NARRATIVE

On Thursday, June 11, 2026 at approximately 0052 hours, I conducted a traffic enforcement stop on a black Range Rover (FL / 76BDVAV) in the 14000 block of US Highway 1 in Sebastian, Florida.

While traveling North on US Highway 1, I observed the above black Range rover make a U-turn while headed South. I followed the vehicle and observed the vehicle cross over the solid white line towards the median and the broken lane divider line multiple times.

I activated my emergency lights and the vehicle did not immediately yield. It turned onto N. Indian River Drive, I activated my siren and the vehicle turned left into a picnic area.

I made contact with the driver and sole occupant of the vehicle, who I identified as Mr. Alexander Gomez, by the Florida Driver's license he provided me. As I spoke with Mr. Gomez, I detected his speech pattern to be slowed and lethargic. I asked Mr. Gomez where he was coming from and he initially stated "Vero Beach" when I asked him more specifically, he stated "a friend's house." I believed Mr. Gomez was deceptive with his answers to my questions. Mr. Gomez appeared to be nervous, and was speaking in incoherent sentences. Mr. Gomez had difficulty finding his registration and insurance documents. He initially handed me the title to his vehicle.

Mr. Gomez stated multiple times, "I am just trying to make it home!" and "I live right over there." Both of which are phrases I know to be commonly uttered by impaired individuals. I asked Mr. Gomez if he had consumed any alcoholic beverages or narcotics, which he denied. When I asked about alcohol, Mr. Gomez broke eye contact with me and stared ahead.

Mr. Gomez was asked to exit the vehicle. I explained my concern for his ability to operate a motor vehicle safely and requested he submit to Standardized Field Sobriety Exercises (SFSE's). Mr. Gomez agreed. Mr. Gomez did not provide any medical responses that were alarming to his completion of the exercises. Mr. Gomez again denied consumption of any alcohol or narcotics.

The first exercise I administered was the Horizontal Gaze Nystagmus (HGN) exercise. I explained the exercise to Mr. Gomez who stated he understood the instructions. Mr. Gomez did not have resting Nystagmus. His pupils were equal in size and tracked simultaneously. I observed the following validated clues of impairment: Lack of Smooth Pursuit and Distinct and Sustained Nystagmus at Maximum Deviation in both eyes. I did not observe Onset of Nystagmus prior to 45 degrees or Vertical Gaze Nystagmus (VGN). During this exercise, Mr. Gomez had an approximately 2-inch orbital sway and had to be reminded multiple times not to move his head.

The second exercise I administered was the Walk and Turn (WAT) exercise. I explained and demonstrated the exercise to Mr. Gomez who stated he understood the instructions and did not have any

questions. Mr. Gomez had difficulty getting into the starting position and stepped offline to his left. He then mumbled "Its kind of difficult to do under any circumstance!" During this exercise, I observed the following validated clues of impairment: Used arms to balance, missed heel to toe (3x), Improper turn and improper number of steps (10 steps on his return). Mr. Gomez DID NOT complete this exercise to standard.

The third exercise I administered was the One leg Stand (OLS) exercise. I explained and demonstrated the exercise to Mr. Gomez who stated he understood the instructions and did not have any questions. I observed the following validated clues of impairment: Put foot down, used arms for balance, and swayed while attempting exercise. Mr. Gomez began by raising his left foot off the ground. He counted to "7-1000" which he repeated twice and after 8-1000, he placed his foot on the ground. When asked if he understood the exercise, he stated to me "I thought you said 1000 seconds?" Mr. Gomez then asked for another attempt.

I explained and demonstrated the exercise a second time to Mr. Gomez who stated he understood the instructions and did not have any questions. I observed the following validated clues of impairment: Puts foot down, used arms for balance, and swayed while attempting the exercise. Mr. Gomez again raised his left foot off the ground. He had to be reminded to keep his leg straight and 6 inches off the ground. Mr. Gomez DID NOT complete this exercise to standard.

The fourth exercise I administered was the Modified Romberg Balance (MRB) exercise. I explained and demonstrated the exercise to Mr. Gomez who stated he understood the instructions and did not have any questions. Mr. Gomez began the exercise by counting aloud and had to be reminded to count in his head. He counted to "30 seconds" in the real time of 36 seconds, outside of the allotted +/- 5 second variance. Mr. Gomez also had an orbital sway while completing this exercise.

The fifth exercise I administered was the Finger to Nose (FTN) exercise. I explained and demonstrated the exercise to Mr. Gomez who stated he understood the instructions and did not have any questions.

During this exercise, I observed the following clues of impairment:

- Left: Low on the Apex (DNR)
- Right: Pad (DNR)
- Left: Pad on the bridge (DNR)
- Right: Pad on the apex (DNR)
- Right: Pad
- Left: Pad

The sixth exercise I administered was the Modified Romberg Alphabet (MRA) exercise. I explained and demonstrated the exercise to Mr. Gomez who stated he understood the instructions and did not have any questions. Mr. Gomez stated the following "CDEFG... I don't know..." he then began at "A" and mumbled until he got to "LMN" which he repeated twice he then kept mumbling the alphabet.

Based on the above indicators of impairment, Mr. Gomez was placed under arrest for Driving under the influence.

During an inventory search of Mr. Gomez's vehicle, I located 7 individually packaged "Ziploc" bags of a green leafy substance that field tested positive for marijuana. The bags were the following weights: 30.83g, 5.47g, 29.78g, 31.20g, 31.13g, 35.38g, and 19.51g. Total package weight including baggies was approximately 183.3 grams. I also located 4 THC Vape pens in their respective boxes.

Inside of Mr. Gomez wallet, I located a large amount of cash in small denominations consistent with narcotic sales. The cash was US Currency, broken into the following denominations: \$100 (2), \$50 (1), \$20 (6), \$5 (4), and \$1 (27). For a total of \$412.


The marijuana located was not claimed as medicinal or inside regulated containers and Mr. Gomez does not possess a valid medical marijuana card. Based on my training and experience, the marijuana separated into individual bags and the cash denominations are indicative of low-level narcotic sales. Further, these bags were separated by strains which were labeled on the bags. The total amount is approximately 9x the amount commonly recognized as "personal use."

Located with in this cash was a receipt from "Earl's Hideaway Lounge." This receipt was dated for Wednesday, June 10, 2026 at 2334 hours. It showed the purchase of four alcoholic beverages including a margarita and three premium drinks for a total of \$27, which was paid for with a \$100 bill.

Upon arrival to the Indian River Jail Complex, Mr. Gomez was searched and Deputy Rentas (6001) began a 20-minute observation period. Deputy Rentas asked Mr. Gomez to provide a sample of his breath to determine its alcoholic content and he refused. Mr. Gomez was advised of implied consent by Deputy

Mr. Gomez was ultimately charged Driving under the influence (DUI), Refusal to submit to DUI testing, Possession of more than 20 grams of marijuana, and possession of marijuana with the intent to sell or deliver. Mr. Gomez was booked into the Indian River County Jail complex and held on a NO BOND status.

Mr. Gomez was issued the following citations: DUI (ANHCAOE), DUI refusal (ANHBAIE), possession of controlled substance (ANHBAJE), and fail to drive in single lane (ANHBAKE).

NARRATIVE

On June 11, 2026, at approximately 0137 hours, while conducting routine patrol in the area of Oslo Road and 20th Avenue SW, Vero Beach, Florida, 32962, I observed a white Lincoln Town-car bearing Florida Tag "03DHJD" drive south bound on 20th Avenue and failed to stay in a single lane and crossed the white solid line on the right shoulder, then proceeded to cross the solid double yellow line.

I conducted a traffic stop on the vehicle for the aforementioned infraction. Upon approaching the vehicle, I observed a white male driver to be the sole occupant. The driver rolled down the window, I smelled the distinct odor of an alcoholic beverage emitting from inside the vehicle. I asked the driver to turn off the vehicle and had me the keys, which he complied. I then asked the driver for his required documents, which he never provided and stated he did not have his license on him. I identified the driver as Mr. Paul Short (arrestee) by his name and date of birth, due to Mr. Short not carrying his license with him.

Mr. Short's eyes were glossy and watery, his speech was slow and slurred. I asked Mr. Short if he had anything to drink, which he stated "Yeah, a few drinks". While speaking with Mr. Short the distinct odor of alcoholic beverage grew stronger. I then requested him to step out of the vehicle, while conversating with Mr. Short I continued to smell the overwhelming odor of alcoholic beverage emitting from his breath.

I explained my concern for his ability to safely operate a motor vehicle and requested Mr. Short to complete Standard Field Sobriety Exercises (SFSE's), which he agreed to complete.

The first exercise I administered was the Horizontal Gaze Nystagmus exercise. I explained the instructions to Mr. Short who stated he understood and did not have any questions. I observed Mr. Short's pupils were of approximately equal size and tracked simultaneously. During this exercise, I observed the following clues of impairment: Lack of Smooth Pursuit, Distinct and Sustained Nystagmus at Maximum Deviation and an angle of Onset Prior to forty-five degrees in both eyes. Mr. Short's angel of onset was approximately 35 degrees. Mr. Short was reminded to follow the stimulus multiple times, and to not move his head.

The second exercise I administered was the Walk and Turn (WAT). I explained and demonstrated the exercise to Mr. Short. I instructed Mr. Short to stand in the starting position, which Mr. Short had extreme difficulty standing in the starting position and attempted to start the exercise multiple times before all instructions were provided. Mr. Short tried to talk over me while I gave him the instructions. The following clues of impairment were observed: Mr. Short couldn't balance during instruction, started to soon, missed heal to toe, turned improperly, stepped off the line, used his arms for balance. Mr.

Short did not complete this exercise to standard. During this exercise Mr. Short stated "I'm fucked, I'm drunk."

The third exercise I administered was the one leg stand (OLS). I explained and demonstrated the exercise to Mr. Short, which he stated he understood and didn't have any questions. Mr. Short put his foot down at 2 seconds which is prior before the allotted time. Mr. Short continued to attempt the exercise and was unable to keep his foot at 6 inches above the ground. Mr. Short used his arms to help for balance. Mr. Short had a slight front to back sway. Mr. Short did not complete this exercise to standard.

Mr. Short was placed under arrest for Driving under the influence and transported to the Indian River County Jail Complex. Mr. Short refused to provide a sample of his breath to determine its alcoholic content. Mr. Short was read implied consent by Deputy Salomon, and Mr. Short still refused to provide a sample.

Mr. Short was ultimately charged with Driving under the influence, and refusal to submit to testing. Mr. Short was processed into Indian River County Jail and held on a total bond of \$1,000.00

Mr. Short was issued the following citations DUI(AM5WDVE), Refusal to submit to breath Test (AM5WDWE), and failed to maintain drive in single lane (ANHB9ME), Failure to exhibit DL upon demand (ANHB9NE).

NARRATIVE

On Thursday, June 11th 2026 at 0717 hours, while conducting routine traffic enforcement in the 3700 block of Indian River Boulevard, I observed a motorcyclist driving southbound.

I observed the motorcyclist drive between two cars and fail to stop at the steady red signal at 37th Street and Indian River Boulevard. I turned south from 37th Street onto Indian River Boulevard and activated my emergency lights in an attempt to conduct a traffic stop. It should be noted that during this time, your affiant was driving an unmarked white Chevrolet Tahoe equipped with interior and exterior lights that flash red and blue.

I observed the motorcyclist to be riding a gray cruiser style motorcycle with a dark colored helmet on. I continued to attempt catching up to the motorcyclist to conduct a traffic stop, however, he increased speed to what I visually estimated to be 115 miles per hour (MPH) in the posted 45MPH zone. I activated my stalker dual DSR2X radar in moving, same lane mode. While behind the motorcyclist, I received a clear and consistent audio doppler tone paired with a visual readout of 112MPH. During this time, the motorcyclist was lane splitting and driving in and out of traffic almost causing numerous crashes and clearly threatening the safety of other motorists. The motorcyclist failed to stop at the steady red signal located at 17th Street and Indian River Boulevard continuing southbound. Due to the motorcyclist's extremely dangerous driving I stopped attempting to catch up to him.

During the time spent attempting to catch up to the motorcyclist, I was contacting Indian River County Public Safety Dispatch. I provided them with a description of the motorcyclist. With the help of the Real Time Crime Center, we were able to learn the motorcyclist was captured on video driving south in the northbound lanes of Indian River Boulevard north of 12th Street. The RTCC further advised the motorcyclist was captured on traffic camera continuing south to 4th Street and US Highway 1.

Deputies Z. Evans and L. Nieves observed the motorcyclist, now southbound in the 100 block of S US Highway 1. Deputy L. Nieves was able to approach the motorcyclist and conduct a traffic stop in front of the South Vero Square Plaza where the two aforementioned deputies took the motorcyclist into custody.

I responded to the South Vero Square Plaza and contacted the motorcyclist, now identified as Michael Santos. I was now able to identify the motorcycle as a two-tone Harley Davidson Cruiser and I observed the same helmet I saw on the aforementioned motorcyclist, confirming this was the motorcycle that I observed driving recklessly and driving in excess of 100MPH while creating a public safety hazard.

I read Santos his Miranda Rights. He agreed to speak with me. Santos advised he left his residence this morning and utilized Indian River Boulevard to go south until he reached 4th Street and US Highway 1, where he conducted a south / left turn onto US Highway 1, where he was then apprehended by deputies. Santos advised he was driving to 574 Southeast Brookside Terrace, Port St Lucie FL, 34983. This location is where he joins his father to go to work. Santos advised his motorcycle has a performance issue that made his motorcycle stall out and he was attempting to avoid breaking down. He also advised he was attempting to get to his father's house in a rush because he did not want to be late. When I advised him he was driving 112mph, he advised he did not know and that 80mph feels like 40mph on his bike. I asked Santos if he observed me behind him at any point. He advised he did not observe Law Enforcement until Deputy Nieves conducted his traffic stop. I asked

Santos why he failed to stop at the stop signals, he advised he was driving too fast to stop.

Based on the information above, I found Michael Santos to be in violation of F.S.S. 316.192(1)(a) Reckless driving, and 316.1922(1)(b) Dangerous Excessive Speeding 100MPH or more. I transported Santos to the Indian River County Jail without incident.

Upon arrival at the Indian River County Jail, I showed Santos the footage supplied by the RTCC, which showed him driving into the oncoming traffic lane just north of 12th Street and Indian River Boulevard. I asked him why he drove that way. He told me that he was driving too fast in the curve and drove into oncoming traffic to avoid crashing his motorcycle. I explained that this action placed more citizens at risk. He replied by telling me that he recently crashed a motorcycle and did not want to do it again.

NARRATIVE

On Thursday, June 11, 2026 at 0828 hours I responded to 1201 Old Dixie Highway (7-11) in reference to a domestic violence call.

Prior to my arrival the victim, Julia Whitney [REDACTED] and advised that the father of one of her children, Gerald Tanner Jr., just entered the above location and poured a fountain drink on her and exited the property. Julia stated that she has an injunction in place with Gerald due to recent activity. I am familiar with these two subjects as the prior case and calls for service were taken by your affiant (particularly 2026-43356 – felony criminal mischief to Julia's apartment). A check was performed by 911 communications and the injunction was confirmed. I viewed the injunction and the service date was indicated as "served in court" on May 6, 2026 with Gerald's signature below on the respondent line.

Upon arrival, Julia stated that she went to 7-11 as she does every morning around 0820 hours to get a drink. She stated she pulled into the parking lot and thought she viewed Gerald's vehicle at the gas pump. Julia stated she entered the 7-11 and proceeded to go to the fountain drink area and get herself a drink. Julia stated just after she filled her drink, Gerald had appeared behind her and dumped the drink on her. Julia stated that Gerald then exited the store. As I spoke with Julia, I noticed that her pants and shoes were wet.

I then, with the assistance of Det. Scribner, was able to view 7-11 CCTV footage. As Julia is in the store, the video footage shows Gerald enter at approximately 0822 hours and approach Julia. Gerald then grabs Julia's drink and dumps it on her before fleeing from the 7-11.

Due to the nature of the call and pending charges, a ping was placed on Gerald's cell phone.

Throughout the lethality assessment, Julia indicated that she believed that Gerald would try and kill her. Julia also indicated that Gerald owned a firearm, is violently or consistently jealous, and has followed/spied her and left threatening messages for her during the aforementioned criminal mischief case. It is clear that Gerald has intensified his reaction due to the separation going from felony criminal mischief to battery domestic violence. Julia stated multiple times that she was "scared".

Due to Julia's responses to the lethality assessment, she was advised that she may be in a potentially lethal situation. Julia was provided information on the nearest domestic violence shelter and indicated that she declined these services as of now.

Later on 6/11 at approximately 1147 hours, Julia called 911 communications and indicated she was in the area and saw Gerald at 1196 Old Dixie Hwy (Snappy's). Myself and other units responded to the area in attempt to locate Gerald. Gerald was located inside the store and detained.

A post-miranda interview was attempted with Gerald. I began by asking Gerald if he was at the 7-11 located at 1201 Old Dixie Hwy earlier on the morning of 6/11 to which he replied yes. I then began to ask Gerald if he made contact with anyone or anything in particular happened to which he replied with indicating he wished to invoke his right to remain silent.

Due to the video evidence it was clear that Gerald was knowingly and intentionally came within 100 ft. of Julia's vehicle and defaced her property by pouring soda on her person and clothes violating the injunction, and in doing so committing battery




NARRATIVE

On Thursday, June 11th, 2026, at approximately 1655 hours, I responded to 1966 39th Street, Vero Beach, FL, for the report of a disturbance. (Statements are paraphrased)

The disturbance was regarding a male named Matthew Dixon, who was reportedly fighting with a neighbor.

Corporal Martin and I arrived at the location and met with Matthew, who was sitting on a chair; however, acting agitated and argumentative as to why we were there. While Corporal Martin spoke to Matthew, I spoke to his mother, named Lisa Troutman. I also spoke on the phone with his sister, named Latrice Levins. While speaking with Lisa, I determined there was criteria for a Baker Act. This was due to them telling me Matthew had been acting extremely paranoid. I learned from speaking to them both that he is paranoid and is saying he wants to kill himself. She continued to say that he is using drugs. Earlier in the day, several family members were on a video call, which included Latrice, Lisa, Matthew, and another family member. Lisa said she observed Matthew place what she believed to be a firearm to his own head and said something to the effect of say I won't do it.

Based on his behavior, the allegation, Matthew's agitated state, and the consistent statements between the family, I determined Matthew was not in the right state of mind and [REDACTED]. Corporal Martin and I approached Matthew to place him in custody. After getting him in handcuffs, he became uncooperative and went dead weight. This caused Corporal Martin and I to have to hold him up while trying to get him to a patrol car. As we got closer to a car, Matthew used his legs to prop them up against the vehicle so we couldn't get him further secured. To get him under further control, Corporal Martin and I had to forcefully place him face down onto the ground. While conducting a search of Matthew, I felt an object with a shape that appeared to be a handgun under his left pocket. I pulled out the object, which turned out to be a fully loaded black Luger revolver loaded with five rounds out of his pants.

IRCSO Public Safety Dispatch ran a criminal history check on Matthew and revealed a felony conviction for Possession of a Firearm by a Delinquent adjudicated and was guilty on 8/22/2017 out of Indian River County (Court Case 31-2017-CF000238AXXXX).

After the course of my investigation, I determined there was probable cause to charge Matthew with violation of FSS 790.23.1c Possession of a Firearm by a Convicted Felon and FSS 843.02 Resisting an Officer Without Violence. Booking staff was informed about Matthew's mental state.

The undersigned certifies and swears that he/she has just and reasonable grounds to believe that the above named defendant committed the following violation of law: On 06/12/2026 at 01:55 (Specifically include facts constituting cause for arrest.)

On June 11, 2026 at approximately 2332 hours, officers conducted a traffic stop on a gray Buick bearing Florida tag 98GB1J, traveling eastbound on County Road 512. The registered owner and known operator, Daniel Talamantez, is known to have warrants out of Indian River County.

(Warrant# 2026CF000048 FTA POSS FENTANYL; USE OR POSS DRUG PARA NO BOND)
(Warrant# 2025CF001285 FTA POSS COCAINE; USE OR POSS DRUG PARA NO BOND)

Upon stopping the vehicle, officers confirmed the driver was Talamantez. Upon contact with Talamantez, officers placed Talamantez under arrest. A hit-confirmation was received at approximately 2345 hours.

After placing Talamantez under arrest, officers asked Talamantez if he wanted his cell phone and his wallet to go with him to the jail. Talamantez stated yes. Officers retrieved the cell phone and wallet from inside the vehicle. Prior to property being placed in the patrol car to go to the jail, the contents of the wallet were searched for contraband. Upon searching the wallet, loose white powder was found to be inside the wallet. Based on Officer Venegas' training and experience with both Talamantez and drug investigations, he suspected the white powder of being cocaine.

Officer Venegas tested the powder inside the wallet using a Cobalt dropper. When tested, the substance immediately turned blue, indicating the presence of cocaine or a derivative of it. An additional white rock was located on the driver side door frame, which also field tested positive for the presence of cocaine or a derivative of it.

Post Miranda Warning, Talamantez denied having any cocaine or knowledge of it.

Based on the totality of the circumstances, I found probable cause to charge Talamantez with one count of Possession of a Controlled Substance (F.S.S. 893.13 (6)(a)) for unlawfully possessing cocaine.

Daniel was transported to Indian River County Jail without incident.
