NARRATIVE

On May 27, 2026, at approximately 2105 hours, I responded to the 4100 block of 58th Avenue, Vero Beach, Florida, in reference to an auto accident.

Upon my arrival, I made contact with Sergeant Le, who informed me the driver of a white Jeep bearing Florida tag BM85JZ, later identified as Kimor Banks, did not possess a valid drivers license. Sergeant Le was shown a photograph of a learners permit on Bank's cellular phone because Banks stated he did not have any identification on his person. A query was conducted through DAVID, which revealed Banks was issued a learners permit on June 1st 2021, it was suspended as of October 4th, 2022, canceled on February 2nd, 2024, and replaced with a valid Identification card that was issued on the same date.

It was later determined Banks's Identification card was located inside his wallet. Banks was placed in handcuffs and escorted to my patrol vehicle. I read Banks his Miranda rights, to which he invoked, and declined any further statements. Banks was informed he was under arrest for driving without a driver's license.

Based on the statements provided, Banks was in actual physical control of a motor vehicle without driver's license, his false statement regarding possessing identification, and his initial presentation of only a learner's permit, I find probable cause to charge Banks with:

1. F.S.S. 322.03 (1)- No valid drivers license, never issued - Citation # ANHB62E




NARRATIVE

On Wednesday, May 27, 2026 at approximately 1808 hours, I responded to the area near mile marker 142 on South Interstate 95 in Vero Beach, Florida.

Upon my arrival, I was briefed by Deputy A. Fettig (6331) who stated Deputy M. Szott (5919) discovered the vehicle on the side of the road and upon initial contact, Mr. Daniel Fuentes (Arrestee) was seated in the driver's seat. Deputy Fettig indicated that Mr. Fuentes was impaired and stated he was advised of his rights in accordance with Miranda v. Arizona.

I made contact with Mr. Fuentes, who was leaning on the outside of his truck. Mr. Fuentes was extremely sunburned and covered in sand. His clothes and appearance were disheveled. His eyes were watery, his speech was slurred and I could smell the distinct odor of an alcoholic beverage emitting from his breath as he spoke with me.

Daniel stated he left work, went to the beach where he fell asleep and "got some good sun." Then he stated his truck stalled out, he stated, "I don't understand it. I don't know how to start it up"

Daniel stated he was coming from Daytona Beach and travelling home to Orlando. When I asked Daniel if he knew where he was, he stated "I am on the side of I-4." When I asked if he knew what city or county he was in, he stated "Not exactly" then stated "Volusia." Daniel then stated he had "not a lot" of alcohol, and then clarified stating "I had two (2) beers earlier." Daniel stated he consumed those beers at 1300. When I asked Daniel what time it was currently, he stated "three o'clock, four o'clock?" The actual time was 1821 hours.

I explained my concern to Daniel for his ability to operate a motor vehicle and requested he complete Standard Field Sobriety Exercises (SFSE's) to which he agreed. Daniel agreed to be transported to an alternate site for safety reasons, however the decision was made by Deputy Fettig to take Daniel into custody for Leaving the scene of a crash with damage to property of another person.

The following was provided by Deputy Fettig in support of his probable cause arrest for Leaving the scene of a crash with property damage:

On May 27, 2026 at approximately 1734 Hours Indian River County Communications Center received reports of a hit and run crash that occurred near the 9800 Block of HWY 60 in Vero Beach.

The complainant was identified as Zachary Polke. Polke stated he was traveling south on I95 when he took the HWY 60 exit. Polke stated he was stopped on the off ramp waiting for the signal light to change, when a small white truck rear ended him. Polke stated both vehicles then continued through the intersection when the light turned green, however when Polke pulled off the side of the road, the driver of

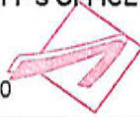

the white truck continued to drive west on HWY 60. Polke attempted to follow the truck, and took pictures of the license plate which showed "FL Dk97AX" Polke stated the truck then made a U-Turn and drove back east on HWY 60, before turning down the I95 South Ramp and merging back onto the interstate. Polke pulled his vehicle over and waited for responding deputies. Myself and Cpl. Szott arrived on scene with Polke, who provided us with a description of the suspect vehicle, to include a picture of the license plate. I remained on scene with Polke as Cpl. Szott checked the surrounding area for the suspect vehicle. Cpl. Szott located the white truck which was pulled onto the shoulder of I95 South near mile marker 145. Cpl. Szott identified the driver as Daniel Fuentes, who was seated in the driver seat.

When I arrived on scene with Cpl. Szott, I began to speak with Fuentes. I advised Fuentes of his Miranda Rights, which he stated he understood and agreed to speak with. I questioned Fuentes about the crash that Polke reported. Fuentes confirmed it was his vehicle that was involved, and also confirmed he was the one driving. I asked Fuentes if he pulled over to exchange any information with the other driver involved, and he stated "No". I then asked Fuentes if he made any attempt to report the accident to law enforcement, to which he again stated "No".

Deputy Hackett then arrived on scene and Fuentes was placed under arrest. Deputy Hackett transported Fuentes to the Indian River County Jail to continue his DUI investigation.

Daniel was placed in handcuffs and transported to the Indian River County Jail Complex (IRCJC).

Upon arrival to the IRCJC, Daniel was given the opportunity to complete SFSE's.

The first exercise I administered was the Horizontal Gaze Nystagmus (HGN) exercise. I explained the exercise to Daniel who acknowledged he understood the exercise. I observed the following validated clues of impairment: Daniel's pupils were of approximate equal size and tracked simultaneously. Daniel had Lack of Smooth Pursuit, Distinct and Sustained Nystagmus at Maximum Deviation and onset of nystagmus at 35 degrees. I observed Vertical Gaze Nystagmus (VGN). Daniel had an orbital sway while completing this exercise and had difficulty tracking my stimulus.

The second exercise I administered was the Walk and Turn (WAT) exercise. I explained and demonstrated the exercise to Daniel who stated he understood the instructions and did not have any questions. During the Instructional phase, I observed no clues of impairment. During the walking phase, I observed the following clues of impairment: Raised Arms, Missed Heel to Toe, Stepped Offline, Improper Turn to the right, and stopped walking to steady. Daniel DID NOT complete this exercise to standard.

The third exercise I administered was the One Leg Stand (OLS) exercise. I explained and demonstrated the exercise to Daniel who stated he understood the instructions and did not have any questions. Daniel

began the exercise by raising his Right foot off the ground. I observed the following clues of impairment during this exercise: Sway and used arms for balance. Daniel DID NOT complete this exercise to standard.

The fourth exercise I administered was the Modified Romberg Balance exercise. I explained and demonstrated the exercise to Daniel who stated he understood the instructions and did not have any questions. Daniel counted to "30" seconds in the real time of 44 seconds. I observed the following clues of impairment: Daniel swayed while completing this exercise.

The fifth exercise I administered was the Finger to Nose (FTN) exercise. I explained and demonstrated the exercise to Daniel who stated he understood the instructions and did not have any questions. Daniel made the following movements:

- L1: Did Not Return
- R2: Tip of finger to tip of nose
- L3: Tip of finger to tip of nose
- R4: Tip of finger to tip of nose
- R5: Tip of finger to tip of nose
- L6: Tip of finger to tip of nose

Daniel was requested to provide a sample of his breath to determine its alcoholic content. Daniel provided the following two (2) lawful samples of his breath: 0.178g/210/L and 0.184 g/210L.

A query of D.A.V.I.D. revealed Daniel has a prior DUI conviction from Virginia in which Daniel was adjudicated guilty on October 12, 2017.

Based on the above indicators of impairment and observations, Daniel was ultimately charged with Failure to Give Information at Scene of Crash (ANHBACE), Driving Under the Influence with a BrAC above 0.15 (ANHCB3E), Driving Under the Influence Causing Property Damage (ANHBAAE).

In addition, Daniel was issued the following citation: Failure to notify Law Enforcement of Crash involving Property damage of at least \$500 (ANHBABE)

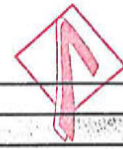

NARRATIVE

On May 26, 2026 at approximately 2342 hours, I, Deputy Gadacz responded to [REDACTED] in reference to a disturbance.

Upon arrival, I made contact with Melinda Sue Pitts, who advised her boyfriend Robert Marshall Gallina Jr. had punched her in the chest several times. Pitts advised they have been dating [REDACTED]. Pitts stated they were eating dinner as a family and during the dinner, Gallina had three alcoholic beverages. After dinner, they had gone to a bar in an attempt to have a couple of drinks. As soon as they arrived, Gallina stated he needed to use the restroom and walked off. About five minutes later, Gallina back saying he has been looking for her everywhere and even outside. She told Gallina that she had been sitting at the bar waiting for him to return from the bathroom. Gallina sat down at the bar and the bartender told Gallina that he could not sell him any alcohol to him due to him looking intoxicated. Pitts advised at that point, they left the bar and headed back home.

Pitts advised on the way home, Gallina started hitting her while she was driving. She stopped the vehicle in the middle of the road, so she would not cause a wreck. Pitts advised during the physical altercation, Gallina broke her car key in the ignition. Gallina then exited the vehicle and started running down the street. Pitts stated she had a spare key to her car inside of the vehicle and used that to get home. When she made it back to her residence. She grabbed the kids and dog, and went down the street to a friend's house, where she contacted her mother. Once her mother arrived at the friend's house, they went back to the residence.

When she entered the home, Gallina was inside and acted like nothing had happen. Gallina attempted to kiss her, but she stepped away and that is when Gallina poked her in the head. Pitts advised she swung at him but did not make contact. They started arguing and walked back to their bedroom. When they entered the bedroom, Gallina poked her in the head again and that started another physical altercation. Pitts advised they both were swing at each other and that is when her mother stepped in between them to stop the fight. Once her mother stopped the fight, her mother started walking away, and that is when Gallina punched Pitts twice in her chest. Pitts walked out of the house and contacted law enforcement. Gallina knew she was on the phone with the police and left the area. I did not observe any marks or bruises on Pitts.

I then made contact with Peggy Sue Pitts Brooks, who is Melinda Pitts's mother. Brooks advised she received a call from her daughter about the altercation and left work early. Brooks advised her daughter and her went to her residence where Gallina was already inside. Brooks advised she saw Gallina poke her daughter in the head and then they started an argument. The argument continued into the bedroom where it became physical. Brooks advised they both were hitting each other and she stepped in

between them. When she was between them, they stopped fighting, but as soon as she moved away. Gallina punched Pitts in the chest twice. That is when her daughter walked outside and contacted the police.

Pitts was provided with a victim rights/notice of legal rights and remedies brochure. I completed the Domestic Violence Lethality Assessment Form. I did not contact a victims advocate due to her answers and Pitts advised she did not want to speak to anyone.

Once done at the incident location, I headed to the Deputy Magill's traffic stop where Gallina had been arrested for DUI. Upon my arrival, Gallina was in the back seat of an assisting deputy's patrol vehicle. Gallina started kicking the patrol vehicles door and tried slipping his cuffs. Gallina kept attempting to place the cuffs in front of him. At that moment, Gallina had to be placed into a wrap. Once in the wrap, Gallina was transported to the Indian River County Jail. At the Jail, I asked Gallina if he would perform some sobriety exercises, which he refused. Gallina provided a breath sample and blow a BAC level of 0.00. I then contacted my supervisor and a DRE. The DRE arrived at the jail, where Gallina advised he would participate in some exercises. The DRE started to conduct the exercises and Gallina refused to continue or complete the exercises.

Based on the facts, Gallina is being charged with Reckless driving, DUI, Resisting without violence, possession of controlled substance, DV Battery, and Neglect of a child.

On May 26, 2026, at approximately 2342 hours, I was responding to 503 21st Road SW, Vero Beach, Florida, in reference to an active disturbance.

Prior to my arrival, the Indian River County Sheriff's Office Dispatch informed responding Deputies, that the suspect, Robert Gallina struck his girlfriend and left the residence driving a silver Ford F150 with a camper top. Dispatch also informed responding Deputies that Robert's girlfriend advised he was under the influence alcohol and taking valium.

Utilizing a law enforcement database, I was able to query Robert's name and discovered he was previously pulled over driving a silver Ford F150 bearing Florida tag DX18RE. I informed Indian River County Sheriff's Office Dispatch of the Florida tag for the vehicle Robert was driving. I queried the LPR system and discovered the aforementioned vehicle was north on 20th Avenue SW, from 9th Street SW, Vero Beach, Florida.

I began heading east on 9th Street SW towards 20th Avenue SW. When I reached 20th Avenue SW, I proceeded north. As I proceeded north, I observed the silver Ford F150 bearing Florida tag DX18RE failing to maintain a single lane of travel as it proceeded north. I stayed behind the vehicle waiting for other Deputies to arrive at my location, due to nature of the original call for service. After observing the aforementioned vehicle almost go completely off the right side of the road and strike a mailbox, I feared for the safety of the motoring public and initiated a traffic stop by activating the emergency lights on my patrol vehicle at 20th Avenue and 2nd Street, Vero Beach, Florida.

I informed Robert to shut his vehicle off and throw the keys out the window, which he did. Robert tried to exit, at which point I told him to remain inside the vehicle until he was told to exit.

When Deputy Lowell and other Deputies arrived, we conducted a felony traffic stop. We ordered Robert from the vehicle and placed him in handcuff restraints and in the rear of my patrol car. I asked Robert who else was in the vehicle, he advised his eight (8) year old son. I called for his son to exit the vehicle and walked with him behind the patrol cars. I asked him if anyone else was in the vehicle, he advised there was not. I informed Deputies, at which point they cleared the vehicle.

I placed Robert's son in the rear of Deputy Lowell's patrol vehicle. Deputy Lowell remained with the child.

I approached the truck, and observed several pills scattered throughout the vehicle. Utilizing drugs.com I identified the pills by their manufactures imprint, as follows;

- Diazepam 10mg – 12 pills
- Gabapentin

There was a prescription for the Gabapentin, so I collected them and placed them in the center consul.

I made contact with Robert in the rear of my patrol car and read him his rights, from my agency issued Miranda card, which he advised he understood, and was willing to talk.

Robert admitted to not having a prescription for the Diazepam, I asked Robert how many he had taken, he informed me he had taken two. I asked if he believed that was the reason, he was unable to stay in a single lane of travel, to which he responded, yes.

It should be noted, while speaking with Robert, he had blood shot watery eyes, and slurred speech.

I collected the twelve (12) Diazepam 10mg pills and secured them in the rear of my patrol car. I later turned them over to Deputy Gadacz when he arrived on scene.

I spoke with Deputy Gadacz, who on scene with Robert's girlfriend, he advised he would be coming to the scene of the traffic stop with the girlfriend, so she could get the child and the truck.

Deputy Gadacz arrived and the child and truck were turned over to Robert's girlfriend.

While we were getting ready to move Robert from my vehicle to Deputy Gadacz's' vehicle, he became very belligerent and uncooperative. We had to remove Robert and place him in the WRAP restraint system, and rubber helmet, due to him head butting and kicking the window in the rear of my patrol vehicle. Once Robert was secured in the WRAP, he was transferred to Deputy Gadacz vehicle.

By Robert taking the Diazepam and driving, he placed his son's life in danger, which is clearly displayed by his driving pattern captured on my dash camera.

Robert failed to provide adequate care and supervision by driving with his son in the vehicle while under the influence of

prescription pills that were not prescribed to him. Robert failed as a parent to make a reasonable effort to protect his son by his actions of driving under the influence.
