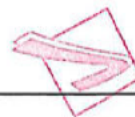

NARRATIVE

On Sunday, July 12, 2026, at approximately 0953 hours, Corporal Portocarrero and I were dispatched to the intersection of 65th Street and Preserve Way in reference to a disturbance involving two males.

Dispatch advised the victim, later identified as [REDACTED] had blood running down [REDACTED] face according to the caller. Dispatch further advised the caller reported that [REDACTED] stated [REDACTED] had been struck with brass knuckles.

Deputy Coultry arrived on scene prior to my arrival and made contact with [REDACTED] stated [REDACTED] later identified as Bernard Jennings, struck [REDACTED] in the head with a metal object [REDACTED] described as "brass knuckles" before leaving the scene. [REDACTED] advised Jennings was operating a work truck towing a white enclosed trailer with green lettering and was wearing a blue hat and blue pants.

I arrived on scene and made contact with the caller, who was identified by his Florida Driver License as Michael Joseph. Michael stated he was leaving the dump when he observed [REDACTED] fall. Concerned for [REDACTED] welfare, Michael altered his route to check on him. Michael stated he observed another Black male enter a truck towing a white enclosed trailer with green lettering before the vehicle drove into the neighborhood, leaving Jennings behind. Michael advised he pulled alongside [REDACTED] yelled from [REDACTED] vehicle to ask if [REDACTED] was okay, and [REDACTED] replied that [REDACTED] had just been battered and requested that he [REDACTED] Michael immediately notified Public Safety Dispatch and remained on scene until deputies arrived.

After obtaining descriptions of the suspect and suspect vehicle from [REDACTED] and Michael, deputies canvassed the area. Deputy Coultry located the suspect vehicle parked at 4319 Lago Circle and observed Jennings as the sole occupant on the property. Upon locating Jennings and the vehicle, I responded to that location.

Upon my arrival, Jennings was actively operating a riding lawn mower. Jennings stopped mowing and made contact with me. I advised Jennings of his Miranda Constitutional Rights, which he acknowledged understanding and voluntarily agreed to waive and speak with me.

I asked Jennings what had occurred. Jennings replied, "It started because [REDACTED] slammed the door." I asked Jennings multiple times to explain the incident further; however, he repeatedly responded, "Whatever [REDACTED] said." Jennings refused to elaborate but admitted that he and [REDACTED] had been involved in an altercation.

Due to Jennings' refusal to provide details, I asked if he knew [REDACTED] Jennings replied, "Yeah, and I'm 72." I then asked Jennings whether he used a weapon, specifically brass knuckles, during the incident. Jennings replied, "No," contrary to [REDACTED] statement and the significant injuries [REDACTED] sustained. I continued attempting to obtain a statement; however, Jennings became uncooperative and refused to answer any additional questions.

NARRATIVE (Continuation)

Because Jennings refused to provide further information and [REDACTED] had been transported to Cleveland Clinic Hospital due to the severity of [REDACTED] injuries, Deputy Coultry responded to the hospital to obtain a more detailed statement from [REDACTED] while I remained on scene with Jennings and his vehicle.

[REDACTED] later provided the following summarized statement to Deputy Coultry, as documented in his supplemental report:

On July 12, 2026, at approximately 1050 hours, I was dispatched to the South Gate of Lost Tree Preserve in reference to a disturbance.

Upon arrival, I made contact with [REDACTED] at the entrance gate. [REDACTED] was observed bleeding heavily from a large laceration above [REDACTED] left eyebrow. [REDACTED] advised that a [REDACTED] later identified as Bernard Jennings, had struck [REDACTED] in the head with a metal object before leaving the scene. [REDACTED] believed Bernard remained within the subdivision. [REDACTED] described Bernard as operating a work truck towing a white trailer with green lettering on the side and stated Bernard was wearing a blue hat and blue pants.

Deputy Sheriff Dyess arrived on scene and remained with [REDACTED] while obtaining additional information from a potential witness. I entered the subdivision in an attempt to locate the suspect. I located a work truck matching the description provided parked in front of a residence at 4319 Lago Circle. I observed an individual, later identified as Bernard Jennings, operating a lawn mower. I motioned for Bernard to stop and walk over to the trailer. Once he exited the lawn mower, I requested his identification and stood by while Deputy Sheriff Dyess interviewed him. I subsequently assisted Deputy Sheriff Dyess with placing Bernard Jennings into handcuffs and conducted a search of his person incident to detention.

I later responded to Cleveland Clinic Hospital, where I interviewed [REDACTED] stated [REDACTED] has known Bernard Jennings for many years and had no difficulty identifying him. Earlier that morning, at approximately 0800 hours, Bernard picked [REDACTED] up from [REDACTED] residence to assist with landscaping jobs for Bernard's business. After completing the first yard, Bernard repeatedly criticized [REDACTED] work and yelled at [REDACTED]. [REDACTED] no longer wished to work with Bernard and requested to be taken home.

NARRATIVE (Continuation)

Instead of returning [REDACTED] home, Bernard drove north toward Lost Tree Preserve to complete additional landscaping jobs. Bernard stopped the vehicle near the entrance gate to the subdivision. [REDACTED] exited the truck and slammed the passenger door as [REDACTED] walked away. According to [REDACTED] this angered Bernard.

[REDACTED] stated that as [REDACTED] turned around while walking away from the truck, Bernard approached [REDACTED] from behind while holding a metal object and struck [REDACTED] in the head. Bernard then returned to the truck and fled the area.

[REDACTED] advised [REDACTED] recognized the object used during the assault and believed it to be the trailer hitch lock later located inside Bernard Jennings' truck.

I returned to 4319 Lago Circle to await the next available tow rotation for the removal of Jennings' work truck and trailer.

Based on the totality of the circumstances, including the victim's statement, the independent witness statement, Jennings' admissions, the physical evidence, and the injuries observed, probable cause was established to arrest Bernard Jennings. Prior to taking Jennings into custody, Jennings advised deputies he was currently on federal probation for trafficking.

Following Jennings' arrest, an inventory of valuables was conducted prior to towing his work truck and trailer. During the inventory, I located a TowSmart trailer hitch lock on the front passenger seat. I observed a fresh red substance, consistent with blood, on the lower metal portion of the hitch lock. I photographed the item utilizing the Axon application and uploaded the photographs to Evidence.com. The hitch lock was placed into a brown paper evidence bag, secured in my patrol vehicle, and later submitted into evidence for further processing.

Photographs of [REDACTED] injuries were also taken and uploaded to Axon Evidence.

Jennings was transported to the Indian River County Jail, where custody was transferred to jail staff for processing.

Based upon the facts and circumstances of this investigation, I determined Bernard Jennings knowingly and intentionally violated Florida State Statute 784.045, Aggravated Battery, by using a heavy metal object capable of causing death or great bodily harm to strike [REDACTED] in the head, causing a large laceration above [REDACTED] left eyebrow. Additionally, Jennings violated Florida State Statute 784.08, Battery on a Person 65 Years of Age or Older, as Jennings acknowledged after being advised of his Miranda rights that he knew [REDACTED]

NARRATIVE

On Monday, July 13, 2026, at approximately 0900 hours. I served the defendant, Thomas Jason Hrusovsky with Indian River County warrant # (WR120261004). Hrusovsky was at the McDonalds located at 5875 20th Street standing outside.

IRC deputy Saint-Eloi advised the aforementioned subject had an active warrant from this county which was confirmed through PSD. After making contact Hrusovsky was placed into custody. Upon a search of Hrusovsky's persons incident to arrest in his left pant pocket I located a small folded piece of aluminum foil that deputy Harvey retrieved.

Within the aluminum foil, I observed a white/tan-ish powder which appeared to very fine in nature. The black backpack that was attached to Hrusovsky was searched by IRC deputy Harvey who located a small gold metal box containing a clear baggie with a white unknown substance that was later field tested by this deputy with an agency issued drug tested kit, which yielded positive for the presence of fentanyl. The total substance was weighed in the aluminum foil and clear baggie, which resulted in .6 grams.

Hrusovsky was read his Miranda warnings from my agency issued Miranda card and he advised me the contraband located inside the bag he believes it to be fentanyl.

With the statement made by Hrusovsky and evidence located, I find Hrusovsky to be in violation of F.S.S. 893.13 Possession of a controlled substance.

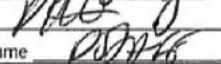

The undersigned certifies and swears that he/she has just and reasonable grounds to believe that the above named defendant committed the following violation of law:
On **07/13/2026**, at **14:58** (Specifically include facts constituting cause for arrest.)

On **07/13/26**, at approximately 1500 hours, I responded to Publix, located at 9621 US 1, Sebastian, Florida, in reference to a retail theft.

Upon arrival, I met with the store manager, Brooke Weisman, who advised of the following: A male, later identified as Christopher Munroe, entered the store wearing black shorts and a gray shirt while pushing a Publix shopping cart. Christopher proceeded to the alcoholic beverage aisle, selected four 24-pack cases of Bud Light, and placed them into the shopping cart. Christopher then walked throughout the store, passed all points of sale without attempting to pay for the merchandise, exited the store, and walked towards Barber Street. The incident was captured on Publix's surveillance cameras, and the video will be attached to this report.

The surveillance video showed Christopher meeting another male, later identified as Michael Guadagno, immediately after exiting the store. The two males then walked away together with the shopping cart containing the four 24-pack cases of Bud Light. No other merchandise was inside the shopping cart.

Brooke advised that Publix wished to pursue criminal charges against both individuals and requested that both be trespassed from Publix, located at 9621 US 1, and Publix Liquors, located at 9625 US 1. Brooke initially advised the value of the stolen Bud Light was \$102.68 and the value of the shopping cart was approximately \$400.00.

While canvassing the area, I located a Publix shopping cart overturned near the roadway in the area of 9505 US 1. Officers searched the immediate area and located Christopher and Michael lying on the ground nearby while smoking cigarettes. The four 24-pack cases of Bud Light were concealed underneath the two males along with their personal bags.

After advising Michael of his Miranda rights, he agreed to speak with Officers. Michael stated he had been waiting at a nearby bus stop when Christopher asked if he wanted to drink. Michael repeatedly stated that he had money and could have paid for alcohol if necessary. He denied knowing Christopher intended to steal the merchandise. Throughout the interview, Michael provided inconsistent statements regarding his involvement and changed his account multiple times. Based on the surveillance video, Michael's immediate association with Christopher after the theft, his continued possession of the stolen property, and his inconsistent statements, Officers developed probable cause to believe Michael knowingly aided Christopher in the commission of the theft.

Sergeant Bruckner advised Christopher of his Miranda rights. Christopher admitted, in summary, that he knew he had been captured on surveillance video taking the merchandise and leaving the store without paying. See Sergeant Bruckner's supplement report for Christopher's complete statement.

After detaining both subjects, Officers returned to Publix to obtain additional information from Brooke. During a search of Michael's personal belongings, Officers located additional beer and food items that were cold to the touch. When asked about these items, Michael stated he had purchased them from the Chevron gas station. Officers responded to the Chevron located south of Sebastian and confirmed no merchandise had been stolen from that business. Officers then returned to Publix, where Brooke positively identified the additional beer and food items as merchandise belonging to Publix that had not been purchased. Brooke provided an updated total retail value of the stolen merchandise of \$180.35 and advised the replacement value of the shopping cart was \$300.00.

Based on the surveillance video, Christopher's admission, the recovery of the stolen merchandise, and the investigation, probable cause was established that Christopher knowingly and unlawfully obtained Publix's property with the intent to temporarily or permanently deprive Publix of its use or benefit. Christopher was charged with Theft, in violation of F.S.S. 812.014, and Theft of a Shopping Cart, in violation of F.S.S. 506.509.

Per the victim's statements, Michael immediately met Christopher after the theft, remaining in possession of the stolen merchandise, accompanying Christopher while transporting the stolen property, his inconsistent statements during the investigation, and the totality of the circumstances, probable cause was established that Michael aided and assisted Christopher in the commission of the theft. Michael was charged with Theft (F.S.S. 812.014), pursuant to Florida's Principal statute (F.S.S. 777.011), and Theft of a Shopping Cart (F.S.S. 506.509), pursuant to F.S.S. 777.011.

The undersigned certifies and swears that he/she has just and reasonable grounds to believe that the above named defendant committed the following violation of law:

On **07/13/2026**, at **14:58** (Specifically include facts constituting cause for arrest.)**PROBABLE CAUSE STATEMENT**

On 07/13/26, at approximately 1500 hours, I responded to Publix, located at 9621 US 1, Sebastian, Florida, in reference to a retail theft.

Upon arrival, I met with the store manager, Brooke Weisman, who advised of the following: A male, later identified as Christopher Munroe, entered the store wearing black shorts and a gray shirt while pushing a Publix shopping cart. Christopher proceeded to the alcoholic beverage aisle, selected four 24-pack cases of Bud Light, and placed them into the shopping cart. Christopher then walked throughout the store, passed all points of sale without attempting to pay for the merchandise, exited the store, and walked towards Barber Street. The incident was captured on Publix's surveillance cameras, and the video will be attached to this report.

The surveillance video showed Christopher meeting another male, later identified as Michael Guadagno, immediately after exiting the store. The two males then walked away together with the shopping cart containing the four 24-pack cases of Bud Light. No other merchandise was inside the shopping cart.

Brooke advised that Publix wished to pursue criminal charges against both individuals and requested that both be trespassed from Publix, located at 9621 US 1, and Publix Liquors, located at 9625 US 1. Brooke initially advised the value of the stolen Bud Light was \$102.68 and the value of the shopping cart was approximately \$400.00.

While canvassing the area, I located a Publix shopping cart overturned near the roadway in the area of 9505 US 1. Officers searched the immediate area and located Christopher and Michael lying on the ground nearby while smoking cigarettes. The four 24-pack cases of Bud Light were concealed underneath the two males along with their personal bags.

After advising Michael of his Miranda rights, he agreed to speak with Officers. Michael stated he had been waiting at a nearby bus stop when Christopher asked if he wanted to drink. Michael repeatedly stated that he had money and could have paid for alcohol if necessary. He denied knowing Christopher intended to steal the merchandise. Throughout the interview, Michael provided inconsistent statements regarding his involvement and changed his account multiple times. Based on the surveillance video, Michael's immediate association with Christopher after the theft, his continued possession of the stolen property, and his inconsistent statements, Officers developed probable cause to believe Michael knowingly aided Christopher in the commission of the theft.

Sergeant Bruckner advised Christopher of his Miranda rights. Christopher admitted, in summary, that he knew he had been captured on surveillance video taking the merchandise and leaving the store without paying. See Sergeant Bruckner's supplement report for Christopher's complete statement.

After detaining both subjects, Officers returned to Publix to obtain additional information from Brooke. During a search of Michael's personal belongings, Officers located additional beer and food items that were cold to the touch. When asked about these items, Michael stated he had purchased them from the Chevron gas station. Officers responded to the Chevron located south of Sebastian and confirmed no merchandise had been stolen from that business. Officers then returned to Publix, where Brooke positively identified the additional beer and food items as merchandise belonging to Publix that had not been purchased. Brooke provided an updated total retail value of the stolen merchandise of \$180.35 and advised the replacement value of the shopping cart was \$300.00.

Based on the surveillance video, Christopher's admission, the recovery of the stolen merchandise, and the investigation, probable cause was established that Christopher knowingly and unlawfully obtained Publix's property with the intent to temporarily or permanently deprive Publix of its use or benefit. Christopher was charged with Theft, in violation of F.S.S. 812.014, and Theft of a Shopping Cart, in violation of F.S.S. 506.509.

Per the victim's statements, Michael immediately met Christopher after the theft, remaining in possession of the stolen merchandise, accompanying Christopher while transporting the stolen property, his inconsistent statements during the investigation, and the totality of the circumstances, probable cause was established that Michael aided and assisted Christopher in the commission of the theft. Michael was charged with Theft (F.S.S. 812.014), pursuant to Florida's Principal statute (F.S.S. 777.011), and Theft of a Shopping Cart (F.S.S. 506.509), pursuant to F.S.S. 777.011.
