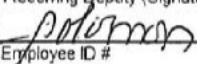

NARRATIVE

On Tuesday, July 14, 2026 at approximately 0138 hours, I conducted a traffic enforcement stop on a silver Jeep Cherokee (FL / 74AEBI) in the 300 Block of Old Dixie Highway SW in Vero Beach, Florida.

While patrolling near the 800 Block of Old Dixie Highway, I observed the above vehicle make a wide turn onto Old Dixie Highway. As it traveled South, it continuously weaved within its lane for several miles. The vehicle activated its turn signal and motioned as if to turn but then continued to drive. As it continued, I became more concerned for the operator's ability to operate the motor vehicle as the above driving pattern was not normal. I conducted a traffic enforcement stop and activated my emergency lights. The vehicle did not immediately yield and continued to travel, bypassing multiple safe places to pull over. The vehicle finally made another wide left turn onto 3rd Lane SW where it came to a final stop.

I approached the vehicle on the driver's side. I made contact with the driver, Mr. Ivan Colon (Arrestee) who I identified by the Florida driver's license he presented me. Initially, Ivan attempted to hand me his entire wallet. When I asked him to remove his license, he fumbled with his wallet and it took him an extended period of time to remove it. He then handed me an expired registration. Ivan had difficulty forming full and complete sentences.

While speaking with Ivan, I could smell a strong distinct odor of an alcoholic beverage emitting from his breath. His eyes were watery and glassy and his speech was slurred. I asked Ivan to exit and he stated he wasn't going to answer any question and he wanted his lawyer. I explained he was not entitled to a lawyer on the side of the road and instructed him to step out of the vehicle. I explained if he refused, I would remove him from the vehicle. Ivan slowly exited the vehicle, bouncing off of his door and staggered towards my patrol car.

After Ivan exited his vehicle, I continued to smell the strong odor of an alcoholic beverage emitting from his breath. I explained my concern for his ability to operate a motor vehicle safely and he stated "Well, can she drive?" I asked Ivan if he would complete Standard Field Sobriety Exercises (SFSE's) with me and he nodded his head yes.

I began by questioning Ivan about his medical history. Ivan disclosed he had a previous [REDACTED] [REDACTED] When I asked Ivan what medications he took, he mumbled the conditions he took them for. Ivan stated he is retired. Ivan denied consuming any illegal narcotics. When I asked how many alcoholic drinks he consumed, he stammered for several seconds the stated "Uhm, my lawyer."

I then re-iterated my concern for his ability to operate his motor vehicle and he stated he wanted his lawyer. Ivan then stated again he wanted his lawyer, I explained he was not entitled to his lawyer on the

side of the road. He then stated 'Well anyway, I just wanna plead the fifth.' Ivan then refused to complete SFSE's. I gave Ivan a warning consistent with Taylor V. State and advised that his refusal may be used against him. Ivan still refused and was placed in handcuffs. Ivan then changed his statement and agreed to do SFSE's. Ivan was removed from handcuffs.

The first exercise I administered was the Horizontal Gaze Nystagmus (HGN) exercise. I explained the exercise to Ivan who stated he understood the instructions. Ivan's pupils were of approximate equal size and tracked simultaneously. I observed the following validated clues of impairment: Lack of smooth pursuit. I made several attempts at this exercise. Ivan was unable to track my stimulus with his eyes. I confirmed he was able to see the stimulus and had him reach out to touch the red light with his finger. Ivan had to be instructed multiple times not to move his head during this exercise. Ivan also had a 2-inch orbital sway.

The second exercise I attempted to administer was the Walk and Turn (WAT) exercise. I explained and demonstrated the exercise to Ivan. Ivan was unable to maintain the starting position and claimed his hip prevented him from being able to complete the exercise properly. Ivan refused to attempt this exercise.

The Third exercise I attempted to administer was the One Leg Stand (OLS) exercise. I instructed Ivan into the starting position. I explained and demonstrated the exercise for Ivan. Ivan began the exercise before being prompted to. He then stated he was incapable of completing the exercise and stated he had a cane in the vehicle he needed to walk.

I then transitioned and administered the N.A.S.B.L.A. seated battery tasks.

The first task I administered was the Finger to Nose (FTN) task. I explained the instructions to Ivan who stated he understood the instructions. I observe the following indicators of impairment. During the instruction phase: Unable to follow instructions. During the performance stage: Did not close eyes, did not tilt head back, opened eyes during task. Before I finished the instructions, Ivan stated "Just arrest me!" I observed the following during the exercise: When I said begin, David stared ahead with his eyes open and began to touch his nose unprompted with his left finger.

- L1 – Pad – Tip of nose
- R2 – Pad – Tip of Nose (Opened eyes)
- L3 – Pad – Tip of nose (I called out wrong hand / He used appropriate hand)
- R4 – Pad – Left Nostril
- R5 – Pad – Tip of Nose
- L6 – Pad – Bridge of Nose

The second exercise I administered was the Palm Pat exercise. I explained and demonstrated the exercise for Ivan who stated he understood the instructions. During the instruction stage, I observed the following clues of impairment: Started at the wrong time. During the Performance stage, I observed the following clues of impairment: Other improper pat (Ivan opened his hand like he was opening and closing a book), did not increase speed, and stopped before being told.

The third exercise I administered was the Hand Coordination exercise. I explained and demonstrated the exercise to Ivan twice. During the instruction stage, I observed the following clues of impairment: Started at the wrong time. During the performance stage, I observed the following clues of impairment: Improper touch (Task 1). Ivan did not perform tasks 2,3 or 4.

Based on the above observed indicators of impairment, I established probable cause for Driving under the influence and Ivan was placed under arrest.

During a search of his person, Deputy J. Sibole located a small clear plastic baggy that contained a powdery white substance. This substance field tested positive for the presence of cocaine. Total weight with package was approximately 0.45 grams.

Ivan was transported to the Indian River County Jail Complex without incident. Upon arrival, A twenty-minute observation period was initiated. After its expiration, Ivan was requested to provide a sample of his breath to determine its alcoholic content. Ivan refused and demanded his lawyer. Deputy F. Solomon (5815) attempted to read implied consent and Ivan loudly spoke over her. I attempted to reason with Ivan who refused to listen. Deputy Solomon continued to read implied consent and asked again if he would provide a sample and he willfully refused.

Ivan had to be restrained by Correctional staff after he refused to listen to lawful commands during the booking process. He repeatedly stood up and attempted to walk around the facility forcing corrections staff to stop what they were doing to address his behavior.

A query of D.A.V.I.D. revealed Ivan was convicted of a prior DUI on 01/29/1976 (UTC: 342L).

Ivan was ultimately charged with Possession of Cocaine, driving under the influence - 2nd Offense, refusal to submit to DUI testing, and resisting without violence.

Ivan was issued the following citations: Possession of controlled substance (ANUOM0E), DUI (ANHCBEE), refusal to submit (ANOULZE).

Ivan was booked into the Indian River County Jail and held on a NO BOND status.

NARRATIVE

On Tuesday, July 14, 2026, at approximately 0204 hours, I conducted a traffic enforcement stop on a white male operating a dark colored electric bicycle(E-Bike) in the area of Old Dixie Highway and 12th Street, Vero Beach, Florida, 32962.

The male was riding a dark colored E-Bike south on Old Dixie Highway towards 12th Street without front lights, he also was riding in the lane of travel not using the dedicated bike lane.

I conducted a traffic stop on the bike for the aforementioned violation, I made contact with a Hispanic male, who was identified by his Florida identification card as Mr. Gerardo Nieves (arrestee). Immediately upon contact with Mr. Nieves I could smell the distinct odor of an alcoholic beverage emitting from his breath. Mr. Nieves's eyes were watery, glassy and bloodshot. His speech was thick and slurred.

Mr. Nieves's movements were lethargic, I requested Mr. Nieves where he was coming from? Which he stated "Some bar and he had a few beers." I requested Mr. Nieves to submit to Standard Field Sobriety Exercises (SFSE's), which he was hesitant at first and then agreed to submit. Mr. Nieves made me aware of his [REDACTED]

The first exercise I administered was the Horizontal Gaze Nystagmus exercise. I explained the instructions to Mr. Nieves who stated he understood and did not have any questions. I observed Mr. Nieves's pupils were of approximately equal size and tracked simultaneously. During this exercise, I observed the following clues of impairment: Lack of Smooth Pursuit, Distinct and Sustained Nystagmus at Maximum Deviation and an angle of Onset Prior to forty-five degrees in both eyes. Mr. Nieves had an immediate angle of onset 35 degrees. Mr. Nieves had to be instructed not to move his head multiple times. He was also purposely not focusing on the stimulus in an attempt to disrupt the investigation.

The second exercise I administered was the Walk and Turn (WAT). I explained and demonstrated the exercise to Mr. Nieves. I instructed Mr. Nieves to stand in the starting position, which he was unable to stand in the starting position. The following clues of impairment were observed. Missed heel to toe, turned improperly, stepped off the line, raised arms for balance, wrong number of steps, stopped walking. Mr. Nieves did not complete this exercise to standard.

The third exercise I administered was the one leg stand (OLS). I explained and demonstrated the exercise to Mr. Nieves. Mr. Nieves was hesitant to due this exercise due to his [REDACTED] advised Mr. Nieves for his safety and wellbeing and alternative exercise would be administered.

The fourth exercise I administered was the Finger to Nose (FTN) exercise. I explained and

Mr. Nieves was placed under arrest for Driving under the influence and transported to the Indian River County Jail Complex. Mr. Nieves refused to provide a sample of his breath to determine its alcoholic content. Mr. Nieves was read implied consent by Deputy Salomon, and Mr. Nieves still refused to provide a sample.

An inquiry of D.A.V.I.D. was conducted and Mr. Nieves has two prior DUI convictions in 2000 and 2001.

Mr. Nieves was ultimately charged with Driving under the influence. Mr. Nieves was processed into Indian River County Jail and held on a total bond of \$~~1,000.00~~ 750.00

NARRATIVE

On July 14, 2026, at approximately 1300 hours, I, Deputy Lopez, conducted a traffic stop at Highland Dr SE and S US 1, Vero Beach, Florida 32962, on a red Nissan Altima License plate (37EKLL) for having a tinted windshield below the legal AS-1 line per statute (F.S.316.2952), driver, passenger and rear windows were also dark enough to obstruct my view into the vehicle. Vehicle also had tinted break lights which altered the light's color and reduced its visibility.

I activated my emergency lights and sirens to conduct a traffic stop on the vehicle. The driver, later identified with a Guatemalan identification card as Anderson Esduardo Solis Jimenez (DOB: 05/05/2006), came to a stop at the "7 Eleven" (210 Highland Dr SW, Vero Beach, Florida 3296). I approached the vehicle, identified myself, and asked why he had taken so long to pull over. Anderson explained that he was waiting for a vehicle pulling a trailer to pass before stopping.

I requested Anderson to provide me with his driver's license and vehicle registration. Anderson began searching for the requested documents in his wallet and provided me with a Guatemala identification card. Anderson was unable to produce a Florida driver's license, Florida identification card, or Social Security number. I asked if he had a Florida driver's license and how long he has been in the country. Anderson said he has been in the country for eight years and has never been issued a Florida driver's license. At that time, Anderson was asked to exit the vehicle, and was detained for further investigation.

I queried Anderson's information through FCIC/NCIC and D.A.V.I.D. to verify his identity by name and date of birth. No valid identification card, driver's license, or Social Security number could be located. After this information was established, Anderson was searched and placed under arrest in the rear of my patrol vehicle.

Based on the facts listed above, probable cause did exist for operating a motor vehicle without a valid driver's license. Anderson was transported to the Indian River County Jail, without incident.

NARRATIVE

On 07/14/2026 at approximately 1850 hours, I was dispatched along with Cpl. Lang to the 2700 block of 9th Street SW in reference to a reckless driver. The complainant identified themselves to dispatch as Nicholas Schubach. Nicholas provided the make of the vehicle, Black Chevrolet, as well as the license plate number, Florida #FCST84. Nicholas stated to our dispatch that the driver of the vehicle was swerving all over the road into other lanes of traffic and almost side swiped another vehicle.

At the approximately 3500 block of 9th Street SW, I had a visual of the described vehicle. I followed the vehicle in west on 9th Street SW until the 4300 block. I observed the vehicle failing to stay in its' lane. The vehicle then turned north onto 43rd Avenue from 9th Street SW. I continued to observe and while driving north the vehicle the vehicle continuously crossed over the right-side solid white line and corrected to center. The vehicle then turned east onto 1st Street SW, where I observed a wide right-hand turn. At the 4000 block of 1st Street SW, I activated the lights and sirens on my marked patrol vehicle. The vehicle continued to drive after multiple changes in siren sounds and blasts in the air horn. At the 2700 block of 1st Street SW the vehicle pulled off on the side of the road.

I made contact with the driver whom provided me a Guatemala identification card. The driver was identified as Julio Abelardo Garcia Perez. During this stop I observed Julio to have slurred speech and bloodshot eyes. I asked Julio to step out of the vehicle multiple times and he refused to do so. He repeatedly requested a Spanish speaking, Deputy. Julio then reached for the gear shift lever. Deputies responded by opening his truck door and physically removing him from the car. While walking him to the back of his truck he appeared to lack balance. Julio was asked if he had a valid driver's license or ID card in which he stated he did not. Julio was then placed under arrest and searched.

While processing the vehicle we located multiple half empty beer bottles behind the passenger's seat.

Julio was then taken to the Indian River County Sheriff's Office jail. Once we arrived, we began a DUI investigation. Julio had asked for a translator. Deputy Quiroz provided translation throughout the DUI investigation process. Julio was asked a series of medical questions prior to beginning the exercises. He claimed his equilibrium was affected by [REDACTED]. He would later clarify that he was taking [REDACTED]. His answers to the rest of the medical questions were unremarkable.

I began by administering the HGN exercise in which I observed the eyes tracked equally and pupils were of equal size. I also observed clues on the lack of smooth pursuit, nystagmus at maximum deviation, and nystagmus prior to 45 degrees.

I then administered the walk and turn exercise which I observed multiple clues. During this exercise Julio failed to maintain the proper stance while waiting to begin. He then began the test early. Other clues

demonstrated steps off the line and missing heel to toe.

The last exercise that was administered was the one leg stand. On this exercise Julio did not lift his foot 6 inches off the ground and put it down before 30 seconds multiple times. At approximately 25 seconds Julio put his foot down and stated he could not finish the exercise. After completing these exercises, I explained to Julio that based on the clues of the exercises I believed he was under the influence and asked if he would provide a breath sample.

He consented to provide a breath sample. The first breath sample that was provided was .186 BAC. The second breath sample provided was .187 BAC.

Julio was then read his Miranda rights. He stated that he understood his rights and still wished to speak with us. Julio was asked if he had been drinking which he responded yes. He stated that he had started drinking at approximately 1000 hours and drank about three Modelo's up until 1600 hours. He has been attempting to get a Florida driver's license for the past nine months. He has lived in the U.S and the state of Florida for 13 years.

Based on the above facts I find probable cause to charge Julio with the following;
