The undersigned certifies and swears that he/she has just and reasonable grounds to believe that the above named defendant committed the following violation of law:
 On **07/15/2026** at **01:10** (Specifically include facts constituting cause for arrest.)

On 07/15/2026 at approximately 0114 hours, I, Ofc. Herrera, responded to [REDACTED] in reference to a disturbance.

Earlier tonight at approximately 1217 hours, I responded to a disturbance at this location. When I arrived on scene, I was approached by [REDACTED] they were outside of the residence. The family advised me that there was a male inside throwing and breaking things. I walked inside and made contact with the male, later identified as Quinton D. Herron (DOB: 09/13/1991). He was irate and yelling. Inside the residence I observed shattered glass and broken furniture on the ground.

After separating Herron from the family, I asked if anyone was injured and if Herron hurt anyone and the family stated that he did not hurt anyone and that they were all ok. The family stated that Herron broke one of the back windows then came around to the front of the residence and was let in by Hubertys R. Inciarte (DOB: 10/15/1985) and that's when Herron began to throw and break things. I asked if they knew who Herron was and Mr. Inciarte stated that Herron was his husband and that Herron has been living there with them. The family did not know why he was acting this way and upon speaking to Herron, he was not very cooperative and stated that he was looking for a phone and continued to yell at the family.

Herron agreed to leave the residence and left for the night to a friends residence in Vero Beach. He agreed he would not be back tonight.

After approximately one hour, Herron returned to [REDACTED] When I arrived on scene, Herron was standing outside in front of the residence.

I spoke with [REDACTED] informed me that Herron came back and broke a lot of the windows of the residence and made his way back in the house. [REDACTED] stated that Herron was yelling and being aggressive towards the family. [REDACTED] informed me that they were scared and that the kids were hiding in the bathroom. [REDACTED] informed me that Herron was approaching [REDACTED] and yelling at [REDACTED] as [REDACTED] tried to calm him down [REDACTED] kept telling him that he was scaring the kids and that he needed to stop. [REDACTED] stated that Herron approached [REDACTED] and got within arms reach, raised his right arm with a closed fist and threw a punch at [REDACTED] but [REDACTED] was able to duck and he struck the door. [REDACTED] stated that there was [REDACTED] in the room next to [REDACTED] and that [REDACTED] closed the door as he was throwing his punch. As [REDACTED] was explaining this, I observed that the door was broken and had a hole in it.

I spoke with [REDACTED] and the family and they confirmed [REDACTED] statements.

I attempted to speak with Herron but he was still uncooperative and continued to yell at the family.

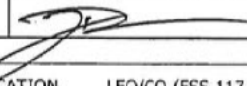
Based on the above-mentioned circumstances, Herron was placed under arrest for violation of Florida State Statue 784.03 - Battery and Florida State Statue 777.04. Herron was transported to the Indian River County Jail without further incident.

NARRATIVE

On July 15, 2026, at approximately 1310 hours, I observed a white Nissan Altima fail to yield to the solid white stop bar at the intersection of 32nd Ave and 41st Street.

Corporal Portocarrero and I initiated a traffic stop and made contact with the driver who was later identified as Davionne Stinson. Stinson immediately opened the door and placed her left foot out in what appeared to be a chance to separate herself from the vehicle. She stated the window was inoperable, however, the driver door window was slightly open.

I advised Stinson to stay in the vehicle. Upon talking with Stinson I observed a strong pungent odor emitting from the vehicle. Based on my training and experience I distinguished this to be burnt marijuana. We asked Stinson if she had a valid medical marijuana card in the State of Florida to which she responded "No" and further stated there was no marijuana in the vehicle. Furthermore, I asked for Stinson's Florida Driver License. Upon Stinson acknowledging the request she first reached for and patted her front left pant pocket then proceeded to reach from a seated position behind the passenger seat and placed her hand into an open bag. Stinson manipulated the entire bag before retrieving a brown wallet. She removed her ID. Upon Stinson removing her ID I observed a Social Security Card. Stinson placed her wallet back into the same bag before retrieving the wrong registration card from the glove compartment. During this initial encounter I observed ashes and a leafy substance scattered throughout the floorboard. Based on my training and experience, the ash-like residue and leafy material were consistent with marijuana use inside the vehicle.

Stinson was asked further investigative questions throughout the initial encounter. When previously asked if there was any marijuana in the vehicle she replied no. On this separate occasion when asked about the presence of marijuana within the vehicle, she immediately began looking around the vehicle. Corporal Portocarrero asked if there was anything in the center console because it was closed and could be concealing items. Under her own free will Stinson initially replied no then proceeded to open a compartment and remove a green tray containing a leafy substance along with a sealed blue Buzzball which is an alcoholic beverage. She then handed this to Corporal Portocarrero without being asked verbally stating "here."

Stinson without threat or promise consented to a vehicle search. All occupants were removed before the search was conducted.

I began by searching the front passenger seat where the 15-year-old male was sitting. I observed the same ashy substance along the floorboard. I moved the driver seat where I found no significant items of interest. I then proceeded to the rear seats where I located a open brown bag, the same brown bag Stinson had repeatedly reached into while retrieving her wallet and identification. Within the bag I located a loaded semi-automatic firearm with one round chambered, a baggie containing a green leafy substance consistent with marijuana and a grinder with a

green leafy substance residue. I also located Stinson's wallet which included her Social Security card, bank cards, a health insurance card, and a photo that matched. All documents located contained Stinson's legal name. It should be noted the bag was open with the firearm not securely encased by the bag not being zipped up and Stinson's ability to freely grab and manipulate items while seated in the driver seat.

Prior to speaking with the individuals, I returned to my patrol car and began to conduct a FCIC/NCIC history search on Stinson. While sitting in the vehicle I heard Stinson spontaneously utter that the firearm was not gifted to her and she had no knowledge of its presence within the bag nor vehicle.

I spoke with the juvenile male who was identified as Kingston Chambers. Kingston stated he had no knowledge of the firearm prior to this Law Enforcement interaction.

I then spoke with Stinson. I advised Stinson of her Miranda Constitutional Rights, she acknowledged them and began to speak with me. Stinson stated she had no knowledge of the firearm. She further stated that the firearm was not gifted nor was it inherited. Stinson went on to state the bag was not hers and she just utilized it to store her wallet while in the vehicle.

I placed Stinson under arrest. Deputy Coultry conducted a search incident to arrest and located no items of interest.

I placed Stinson in the back of my patrol car and activated the interior camera.

Stinson was transported to the Indian River County Jail and subsequently turned over to booking staff.

Based on Stinson's repeated manipulation of the bag before the search, the presence of her wallet and personal identifying documents inside the bag, and the location of the marijuana and grinder within the same bag, I believe Stinson knowingly exercised domination and control over the marijuana and drug paraphernalia therefore in violation of Florida State Statutes 893.147.1 and 893.13.6b.

NARRATIVE

On Wednesday, 07/15/2026, at approximately 1930, I responded to 4000 43rd Avenue, Vero Beach, Florida 32960, to assist Sergeant Flores with a traffic stop on a blue GMC Yukon bearing Florida tag#CI65UQ.

The probable cause for the traffic stop is outlined below by Sergeant Flores:

"On July 15, 2026 at 1930 hours I was on patrol and observed a blue GMC Yukon XL driving towards me north on 43rd Ave just before 40th Street. This is a 45 mph zone. I estimated the Yukon to be approaching me at a speed higher than the posted limit. I estimated the speed to be 60 MPH. I activated my stalker DSR 2X and received a reading of 62 MPH.

I turned around never losing sight and stopped the vehicle just before 41st Street. I approached the driver and asked for his credentials. I could smell the strong odor of burnt marijuana emitting from the vehicle. I asked the driver now known as Jeffrey Velde if he has a medical marijuana card and he stated yes. I could see marijuana shake on top of the center console. I also had the passenger David Lee Homberto Hill give me his identification since he was not wearing a seatbelt.

I then called for another unit to respond and Deputy Yerian arrived. I explained to Yerian what I had and found that Velde is in the medical marijuana registry but he has no outstanding prescriptions for marijuana."

See Sergeant Flores's supplement for further information.

Upon arrival I made contact with the driver, identified as Jeffrey Alexander Velde, at the driver's side of the vehicle. When I approached the vehicle, I smelled a strong pungent odor, which based on my training and experience I was able to immediately identify as marijuana. I asked Velde if he had any marijuana in the vehicle, which he stated he did prior to driving the car, but removed it from the vehicle before he made the decision to drive. Sergeant Flores was in the process of conducting a query into Velde's driver's license and medical marijuana status through the Indian River County Sheriff's Office non-emergency Dispatch, while that process was on-going, I had Velde step out of the vehicle.

Sergeant Flores was advised that Velde did not have an active medical marijuana card and subsequently conducted a vehicle search while I continued to have a conversation with Velde. Sergeant Flores advised me to take Velde into custody, once he was secured in the back of my patrol car I met with Sergeant Flores at the driver's side of the blue Yukon. During the search of the vehicle, Sergeant Flores located a compartment in the center console that was able to be removed. Sergeant Flores noted that the compartment could only be opened from the driver's side because if attempted on the passenger side, it remained locked in place. After removing the compartment, a zip-lock bagging containing a green leafy

substance (immediately identifiable as marijuana based on my training and experience) as-well as a white powdery rock-like substance, which based on my training and experience I immediately recognized as crack cocaine.

Based on the discovery of the items inside the compartment, I went back to my patrol car and advised Velde of his Miranda rights, which he invoked and did not want to speak with me. Utilizing an agency provided test kit I conducted a field test of the suspected crack cocaine. The test kit yielded a distinct blue coloration change indicating a field presumptive positive test for the presence of crack cocaine.

During my field test Sergeant Flores began to question the passenger, David Lee Homberto Hill, about the knowledge of the items in the vehicle. Hill stated he did not see Velde attempt to conceal anything nor was he aware of any illegal substances inside of the vehicle. See Sergeant Flore's supplement for further information.

At the time of this investigation, Velde had physical control over the vehicle and center consol. Velde's personal belongings including a work cellphone, wallet and cash were located inside the center consol of the vehicle in the direct vicinity of the compartment where the illegal substances where located. Velde stated that he is an active marijuana user and that Hill has never taken any illegal substances to his knowledge. Additionally, the compartment where the illegal substances was located was only accessible from the driver side area of the vehicle.

Based on the totality of the circumstances, Jeffrey Alexander Velde was placed under arrest for the following offenses:

- F.S.S. 893.13 – Felony Possession of a Controlled Substance

Velde was transported to the Indian River County Jail without further issue.

NARRATIVE

On July 13th, 2026, at approximately 2316 hours, Corporal Thomas and I were dispatched to 5555 20th Street, Vero Beach, Florida, 32966 for a shoplifting in progress.

Prior to my arrival, the communication center advised there were 2 suspects involved. One being a white female with blonde hair wearing a black sweatshirt and the second was a white male was wearing a black hat and black shirt and had stolen approximately \$62 worth of merchandise. The female later identified as Monica Barton had left the scene and the male later identified as Donovan Lucas, was with loss prevention.

I went into the loss prevention office where I watched the camera footage of Donovan and Monica at the self-checkout. I observed Monica placed a bag of three oranges onto the scale and selected one as the total amount. Monica handed the following items to Donovan to be placed in a bag without being scanned: 1 pack of AA batteries, 1 salon perfect press on nails, 1 KISS my lash but better fake eyelashes, 1 Billie Rzrbl (makeup). The total for all the items is \$64.32. Monica and Donovan walked past all points of sale when loss prevention met them at the exit. When asked to go back to the loss prevention office Monica left the cart of items and Donovan at the store. Based on the evidence gathered on scene, probable cause was established for their arrest. Donovan was taken into custody on scene, and all attempts to locate Monica were met with negative results.

On Wednesday, July 15th, 2026 at approximately 2100 hours, Corporal Thomas, Deputy Lowell, and I responded to the Howard Johnson Hotel at, 1985 90th Avenue, Vero Beach, FL, 32966, room 237, in an attempt to locate Monica.

Upon arrival we came in contact with her and I was able to identify her by the camera footage from Wal-Mart and her name and date of birth. She was detained in handcuffs behind her back, they were checked for fitment and double locked. I read her Miranda rights off an agency issued card. She admitted to being at Wal-Mart on Sunday, July 12th, 2026, with Donovan, and confirmed it was her on the surveillance footage. She denied any involvement in the theft, though could not explain why she did not scan the items.

Based on the above it was determined that Monica did knowingly obtain or use, or endeavor to obtain or use merchandise of a value of \$64.32, which was the property of Wal-Mart, or any other person not the defendant(s), with the intent to permanently or temporarily deprive Wal-Mart or any other person not the defendant(s) of the property or benefit therefrom or to appropriate the property to the use of Monica Barton or to the use of any person not entitled thereto, contrary to Florida Statute 812.014(1) and (2)(e). (2 DEG MISD)
