and yell profanities.

No further actions were taken by this officer.

NARRATIVE

On Monday May 4, 2026, at approximately 2056 hours, I responded to the 300 Block of 90th Avenue SW in reference to a possible vehicle crash. While enroute, I was advised by dispatch the female driver was unconscious behind the wheel of the vehicle.

Upon my arrival, I made contact with the driver, later identified as Natalie Bella, who was alert and talking at this time. I asked her if she was okay and if she needed any medical attention, and she refused medical attention.

As I interacted with Bella, I observed several physical signs of impairment: Glassy-watery eyes, slurred speech, and a heavy odor of an alcoholic beverage. Also, while speaking with Bella, I observed a can of an alcoholic beverage in the center cup holder. The can was a 19.2 oz can of Voodoo Ranger IPA which contained 9.5% Alcohol per Volume. There was also a full unopened can in the passenger floorboard. Bella was asked to exit the vehicle through the passenger side, as to prevent her from falling the ditch on driver's side. As Bella exited the she spontaneously stated she was not drunk, and repeatedly said that several times. Bella was unsteady on her feet and was swaying back and forth as she stood next to her vehicle. Bella began to yell that she did not do anything wrong, and just wanted to go home. She then stated that she did not crash into the ditch, she pulled over and ran off in the ditch by accident. She then continued to state that she did not do anything wrong.

I became concerned Bella was impaired beyond her normal faculties by alcoholic beverages or chemical or controlled substances.

To dispel my concerns, I asked Bella if she would participate in a series of standardized field sobriety exercises, to which she agreed. I asked Bella a series of medical questions to ensure she could participate in field sobriety exercises. Bella stated that she had no physical defects, was not sick or injured, did not have epilepsy or diabetes, and did not wear contacts and glasses.

All field sobriety exercises were explained and demonstrated proficiently prior to her beginning each exercise and I confirmed she understood the instructions prior to the start of each exercise.

The following exercises were performed:

- 1.) HORIZONTAL GAZE NYSTAGMUS – I instructed Bella to stand directly in front of me at the rear of her vehicle. The road was a dirt road, with no painted lines, however there were tire marks and I attempted to have her stand on those in front of me. Bella was unable to follow instructions on numerous occasions. I instructed her to stand facing me with her feet together heel-to-heel, and toe-to-toe with her hands by her side. Bella was unable to put her feet together and keep them that way. She was also unable to keep her hands down by her side. She kept separating her feet to prevent from falling over. As I gave Bella the instructions for the Horizontal Gaze Nystagmus, she began to turn her head sideways and yelling. This continued approximately six more times before I stopped the exercise.

I discontinued the exercises out of concern for Bella's safety, as she was unable to follow simple clear instructions and was

Based upon my investigation, probable cause exists that on Monday May 4, 2026, Bella was in actual physical control of a motor vehicle while under the influence of alcohol beverages and/or a chemical or controlled substance and was impaired beyond their normal faculties, incapable of operating a vehicle safely. Bella drove her car off the side of the road and nearly down into an 8' deep ditch.

NARRATIVE

On May 5, 2026, at approximately 0148 hours, I responded to 4425 US Highway 1, Vero Beach, in reference to an auto accident. While enroute, Indian River County Public Safety Dispatch, informed me the suspect was Zanari Wynn who has since left the scene in a red vehicle.

Upon my arrival, I made contact with the caller Michael Steigerwald, who informed me that Wynn grabbed the steering wheel taking control of his vehicle, and jerked it towards the right causing a crash by the intersection of 45th Street and US Highway 1. I then observed the scene at the intersection consistent with Steigerwald's statement. A fiberglass post owned by WAWA was damaged in the process. Along with the landscape and the concrete curb side walk. A green utility pole was struck by the passenger side mirror, but no visible damage to the pole was observed.

At approximately 0225 hours, while gathering information from Steigerwald as to what occurred, Wynn showed up on scene attempting to retrieve her phone from Steigerwald's vehicle. I then asked Wynn what occurred, she stated various different stories which did not make much sense and did not line up with the incident that occurred. I did observe a scrape on Wynn's right shoulder and white concrete powder like residue on her back area. At this time, I read Wynn her Miranda rights due to the possibility of a physical altercation. Wynn stated she understood and waived her rights. Post Miranda, Wynn stated it got physical and that she did punch Steigerwald. Later stated it wasn't physical, and denied hitting Steigerwald. Wynn stated she was in the city of Sebastian three houses away from Earls Hideaway Bar at a friend's house. Later stated they went to a bar called Dom's Bar in Vero Beach, where she stated she was there but was not there with Steigerwald, but later stated she had drinks with him at the bar. Wynn willingly showed me her life 360 APP that tracks her movements and whereabouts. The app never showed Wynn in Sebastian, the app also showed her by his residence on [REDACTED] which she stated she did not go to but later stated she did not remember.

Wynn statements were inconsistent and contradicting while going off into several tangents not pertaining to questions asked. She stated that Steigerwald was mad because she would not engage in sexual intercourse with him. She then stated that she doesn't know how he got flat tires but offered to pay for them.

Based on the inconsistencies I decided to speak with Steigerwald and gather his side of what occurred.

I read Steigerwald his Miranda rights, he understood and waived his rights. Steigerwald stated met up with Wynn at their mutual friend's house Hanya Rant located at the Palms of Vero apartment complex. Steigerwald stated that Wynn was taking shots of alcoholic beverages with her friends and at some point, engaged in sexual intercourse. Shortly after he left the residence and met up with Wynn and her friends at a local bar called Dom's Bar. While at the bar Wynn continued to consume alcoholic beverages and became severely impaired. After the bar Steigerwald and Wynn went back to his place on [REDACTED] where he resides. Steigerwald stated, Wynn did not make it inside his place due to being heavily intoxicated and urinated outside his residence. Steigerwald also stated that Wynn fell forward multiple times while urinating.

Wynn then wanted to be dropped off back at her friend's house at the Palms of Vero. As he drove southbound on US Highway 1, they began to argue over infidelity. Wynn received a facetime call from another male later identified as Lamone Baskin. Wynn then dropped her phone causing it to slide across the front dash of the vehicle onto the driver side. Steigerwald then grabbed the phone as Wynn reached over grabbed the steering wheel jerking it to the right causing the vehicle to crash

at the intersection of 45th Street and US Highway 1. Steigerwald stated he did his best to regain control of the vehicle and pulled over at the nearest parking area.

Steigerwald then stepped out of the vehicle, noticed that both his passenger tires were flat and both his rims were cracked. Wynn stepped out of the vehicle, became argumentative, and physical with Steigerwald. He stated, Wynn punched him behind the head and the right side of his face. After inspecting Steigerwald's body, a visible scratch mark can be seen on the right side of his face by his temple. Steigerwald then stated, Wynn attempted to sit on a concrete curb but threw herself back landing on her backside which is consistent with her scratch and white concrete powder like residue on her back. Wynn's mother showed up, while reprimanding Wynn, shortly after Baskin arrived in a red sedan. Wynn got out of her mother's vehicle and left the scene with Baskin.

It should be noted that Steigerwald and Wynn have been dating on and off again for five years, and have been intimate within the past six months.

Based on my investigation, Wynn knowingly and willingly struck Steigerwald against his will, therefore, I find probable cause to charge Wynn with:

1. F.S.S. 784.03.1a2 cause bodily harm Dating Violence - no bond.

While conducting my investigation, Deputy Hackett (6318) stated the following to me regarding his investigation:

Upon his arrival, Deputy Hackett spoke with Mr. Michael Steigerwald (Involved) who stated the following during a sworn statement recorded on his body-worn camera.

Michael stated he was driving his Ford F-150 South on US Highway 1 from the area of [REDACTED]. An altercation occurred inside the truck during which his passenger, Ms. Zanari Wynn (Arrestee) took physical control of the vehicle by grabbing ahold of the steering wheel and jerking it to the right. Michael stated her actions forced the vehicle off the roadway and veered in-between several utility poles on the side of the road.

Michael's truck struck the concrete sidewalk and caused visible damage to the landscape and the concrete sidewalk. Michael's truck mirror struck the green utility pole and had visible green paint transfer on his right mirror, which was cracked and displaced from its housing. Michael's front passenger and rear passenger tires were deflated and his rear rim was severely damaged.

During the initial investigation, Michael stated Ms. Wynn had departed the scene in another vehicle. However, while conducting the investigation, Ms. Wynn returned to the scene.

While questioning Ms. Wynn about the incident, Deputy Hackett observed several indicators of alcohol impairment. Deputy Hackett noted the following observations: Ms. Wynn's eyes were glassy, her balance was uneasy, and there was an overwhelming odor of an alcoholic beverage emitting from her breath as she spoke.

Ms. Wynn stated she was currently on probation and did not have a valid license. Her story was inconsistent and changed

several times. Ms. Wynn admitted to being inside Michael's truck but claimed she did not know how the tires became deflated. Ms. Wynn ventured off onto several tangents that did not pertain to the questions she was asked.

A query of D.A.V.I.D. revealed Ms. Wynn was convicted of DUI on September 3, 2025 (AJ8SYGE) and her license was suspended indefinitely.

Deputy Hackett requested Ms. Wynn to complete Standard Field Sobriety Exercises (SFSE's) upon arrival to the jail and she refused. Ms. Wynn was advised her refusal could be used against her in criminal court in accordance with Taylor v. State. She was requested a second time and willingly refused Deputy Hackett's second request.

Upon arrival to the Indian River Jail Complex, a twenty-minute observation period was initiated. Ms. Wynn was then requested to provide a sample of her breath to determine its alcoholic content and she refused. She was advised of Implied Consent by Deputy F. Solomon and requested a second time to provide a sample her breath and willingly refused.

Based on the above statement of Michael and the physical evidence he observed, Deputy Hackett established probable cause to charge Ms. Wynn with:

NARRATIVE

On Tuesday, 5/5/2026, at approximately 1716 hours I responded to [REDACTED] in reference to a physical altercation between father and son.

I made contact with the son, Logan Dittmeier, who advised me of the following. He came home from work and brought in two of the three trash bins. Logan advised that he forgets the third bin as it is on the side of the house. Logan was outside eating when his father came home from work. Logan's father, Steven Dittmeier, came outside and started yelling at him for not taking in the third bin. Steven and him get into a verbal dispute over the bin being brought in. Steven leaves the backyard and goes to bring the bin in. After bringing in the bin Steven then comes back outside and starts yelling at Logan before returning into the residence. Logan followed Steven into the residence because he heard Steven yell at his mother. Logan advised he walked into to make sure that Steven did not hurt his mother because he has allegedly done so in the past. Once in the house Steven confronts Logan asking him if they're going to fight which Logan advised him that they were not and was simply checking on his mother. Logan advised that Steven then lunged at him and punched him in the chest. Logan showed me by his left clavicle bone a small cut and redness where Steven had punched him. Logan advised that after Steven punched him he fought back to defend himself. Logan advised me that he had video on his cellphone.

Logan then showed me video on his phone. I observed what appeared to be Logan sitting down. It is then heard Steven stating "any day you think you can take me lets do it". Logan replies that he is not fighting him. Steven is then seen briefly appearing close to Logan while still enticing him to fight. Logan stated "are you going to fight me?" to which Steven stated "if I have to". Steven is heard opening or closing the sliding glass door as Logan tried to ask him a question. Logan then pick up his phone and places it inside of his pocket while entering the residence. Steven is then heard asking Logan repeatedly "you need something", to which Logan does not reply. Logan's mother then is heard telling Steven to stop to which Steven tells her to "shut the fuck up". Logan advised Steven that he is just making sure his mom is alright to which Steven continues to name call either Logan or his wife a "nigger monkey". Logan is then heard asking Steven "are you going to hit me?" right before physical scuffle is heard. I observed injuries to Steven's right eye, left ear, and the top of his head.

I made contact with Steven who advised me of the following. He came home from work and saw that one of the trash bins was still outside. Steven then went and confronted Logan about the trash bin and Logan advised him that he did not feel like taking it in. Him and Logan began calling each other names and that was it. Logan then broke a chair and Steven got a few hits in the face. Steven advised that he just wanted Logan kicked out. While speaking with Steven he referred to Logan as his step-son. After further clarification Logan is not Steven's biological son but Steven had taken him in as a son nine-teen years ago and they had been [REDACTED]. Steven further explained that when he got home Logan was on the back porch eating when he confronted him about the trash bin. Steven advised that the argument started outside, he left and came back outside and confronted Logan about the garbage to which Logan told him "fuck you I ain't doin it". Steven advised that there was then some name calling, he went into the house into his room, and then the Police showed up. Steven did not give any detail of the physical altercation and just continued to talk about possessions and gettin Logan to leave.

I spoke with Logan's mother, Alice, who advised the following. She was home cooking and Logan was on the back patio. Steven got home from work, walked through the front door, and straight outside to Logan. Steven started yelling in Logan's face. Alice then opened the door and stood there. Steven then yelled at her before entering the residence. Logan then came into the residence where Steven yelled at Logan. Alice then advised that Steven attacked Logan. Alice advised that Steven punched Logan in the chest and then they began fighting each other. Alice advised that Logan picked up a chair because Steven was going after him with a frying pan.

NARRATIVE

On Tuesday May 5, 2026 at approximately 1935 hours, I responded to 1190 37th Street, Vero Beach (Behavior Health Center) in reference to a disturbance.

Upon arrival I met with nurse manager, Brandi Gibson who stated the following:

Gibson stated on Monday May 4, 2026, Daniel Brausam was brought to the facilities under an [REDACTED] by the Indian River County Sheriff's Office. Gibson said on today's date at 1110 hours, a psychiatric doctor deemed Brausam coherent and no longer needed to be held for further psychiatric evaluations. Gibson stated Brausam was told he could leave the facility, but chose to stay voluntarily, knowing he was free to leave at any time. Gibson told me at approximately 1900 hours, she overheard Brausam stating racial slurs to her and other medical personnel, when she went to check on Brausam, Brausam struck her with a closed fist in the abdomen area. Gibson also told me she observed Brausam kick and stomp on another medical team member, Tyronne Ragin.

I then spoke with behavioral tech, Tyronne Ragin who stated the following:

Ragin stated at approximately 1900 hours he observed Brausam strike Gibson with a closed fist in the abdomen area, when he then attempted to intervene, Brausam repeatedly stomped on his foot and kicked him with the intent to cause harm.

I then read Miranda rights to Daniel Brausam who understood and revoked his rights, wishing to speak with me, stating the following:

Brausam stated at approximately 1900 hours, of today's date he started calling the medical personnel racial slurs. Brausam said he knowingly punched Gibson in the abdomen area and stomped/kicked Ragin on his foot and leg area.

Brausam was placed under arrest and charged with two counts of Battery on medical personnel (784.07(1)(c)). Brausam was transported to Indian River County Jail where he was turned over to the care and custody of the Correction Deputies without incident.

NARRATIVE

On Tuesday, May 5, 2026, at approximately 2004 hours, I, Deputy M. Neill #6317 responded to the intersection of Vista Palm Lane and S US Highway 1, Vero Beach, Indian River County, Florida, in reference to disturbance.

A caller who was passing by observed a disturbance occurring between a male and a female, who were pulled over on the side of the road. The caller reported that the disturbance was physical and provided a description of the male half.

Upon my arrival to the area, I locate the male half walking northbound from the intersection. I made contact with the male, who was identified as Mr. Stephen Meus, and questioned him about what happened. He stated he got in to an argument with Ms. ZharNay Avriett, as she was accusing him of speaking to other women and was being jealous. While Ms. Avriett was driving, Mr. Meus was in the passenger seat. Ms. Avriett started to hit and strike Mr. Meus in the head, eventually grabbing and pulling his dreads. Mr. Meus grabbed ahold of her wrist in order to prevent her from grabbing his hair any further. Once she stopped tugging on his hair, he released her wrist. As they were coming to a stop, Mr. Meus grabbed the keys from the vehicle so that they would not continue to have a physical disturbance while driving. This upset Ms. Avriett. Ms. Avriett threw a cup of coke at Mr. Meus. He then exited the vehicle. While standing outside of the vehicle, Ms. Avriett grabbed his dreads again and attempted to pull him in to the vehicle. This resulted in Mr. Meus obtaining scratches on his shins, as he hit his legs on the bottom part of the door. He then gave the keys back to Ms. Avriett and she drove away.

Mr. Meus had two small lacerations, one on each shin. He also had an old bite mark on his left shoulder. His shirt was also wet as if someone threw a liquid on him.

I spoke with the caller, who originally reported the incident. She advised that she saw a heated argument between the two parties, but did not actually see anyone being physical as she was passing by.

While on scene, Ms. Avriett responded to the scene. She advised that Mr. Meus informed her to return to the scene. I spoke to her about the incident. Ms. Avriett denied the disturbance ever getting physical and stated they only had an argument.

Both Mr. Meus and Ms. Avriett confirmed that they [REDACTED]

[REDACTED] Mr. Meus advised that they had broken up but denied stating that they were in an actually dating relationship.

Based on the injuries on Mr. Meus, and how they are consistent with his statement, paired with the two subjects appearing to be in a [REDACTED] I believe there is probable cause to arrest Ms. Avriett for the offense of Battery – Dating Violence.

I went to place Ms. Avriett under arrest. I informed her to place her hands behind her back, and that she was under

arrest. Ms. Avriett stated "no, no" to Deputy Scott and myself. I informed Ms. Avriett to stop tensing up, as she was actively flexing her muscles and attempting to pull her hands from behind back to the front. Ms. Avriett had to be over powered in order for us to secure her in handcuff restraints.

While in the backseat of my patrol vehicle, Ms. Avriett asked how she was being placed under arrest. After explaining to her how his shirt was wet and Mr. Meus claimed she threw a coke on him, she spontaneously stated "it wasn't even a coke, it was a Pepsi" and went on to state how if she didn't leave a bruise, it wasn't a crime.

Ms. Avriett was transported to the Indian River County Jail.
